FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a six-game homestand tonight with the opener of this three-game set against the Pittsburgh Pirates. LHP **Dillon Peters** is making his third appearance of the season and the first career start against the Pirates. Pittsburgh is countering with RHP Chad Kuhl, who in two career starts against the Marlins has gone 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA (10.0 ip/4 er). Miami opened its current homestand by dropping three straight to the New York Mets. On Sunday, the Marlins will hit the road for a two-game series against the Yankees (April 16-17), a four-game series in Milwaukee (April 19-22), and a three-game set at Dodger Stadium (April 23-25).

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

Jarlin García tossed 6.0 no-hit innings against the New York Mets, but the Marlins were unable to hold a late lead, falling by the score of 4-1. **Miguel Rojas** put Miami up early with his second home run of the season, a solo shot to left, but that would be all the scoring the Marlins would do. García finished 6.0 frames and gave way to **Drew Steckenrider**, who tossed a scoreless seventh. In the eighth, the Mets got to three Marlins relievers for four runs. Miami was limited to just two hits, Rojas's home run in the first and a single by **Chad Wallach** in the second.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today optioned OF **Braxton Lee** to Triple-A New Orleans, transferred OF **Garrett Cooper** to the 60-day disabled list and selected the contract of OF **JB Shuck**. Shuck last appeared in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox on October 2, 2016 vs. Minnesota, and in 364 Major League games, has a lifetime .251 average (250x995) with 123 runs scored, 36 doubles, eight triples, eight home runs, and 80 RBI.

VS. PIRATES

Miami dropped the 2017 season series, 3-4, going 1-2 at Marlins Park and 2-2 at PNC Park. The Marlins .576 winning percentage against the Pirates at home (53-39) is their second-best winning percentage at home against any National League team, behind a .646 mark against the Colorado Rockies (64-35).

UNLUCKY 13

The Marlins have played 21 games on Friday the 13th, with an all-time record of 9-12 (.429) on this day, while the Pirates are 47-48 (.495). These two teams have faced off twice on this day, with Pittsburgh winning both: August 13, 1993 in Pittsburgh (8-3) and June 13, 2014 in Miami (8-6, 13 innings). Miami has dropped each of its last four Friday the 13th games, while the Pirates lost their last outing but have won 12 of their last 13 going back to 2003. - *Stats LLC*

EXPERIENCED YOUTH

The two teams in this series are showcasing two of the youngest active rosters in Major League Baseball, with Miami ranking as the fourth-youngest (28 years, 24 days) and Pittsburgh as the fifth-youngest (28.039). Philadelphia's current active roster is the youngest at 26.277, followed by Cincinnati (27.223) and the Yankees (27.334). - *Stats LLC*

MIAMI HEAT

Dillon Peters is making the ninth start of his young career tonight, and the fifth here at Marlins Park. His home/road splits over four starts each are drastically different, with his numbers at Marlins Park far exceeding his numbers on the road. At home, Peters has gone 2-1 with a 1.14 ERA (23.2/3), with an opponents average of .202 and a runners in scoring position average of just .100. On the road, however, he has gone 0-2 with a 13.22 ERA (16.1/24), a .405 average against and .435 average with RISP. Peters first start at home this season was a 6.0-inning scoreless effort against the Chicago Cubs on April 1. - *Stats LLC*

STARTING AT ZERO

Jarlin García made his first career Major League start on Wednesday, becoming first pitcher to throw 6.0 or more no-hit innings in his first career start since Ross Stripling of the Dodgers on April 8, 2016 at San Francisco (7.1 ip). García, who became the first Dominican pitcher to make his first career start for the Marlins since **José Ureña** in 2015, was the first Marlin to ever allow to hold an opponent hitless in his first MLB start. He finished with two walks and three strikeouts over his 6.0 frames.

SHOWING HE BELONGS

Marlins rookie third baseman **Brian Anderson** leads all Major League rookies in hits (13), doubles (4), walks (9), and OBP (.436), and is tied for the lead in runs scored (8). He ranks second in RBI (9), average (.295), and third in SLG (.488).

TOUGH TEST

Based on 2017 records, Miami will have the sixth-toughest schedule in the Majors over the course of March/April, as their opponents had a combined .519 winning percentage last season. Over the first month plus, the Marlins will have faced the Cubs, Boston, Philadelphia, the Mets, Pittsburgh, the Yankees, Milwaukee, the Dodgers, and Colorado in that stretch. However, from May through September, the Marlins have the third-easiest schedule, with opponents combining on a .485 record. - *Stats LLC*

GETTING CAUGHT RED HANDED

Marlins catchers have combined to throw out seven of 14 total attempted base stealers this season (50.0%), which is tied with Oakland for the third-best mark in the Majors. Cubs catchers have tossed out 57.1.0% (4-of-7), while Tigers catchers have thrown out 53.8% (7-of-13). Miami is tied with Detroit at the top of the Majors in total caught stealing. **Bryan Holaday** has thrown out four attempted base stealers, which ranks is tied for the third-most with Tucker Barnhart and Omar Narvaez, behind Jonathan Lucroy and James McCann, who both have five.

YEAR OF THE FAN

The Marlins, in partnership with AutoNation, America's largest automotive retailer, will be awarding a prize of a 24-month car lease to a select fan tomorrow night, the fourth of 25 dates this season where a fan (or fans) will drive off with a new car. The "Marlins Year of the Fan Sweepstakes, Driven by AutoNation" is open to any eligible fan in attendance at each select home date. Fans will be eligible for that date's drawing by scanning their valid, digital game ticket, stored on a mobile device, upon entry to Marlins Park prior to the end of the third inning. The 24-month car lease awarded to the winner of each game date's random drawing among all eligible entries will drive away with either a 2018 Ford Focus or 2018 Chevy Cruze. The next Sweepstakes game after tomorrow will be Saturday, April 28 vs. Colorado.

Named to first career Opening Day roster after finishing Spring season with 1-0 record and 4.70 ERA (7.2 ip/4 er) in five appearances (three starts). Was optioned to Triple-A New Orleans on March 16 before being recalled by Miami on March 29.

Making first career start and appearance against the Pittsburgh Pirates.

Took loss in last start, April 7 at Philadelphia. Allowed nine runs on nine hits while walking three and striking out three over 2.2 innings. Surrendered two grand slam home runs, becoming first pitcher in Club history to allow two grand slams in the same game, and was first MLB pitcher to do so since Mike Fiers in 2015. Only once have the Marlins as a team allowed two GS in the same game: May 21, 2000 vs. the Dodgers.

Made first start of season on April 1 against Cubs, tossing 6.0 shutout innings. Allowed six hits and walked one, while striking out two. Marked third career scoreless start, including a 5.2 inning performance against Atlanta in final start of 2017, giving him 11.2 consecutive innings without allowing a run. Scoreless streak was ended in next start at Philadelphia.

In 2017, overcame broken left thumb early in Minor League season and went 7-3 with a 1.57 ERA (63.0 ip/11 er) in 13 starts before earning his first MLB promotion in September.

Missed nearly two months of Minor League season after sustaining a fractured left thumb in April 17 start at Pensacola (hit by line drive).

In four rehab starts, posted 1-1 record, allowing just one earned run (three total) over 17.1 innings.

Prior to going on DL, allowed two runs and six hits over first two starts of season (10.1 ip). In return, allowed six hits and one run over 5.0 frames on July 27 at Mississippi.

Allowed average of 3.15 hits per start and surrendered more than three hits in a start just three times: July 27 at Mississippi (6), August 6 vs. Birmingham (7) and August 25 vs. Birmingham (4).

Tossed season-high 6.2 innings in last Minor League outing, Aug. 25 vs. Birmingham. Held Barons scoreless with two walks and season-high tying seven strikeouts.

Held opponents scoreless over final 13.2 innings in Minors, marking second-longest scoreless streak of season: tossed 14.2 scoreless from July 10-21.

Had contract selected by Miami on September 1 and made MLB debut that night with a start vs. Philadelphia.

Went 7.0 innings and struck out eight in debut, leaving in line for the win. Allowed just three hits and three walks. Tied Club record for innings pitched in an MLB debut, joining Justin Nicolino (June 20, 2015) and Brad Penny (April 7, 2000), and also tied for most strikeouts in an MLB debut, joining José Fernández (April 7, 2013).

In debut, infielder Brian Anderson also started and made MLB debut. Marked 18th time in Club history two-or-more players made MLB debut in same game, and just fourth time that two players started MLB debut together, joining Justin Bour & J.T. Realmuto (June 5, 2014 at Tampa Bay); Christian Yelich & Jake Marisnick (July 23, 2013 at Colorado); and Dan Uggla & Eric Reed (April 3, 2006 at Houston). - *Stats LLC*

Trevor Richards is making his third career start in the middle game of this three-game set against the Pirates. Richards had his contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston. In four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami, went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er).

Is making first career start and appearance against Pittsburgh.

In last start, surrendered three runs, six hits, and three walks, with two strikeouts, over 4.0 innings at Philadelphia on April 8.

Took loss in debut, allowing five runs on eight hits and a walk, while striking out five, over 4.1 innings. Surrendered just two hits over first three innings, but was touched for three runs in fourth and two in fifth, leaving with one out and a runner on first.

Split second affiliated and third professional season between Single-A Jupiter (13 games, 11 starts) and Double-A Jacksonville (14 starts). Combined to go 12-11 with a 2.53 ERA (146.0 ip/41 er) overall and earned Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
