The game was delayed by rain for 55 minutes with 0 outs in the top of the fifth inning (0-1 count to J.D. Martinez).

NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees had their eight-game winning streak snapped...was the Majors' longest active winning streak...are still 17-2 over their last 19 games...dropped into a tie with Boston for first place in the AL East and the best record in the Majors (26-11, .703)...are 5-1 on their nine-game homestand...at 26-11, have still equaled their best start since going 28-9 in 1998 (also went 26-11 to start 2003).
 - Erased a four-run deficit for the second time in their last four games (also trailed, 4-0, on Sun. vs. Cleveland).
 - Have been out-homered by their opponents in three of their last five games.
 - The fifth-inning rain delay was the Yankees' second in-game weather delay this season (also 45 minutes on 4/12 at Boston)...was their eighth game impacted by weather, first since their scheduled 4/15 doubleheader at Detroit was postponed by rain.
- Yankees batters were held without an extra-base hit for the first time this season...the 36G with at least 1XBH is their fourth-longest XBH streak to start a season since 1908...also snapped a streak of 30 consecutive games with a double (4/5-5/9), the club's second-longest streak since 1908.
 - Have scored runs against the opposing bullpen in all six games this homestand...have scored 19 of their 31R this homestand in the seventh inning or later.
- **RF Aaron Judge** (1-for-2, 1RBI, 3BB) reached base four times in five trips...drew a season-high 3BB...went 5-for-10 with 3R, 1HR, 5RBI and 4BB in the series...has at least 1RBI in his last 4G (7RBI).
- **2B Gleyber Torres** (2-for-4, 1R) extended his hitting streak to eight games...marked his sixth two-hit game in 18 career games...was just his second time being on the losing side in his career (16-2).
- LHP CC Sabathia (4.0IP, 9H, 4ER, 0BB, 5K, 1HR) started and took a no-decision...his 4R were a season high; had allowed just 4R/1ER in his first four starts off the D.L....allowed a season-high 9H; did not allow more than 5H in any of his first six starts of the year.
 - Allowed a solo HR to Hanley Ramirez leading off the fifth, his final batter before rain ended his outing...was his first HR since 4/6 vs. Baltimore (Chris Davis), snapping a streak of 111 batters faced without a HR.
 - Extended his reg. season unbeaten streak to 15 starts, the second-longest of his career (18 starts from 6/10-9/10/08 with Cleveland and Milwaukee)...has not lost since 8/6/17 at Toronto...is tied with Arizona's Robbie Ray for the longest active unbeaten streak in the Majors.
 - Snapped his streak of winning starts vs. Boston at five...was just the second such streak by a Yankee since 1966 (Mike Mussina, five straight wins from 9/2/01-6/1/02)...still has just one loss in his last 12 starts vs. the Red Sox (since 4/24/14).
- RHP Jonathan Holder (2.0IP, 2K) tied a season high with 2.0 scoreless innings (also 4/21 vs. Toronto)...has not allowed an earned run in seven appearances since being recalled from Triple-A Scranton/WB on 4/21, retiring 25-of-28 batters (8.2IP, 2H, 1R/0ER, 1BB/1IBB, 7K).
- RHP Dellin Betances (2.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 3K, 1HR) retired 6-of-7 batters but allowed a tie-breaking HR to J.D. Martinez in the eighth.
- Yankees relievers (5.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 1BB, 6K, 1HR) retired 15-of-17 batters faced.
- In 13 games vs. Boston at Yankee Stadium since the start of 2017, **Yankees pitchers** have held Red Sox batters to a .119 (10-for-84) BA with RISP, including 1-for-8 tonight.
- **1B Greg Bird** (right ankle surgery) went 0-for-3 with an RBI groundout and two flyouts, and played five innings at first base, in his first rehab game with Single-A Tampa...**OF Billy McKinney** (left shoulder sprain) went 0-for-1 with 2BB and played seven innings in left field for Tampa.

BOSTON RED SOX NOTES

- The Red Sox improved to 4-3 on their 10-game road trip...are 9-9 in their last 18 games (since 4/21) after starting the season 17-2...are 3-3 vs. the Yankees and 1-2 in the Bronx this season...are 5-12 at Yankee Stadium since 7/17/16.
- LHP Eduardo Rodriguez (5.0IP, 1H, 0R, 3BB, 8K) started and did not record a decision...is undefeated in seven starts this season, the second-longest such streak of his career (eight starts from 4/13-5/26/17)...marked his first scoreless start of the season and his first since 9/23/17 at Cincinnati (7.2IP).
 - Is only the third Red Sox pitcher since 2000 to record at least 8K and allow 1H-or-fewer vs. the Yankees, joining Joe Kelly (7.0IP, 1H, 1ER, 8K on 4/11/15 at Yankee Stadium) and Josh Beckett (6.0IP, 1H, 0R, 8K on 6/9/09 at Fenway).
 - The Red Sox are 7-0 in his starts this season.
 - In 10 career starts vs. the Yankees, is 4-2 with a 2.70 ERA (56.2IP, 17ER)...tonight marked his second career scoreless start vs. the Yankees (also 8/11/17 at Yankee Stadium)...is 2-2 with a 2.25 ERA (36.0IP, 9ER) in six career starts in the Bronx.
- **RF Mookie Betts** (3-for-4, 2R, 1 double) reached base four times...since 4/19, 15 of his last 21 hits have gone for extra bases (6 doubles, 8HR, 1 triple)...his 27 extra-base hits are tied for second-most by a Red Sox batter within the club's first 37 games of a season since 1908 (Earl Webb-29XBH in 1931; David Ortiz-27XBH in 2016).
- **DH Hanley Ramirez** (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 3RBI) hit a solo home run in the fifth ...has homered in back-to-back games...since the start of 2016, his 28RBI vs. the Yankees are the most by any player and his 11HR are tied for the most.
- LF Andrew Benintendi (1-for-5, 1R, 1 double) is hitting .333 (20-for-60) with 10R, 2 double2, 1 triple, 5HR and 17RBI in his last 15 games vs. the Yankees since 8/11/17.
- **RF J.D. Martinez** (1-for-4, 1R,1HR, 2RBI) hit a go-ahead, solo home run in the eighth inning to extend his hitting streak to 11 games...is batting .444 (20-for-45) with 9R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 9RBI and 4BB over the streak... is his longest hitting streak since a career-high-tying 14-game streak from 8/9-24/16.
- RHP Craig Kimbrel (1.0IP, 1K) tossed a perfect ninth inning to record his 10th save of the season.
