## HERE'S THE STORY...

- ♦ The D-backs own the second-best record in the NL behind the Braves (.610, 25-16)
- ♦ Arizona is 9-5 in its last 14 games vs. Milwaukee @ Chase Field.
- ♦ The D-backs 2.72 ERA (32 ER in 106.0 IP) during the day is second best in the Majors, behind the Angels (2.67) and ahead of the Astros (2.74) and Pirates (2.81).
- ♦ **Matt Koch** is making his first appearance vs. Brewers.
- ♦ **Jimmie Sherfy** has not allowed a run in his first 13 Major League appearances dating back to 2017 (SEE NOTE).

## LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- ♦ Daniel Descalso delivered the go-ahead, RBI single in the eighth inning to defeat the Brewers, 2-1, ending Arizona's season-long, 6-game losing streak.
- ♦ Zack Greinke (1 ER in 6.0 IP) passed Dwight Gooden (2,293) and moved into a tie with John Lackey (2,294) for 52nd place on the all-time strikeout list.
- ♦ Archie Bradley earned the win with 1.0 scoreless inning.

## POLLOCK PLACED ON DISABLED LIST

- ♦ Yesterday, **A.J. Pollock** was placed on the 10-day disabled list with a left thumb avulsion fracture...he suffered the injury diving for a ball in the ninth inning of Monday's game.
- ♦ According to Torey Lovullo, Pollock will be sidelined between 4-to-8 weeks, and will be fitted with a soft cast...surgery is not required at this point.

## D-BACKS COMPLETE TRADE WITH RED SOX

- ♦ Last night, the D-backs traded LHP **Josh Taylor** to the Red Sox as the player to be named in the trade that brought INF **Deven Marrero** to Arizona on March 24.

## SAYONARA TO KOCH'S CY YOUNG STREAK

- ♦ **Matt Koch's** string of facing a former Cy Young Award winner will come to an end today...he faced Clayton Kershaw, Justin Verlander and Max Scherzer in his 3 previous starts and went 1-1 with a 2.79 ERA during that span...additional notes:
  - Was the first pitcher in team history to face 3 different Cy Young winners in a row...Scherzer (2009) and Brandon Webb (2008) each also had stretches of facing 3 straight Cy Young Award winners, but with repeats included [source: STATS LLC].
  - On May 1 vs. Dodgers and May 6 vs. Astros, he became the first pitcher to face different MVPs in consecutive starts since the White Sox' Ed Lopat during the 1947 season, who went against the Tigers' Hal Newhouser on Sept. 23 and St. Louis Browns' Dizzy Dean on Sept. 28 [source: STATS LLC].

- ♦ Since April 21, he ranks among NL leaders in doubles (T-1st), OBP (5th), OPS (6th), average (6th) and slugging pct. (9th, .610).

- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** is a career .391 hitter with 9 home runs and 31 RBI in 42 games vs. Brewers, ranking among the top active players against Milwaukee in OPS, average and slugging pct.:

- ◆ Koch is in his third full season in the D-backs' organization after being acquired from the Mets on Aug. 29, 2015 with RHP Miller Diaz for RHP Addison Reed.
- ◆ Entered 2017 rated by *Baseball America* as possessing the Best Control in the D-backs' system...also rated by MLB.com as Arizona's No. 17 prospect.
- ◆ Selected by the Mets in the third round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft from the University of Louisville.

- ◆ Making his first career start vs. Brewers.
- ◆ Is 2-0 with a 1.88 ERA when pitching in day games this season (3 ER in 14.1 IP).

**LAST START**

- ◆ Suffered his first loss of the season vs. Nationals on May 11, allowing 3 runs on 7 hits in 8.0 innings.
- ◆ Tossed a career-high 8.0 innings.
- ◆ Became the first D-back in team history to face 3 different former Cy Young Award winning pitchers in three straight outings (Clayton Kershaw on May 1; Justin Verlander on May 6; Max Scherzer on May 11).

**CY WHAT?!**

- ◆ Matched up against a third different former Cy Young Award winning pitcher in his last 3 outings (Clayton Kershaw on May 1; Justin Verlander on May 6; Max Scherzer on May 11), the first pitcher in team history to go through such a stretch...Max Scherzer (2009) and Brandon Webb (2008) each also had stretches of facing 3 straight Cy Young Award winners, but with repeats included [source: STATS LLC].
- ◆ Was the sixth NL pitcher since 2010 to have 3 straight starts against 3 different Cy Young Award winners, joining Luis Perdomo in 2017, Jimmy Nelson in 2014 (4 straight), Travis Wood in 2012, Tim Hudson in 2011 and Tim Stauffer from 2010-11.
