TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Nationals finish a four-game set today with the 10th meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves have taken two games in the series already, giving them four wins against the Nationals at SunTrust Park this season...They won three games total here against Washington last season.

A With a win today, the Braves will take their 12th series of the season...They won 18 total sets last season, and did not win their 12th until a three-game sweep of Oakland, June 30-July 2...The Braves are 5-1-2 in home series so far this season.

A The Braves today finish their longest homestand so far this season, an eight-game stretch against New York (NL) and Washington...They leave for a six-game, seven-day trip to San Diego and Los Angeles following today's game...They will not have a longer stretch of home games until August 10-19, when they play 10 games against Milwaukee, Miami and Colorado.

A RHP Anibal Sánchez owns a 9-1 record and a 2.11 ERA (33 ER/140.2 IP) in 23 games, 22 starts, against the Nationals...He tossed 3.0 scoreless innings earlier this season in his first ever relief appearance against the Nationals.

THE ROTATION: RHP Brandon McCarthy tossed 6.0 innings and allowed two runs and four hits yesterday, but took a no-decision in the Braves' 5-3, 14-inning loss...McCarthy's performance marked the fifth straight game the Braves' starting pitcher allowed five hits or less

A Since compiling a 13.14 ERA (18 ER/12.1 IP) and a .459 opponents average against in suffering all three losses in a sweep by San Francisco from May 4-6, the Braves starting rotation has gone 10-6 with a 3.06 ERA (48 ER/141.0 IP) and a .225 average against.

A Since that San Francisco series ended, the Braves starting rotation ranks second in the league in innings (141.0 IP), tied for third in wins (10), fourth in ERA (3.06), batting average against (.225) and OPS against (.670), and tied for fourth in strikeouts (129).

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz ranks fifth in the National League with a 2.22 ERA while teammate LHP Sean Newcomb is 10th with a 2.73 mark.

DAY GAME: The Braves play their second straight home day game today, the club's first such pairing this season...They are 14-4 in daylight this season.

A The Braves are averaging 6.50 runs in day games this season, the highest mark in baseball...They also lead the majors with 1.72 home runs per day game (31 total home runs)

A They have limited the opposition to a .208 batting average in day games, the best average against in the National League and trailing only the Yankee's .207 mark for tops in baseball

FREEMAN: 1B Freddie Freeman extended his hitting streak to 15 games yesterday with a sixth-inning double... Freeman's run is the longest by a National League player this season and four shy of Michael Brantley's run (19 games from May 9-May 30) for the longest in the majors this season...Prior to Freeman, OF Nick Markakis held the longest Braves streak this season, a 12-game run from April 23-May 5.

A After going 1-for-5 yesterday, Freeman is hitting .377 (23-for-61) over the streak, which dates to May 19...He began the streak hitting .319 and is now up to .335.

A Freeman's streak is the longest active run in baseball...He is four games ahead of Los Angeles' Andrelton Simmons.

A Freeman has also reached base safely in 23 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the National League...Only Detroit's Jeimer Candelario has a longer run (27).

A Freeman's on-base run dates to May 10 and a 5-for-5 effort at Miami...He owns a .471 on-base percentage over the 23 games.

A Freeman leads the National League with a .431 on-base percentage, while his .965 OPS is second only to Colorado's Nolan Arenado.

STRIKEOUTS: LHP Jesse Biddle fanned eight batters in 3.0 innings of relief yesterday to become the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings.

A Milwaukee's Josh Hader struck out eight batters to earn a 2.2-inning save on April 30 of this season at Cincinnati...Prior to that, the last reliever to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less of work was the Yankee's Ron Davis on May 4, 1981... Davis got nine outs, eight by strikeout.

A Since the franchise moved to Atlanta in 1966, only one other reliever struck out eight batters in a game...Rick Kester fanned eight Houston Astros over 5.2 innings on September 13, 1970 at the Astrodome.

A Biddle threw 50 pitches, 33 for strikes...Michael A. Taylor flew out to right field to lead off the 12th inning for the lone non-strikeout out.

PICKOFFS: The Braves are one of two teams in the majors with double-digit pickoffs this season, while tomorrow's starter, RHP Julio Teheran, is tied for the major league lead with five.

A San Diego leads the majors with 11 pickoffs, while the Braves have 10.

A Since Teheran's first full major league season in 2013, he leads the majors with 31 pickoffs, eight more than the next closest pitcher...The next closest right-hander has 15 since that date.

Today's Game

- A* Makes his fourth start of the season (fifth appearance) and the 266th (289th appearance) of his career.
- A* Signed by the Braves to a minor-league contract on 3/16 before having his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett on 4/2...Made his Braves debut that night.
- A* Set to make his 23rd start against the Nationals and his 24th overall appearance...Is 9-1 with a 2.11 ERA (33 ER/140.2 IP) against Washington, and has allowed two earned runs or less in 20 of his 23 previous appearances.
- A* His .900 (9-1) winning percentage is tied for the best mark all-time against the Nationals/Expos (minimum 10 decisions)...Ryan Dempster and Josh Johnson each finished their career 9-1 against the Nationals/Expos franchise.
- A* Sánchez's 2.11 ERA is also the best all-time against the Nationals/Expos among qualifying pitchers
- A* Faced the Nationals once this season, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of relief in his Braves debut, 4/2 at SunTrust Park.
- A* Holding opponents to a .129/.250/.161 line with four hits on his first time through the lineup, before allowing a .346/.452/.731 line when facing opponents a second time.
- A* Has pitched to a 1.50 ERA (1 ER/6.0 IP) in the first and second innings...Has a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP) in subsequent innings as a starter.
- A* Allowed a pair of home runs in his last start, 5/29 vs. NYM, and has surrendered 19 total homers in his last 17 games dating to 7/16/17.
- A* Among pitchers with at least 75.0 innings since 7/16/17, Sánchez's rate of 2.16 home runs per 9.0 innings is third highest in the majors.

2018 Recap

- A* Returned from the disabled list, 5/29, and started that night vs. NYM...Allowed five hits and four runs over 4.0 innings in a no-decision.
- A* Missed 37 games after suffering a right hamstring strain on 4/18.
- A* Began a rehabilitation assignment with Triple-A Gwinnett on 5/21 and made two rehab starts with the Stripers...Combined to go 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8 ER/6.2 IP).
- A* Suffered a right hamstring strain during pregame warmups on 4/18 and was placed on the 10-day disabled list that night.
- A* Snapped a career-long six-game losing streak in his last start with Atlanta, 4/13 at CHI...Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts, allowing just three hits and one walk in the Braves' 4-0 shutout of the Cubs.
- A* Went 0-6 with a 6.51 ERA (34 ER/47.0 IP) during the losing streak, which dated to 8/6/17 at BAL and spanned 11 games (10 starts)...Received just 13 runs of support during the stretch, an average of 1.18 runs per turn...Received either one or zero runs of support in eight of the 11 games.
- A* Made his first start of the season and went 5.0 innings and allowed seven hits and two runs in his last turn, 4/7 at COL...Atlanta lost 3-2 in the 10th inning.
- A* Is undefeated in six career starts against the Rockies...Sánchez is one of nine pitchers in history to make at least five starts against the Rockies and log an ERA under 2.00...Only five of those pitchers -- Sánchez, Jacob deGrom, Tom Koehler, Mark Prior and Bill Swift -- have done so without taking a loss
- A* Made his Braves debut with 3.0 innings of scoreless relief on 4/2 vs. WSH...Allowed one hit and three walks after having his contract selected from Triple-A Gwinnett that afternoon.
- A* Signed by Atlanta to a minor-league contract on 3/16 after spending the bulk of spring training in camp with the Twins...Signed a one-year major league contract with Minnesota on 2/22 before the club granted him his unconditional release on 3/13.
- A* Made two spring starts with Atlanta after signing with the club and went 1-0 with a 5.00 ERA (5 ER/9.0 IP)...Earned the win with 4.0 inning of two-run baseball on 3/18 at HOU in his first appearance with the Braves.
- A* Went 1-1 with a 7.62 ERA (11 ER/13.0 IP) in total on the spring.

2017 Recap

- A* Split the season between Detroit and Triple-A Toledo...Made 28 big league appearances, including 17 starts, and compiled a 3-7 record with a 6.41 ERA (75 ER/105.1IP) and 104 strikeouts.
- A* Surpassed 1,500 career innings with 4.0 innings on 4/26 vs. SEA...His 1592.2 innings pitched in his career are sixth-most by a Venezuelan-born pitcher in MLB history.
- A* Made his 250th career start on 7/16 vs. Toronto...Became the sixth Venezuelan born player to make 250 Major League starts, joining Felix Hernandez (369), Freddy García (357), Carlos Zambrano (302), Johan Santana (284) and Wilson Alvarez (263).

Career Recap

- A* 2018 marks his 13th major league campaign...Played the first six-and-a-half seasons (2006-12) of his career with the Marlins, before spending the last five-and-a-half seasons (2012-17) with Detroit.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 4/3

- Right-handed batters have just five hits in 46 at-bats (.109) against him...Lefties are hitting .407/.484/.704 with 11 hits, three walks, two doubles, two home runs and six RBI.
- Set career highs in innings (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...Milwaukee's Josh Hader struck out eight batters to earn a 2.2-inning save on 4/30 of this season at CIN...Prior to that, the last reliever to strike out eight or more batters in 3.0 innings or less of work was the Yankee's Ron Davis on 5/4/81.
- Five of his 16 appearances this season have been multi-inning efforts, most among Braves relievers.
- Opponents are hitting just .125 (4-for-32) with runners on base (.182 with RISP), compared to a .293 (12-for-41) average with the bases empty.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 8 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 12/3

- Tossed 1.0 clean inning with two strikeouts, 6/2 vs. WSH, to snap of streak of four consecutive appearances allowing a run...Allowed five earned runs in 4.0 innings pitched during the skid, after yielding just two earned runs in his first 26.0 frames
- Went 14 consecutive outings without allowing an earned run (15.1 innings), 4/16 to 5/19.
- Holding batters to a .157 (8-for-51) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-31, .097) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .277 (18-for-65) with no one on base.
- Converted his eighth hold of the season, 5/19 vs. MIA...Is 8-for-9 in hold chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .239 (16-for-67) average...Lefties are hitting .204 (10-for-49).

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 5 **1st Batter/Retired:** 29/20 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 23/5

- Blew his second save, 6/2 vs. NYM, after allowing a leadoff homer to lefty Juan Soto...Left-handed batters are hitting just 4-for-32 (.125) against him this season.
- Fanned the side in 1.0 perfect inning of relief, 5/28 vs. NYM [1]...Was just the second time in his career he stuck out the side without allowing a baserunner in a 1.0-inning stint (also 6/29/15 at BAL).
- Ranks tied for seventh in the majors with 28 appearances this season...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/30 vs. NYM, and allowed one run to score before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited 23 runners on the season, and has stranded 18 (78%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which is the third-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and Peter Moylan (present) had a longer streak in MLB history.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 2/2 **Holds:** 7 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/16 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 7/2

- Took his first loss of the season after allowing career highs in hits (4) and runs (3) on 5/28 at NYM [2]...Has pitched to a 5.65 ERA (9 ER/14.1 IP) over his last 17 games after opening his season with eight scoreless appearances (8.1 IP).
- Logged his second save of the season, 5/14 at CHI...Two saves lead all rookie relievers in the majors (tied)...Is a perfect 7-for-7 in hold chances and has converted his only two save opportunities.
- Has earned the win in three of his last eight appearances after picking up a victory, 5/20 vs. MIA...Three wins are tied for seventh in the majors among relievers.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded five of seven runners this season and nine of 11 in his career.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Appeared on consecutive dates five times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.

Peter Moylan • RHP • 6-3 • 220 • 39 yrs • #30

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 1 **1st Batter/Retired:** 25/14 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 14/7

- Blew his first save of the season, 5/28 vs. NYM [2]...Inherited the bases loaded and allowed a two-run single on the first pitch he threw...Has allowed seven of 14 inherited runners to score (50%)
- Tossed 1.0 clean inning, 6/2 vs. WSH, retiring all three batters he faced...Marked his second clean appearance of at least 1.0 inning this season...Allowed at least one baserunner in 20 of his 25 outings this season.
- Overall, opponents have 22 hits and 13 walks over 19.1 innings of work (1.81 WHIP).
- Worked a season-most 1.1 inning, 4/29 at CIN, and has 13 outings of at least 1.0 full inning this season...Made 79 appearances with Kansas City last season, but just 34 of those games went 1.0 full frame...His 79 total appearances led the majors, but his 34 relief outings of at least 1.0 inning ranked tied for 142nd.
