TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins start a three-game series tonight with the 10th meeting between the clubs this season...The teams split a two-game series in Miami last week, July 23-24...Miami will return to Atlanta for one final time this season, August 13-15.

A The Braves have won nine of their last 12 games against the Marlins in Atlanta, including rallying from a five-run, ninth-inning deficit in the teams' last game here, a 10-9 Braves win on May 20.

A Tonight's pitching matchup is a rematch of the club's final game in Miami, last Tuesday, July 24...LHP Wei-Yin Chen earned the 9-3 win over RHP Julio Teheran.

A Teheran is 6-6 with a 4.23 ERA (54 ER/115.0 IP) in 19 career games, 19 starts, against the Marlins...He is 0-1 with a 12.54 ERA (13 ER/9.1 IP) in two starts this season and has not beaten the Marlins in Atlanta since 2013.

A Chen is now 2-1 with a 3.23 ERA (14 ER/39.0 IP) in seven career starts against Atlanta...He has allowed seven runs, earned, in each of his last two road starts.

TRADE: The Atlanta Braves yesterday acquired RHP Brad Brach from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot.

A Brach, 32, went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) and 11 saves in 42 games out of the bullpen for Baltimore this season.

A The 6-foot-6, 215-pound native of Freehold, NJ, was an American League All-Star in 2016 and over an eight-year career with San Diego and Baltimore, the right-hander is 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games.

A Originally drafted by San Diego in the 42nd round of the 2008 First-Year Player Draft out of Monmouth University, Brach made his major league debut in 2011 with the Padres...He joined the Orioles in 2014, and since 2015, Brach ranks fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.

A To make room on the 40-man roster, the club transferred RHP Brandon McCarthy to the 60-day disabled list.

A This deal marks the teams' first since 2016, when the Orioles sent Brian Matusz and the 76th pick in the 2016 First-Year Player Draft for minor-league pitchers Brandon Barker and Trevor Belicek.

A In order to make room on the active roster, the club placed LHP Sam Freeman on the 10-day disabled list, retroactive to July 29, with left shoulder inflammation.

CROWDS: The Braves drew 40,303 fans yesterday, marking the team's 13th sellout of the season...They have sold out four consecutive games and six of the last seven after selling out 10 total home games in 2017.

A The Braves are one of nine major league teams to be on pace to outdraw their total from last year...Through 49 games last season, the Braves drew 1,556,426 fans...They are at 1,607,967 so far this season, an increase of 51,541 fans.

A Overall, the Braves are 11th in average attendance at 32,816...They lead all N.L. East teams.

MARKAKIS ON BASE: OF Nick Markakis has reached safely in 16 consecutive games, dating to July 6...His run is tied for the third-longest active streak among National League players and one off the lead of Cincinnati's Jesse Winker and St. Louis' Matt Carpenter.

A He has a .391 on-base percentage and a .328 batting average (20-for-61) over this stretch.

A His career-long streak is a 38-game run from July 5-August 18, 2009...Markakis compiled a .340 average and a .382 on-base percentage over that streak.

NEAR HISTORY: LHP Sean Newcomb allowed one hit over 8.2 innings yesterday, losing his no-hitter when Chris Taylor singled to left field with two outs in the ninth inning.

A Newcomb's performance was the longest a Braves pitcher took a no-hit attempt since Shelby Miller also went 8.2 no-hit innings on May 17, 2015 at Miami.

A Miller allowed a first-pitch single to Justin Bour that day...Miller and Newcomb are the only two pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to lose a no-hitter with two outs in the ninth inning, according to research from the Elias Sports Bureau.

A Newcomb improved to 8-1 with a 1.84 ERA (15 ER/73.1 IP) in 12 games this season following a Braves loss...His .889 winning percentage is the best in the majors in such games, while his eight wins are tied for most (Max Scherzer).

INCIARTE HITS: OF Ender Inciarte went 2-for-4 yesterday with his 16th double of the season and is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with three doubles and just one strikeout since the All-Star break...Inciarte is a career .318 hitter (363-for-1,140) following the All-Star break.

A Inciarte hit .227 prior to the break in 2016 before going 100-for-293 (.341) after the All-Star game in his first season in Atlanta...Inciarte hit .241 prior to the game this season.

DOUBLES: The Braves doubled three times yesterday to give them a National League-leading 214 this season.

A No other N.L. club has 200 two-base hits.

Tonight's Game

- A Set to make his 21st start of the season and the 183rd (186th appearance) of his career.
- A Makes his 20th career start against Miami and his third this season...Is 6-6 with a 4.23 ERA (54 ER/115.0 IP) in his career against the Marlins.
 - A Is 1-5 with a 6.65 ERA (33 ER/44.2 IP) over his last eight starts against them, dating 9/26/15...Atlanta has gone 2-6 during this spell...Teheran opened his career 5-1 with a 2.69 ERA over his first 11 starts against Miami.
 - A Faced them twice this season, including in his last start, when he allowed a career high-tying nine runs (seven earned) over 4.1 innings...Has allowed 15 total runs (13 earned) over 9.1 innings against the Marlins this season.
- A Started against the Marlins in his most recent turn, and will pitch against the same opponent in consecutive turns for the 10th time in his career...Did so twice this season, 4/3 and 4/9 vs. WSH and 6/4 and 6/17 vs. SD.
 - A In nine career instances in which he has faced the same opponent in back-to-back starts, is 5-1 with a 3.00 ERA (18 ER/54.0 IP) and 36 hits allowed in the first meeting and 3-3 with a 3.21 ERA (19 ER/53.1 IP) and 52 hits allowed in the second.
- A Leads the majors with six scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four hits allowed...Also has five starts of five runs and no more than 5.0 innings completed, tied for the seventh most such starts in the majors.
 - A In his last seven starts, has four efforts of one run or fewer allowed and three turns allowing at least five earned runs.

2018 Recap

- A Held Arizona to four hits and three walks over 6.1 scoreless innings 7/15...Fanned six.
 - A The start was his sixth scoreless effort of at least 6.0 innings and no more than four hits on the season, the most such starts in the majors.
- A Allowed a then season-most seven runs, 6/23 vs. BAL...Surrendered a first-inning grand slam to Mark Trumbo, the fifth grand slam allowed by Teheran in his career...Five grand slams are third most among active pitchers since his debut in 2011.
- A Held San Diego hitless over 6.0 innings, 6/17...Was the first hitless start of his career.
 - A Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher (eight times overall) to not allow a hit in a start of at least 6.0 innings and the first since RHP Aaron Harang went 7.0 innings on 4/18/14 at New York-NL.
 - A Fanned 11, becoming just the second Atlanta pitcher to strike out double digits in a no-hit outing...Kent Mercker fanned 10 in his no-hitter on April 8, 1994 at Los Angeles (NL).
- A Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/16...Missed nine games with a right thumb contusion after going on the D.L. on 6/5.
- A Tossed just 4.0 innings, 6/4 at SD, before leaving with a right thumb contusion...Allowed five hits and four runs, including a season high-tying three home runs.
 - A Placed on the 10-day disabled list the following day, 6/5...The D.L. stint was the second of his career and his first since 2016.
- A Lost his second consecutive start despite allowed five hits and two runs over 7.0 innings, 5/30 vs. NYM...Has gone 7.0 innings three times this season, and all three have come against the Mets.
 - A Snapped his scoreless streak against the Mets at 22.0 innings after allowing a run in the fourth inning...His streak was the longest in the majors against the Mets since Teheran also had a 29.0-inning run from 6/21/15 to 9/9/16.
- A Turned in a "quality" start, 5/25 at BOS, allowing four hits and three runs over 6.0 innings of work...Threw a season-most 109 pitches.
 - A Took the loss after Atlanta fell 6-2...The loss snapped a career high-tying four-game winning streak that dated to 4/16 vs. PHI...Went 4-0 with a 2.06 ERA (8 ER/35.0 IP) over the run, which spanned six total starts.
- A Allowed a then season-high six runs over 5.0 innings, 5/20 vs. MIA...Left the game trailing 6-0 before Atlanta rallied for a 10-9 win...The Braves are 10-6 in his 16 starts this season.
 - A All six runs scored in the fourth inning, the third time in his career he's allowed six or more runs in one inning...Also on 7/28/17 (5th) and 5/26/15 (4th).
- A Won his third consecutive start, 5/14 at CHI, after holding the Cubs to four hits and four runs over 6.0 innings...All four runs scored on a pair of two-run homers.
 - A Allowed two runs in the bottom of the second to snap a 16.0-inning scoreless streak, the second-longest such stretch of his career...Tossed a career-most 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings in 2016.
- A Tossed 6.0 scoreless innings, 5/9 at TB...Allowed four hits and fanned seven...Logged consecutive scoreless starts for the fifth time in his career.
 - A The outing vs. TB snapped a streak of 11 consecutive starts within the N.L. East, dating to 9/6/17.

Career Recap

- A Signed a six-year contract through 2019, with an option for 2020, on February 14, 2014.... Is a two-time National League All-Star (2014, '16).

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 3 **1st Batter/Retired:** 33/24 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 8/3

- Over his last 24 appearances, dating to 5/19, has a 2.25 ERA (7 ER/28.0 IP) with a .177 (17-for-96) opponents' average and three holds...Six of the 24 games have spanned at least 2.0 innings.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... Has gone more than 1.0 inning in 10 outings this season, compiling a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just 12 hits in 83 at-bats (.145) against him...Lefties are hitting .291 with 16 hits (55 at-bats), seven walks, three doubles, four home runs and 11 RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Brad Brach • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #46

Saves/Opp: 11/13 **Holds:** 3 **1st Batter/Retired:** -- **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/2

- Atlanta acquired him yesterday, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .272 (25-for-92) average, while lefties are hitting .342/.422/.452 in 84 plate appearances.
- Since 2015, ranked fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.
- The 32-year-old as an eight-year major league veteran, pitching to a career record of 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games prior to Atlanta acquiring him...Was named an American League All-Star in 2016 while going 10-4 with a 2.05 ERA.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 41/27 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/5

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one...Tied for second on the team with his 11 holds (A.J. Minter, 11)...Dan Winkler leads the club with 17.
- Has a 4.62 ERA (13 ER/25.1 IP) in his last 21 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season with just six walks...Has walked 12 over this skid.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL.
- Leads Atlanta relievers with four wins.
- Holding batters to a .186 (16-for-86) average with men on base and has allowed just eight hits (8-for-49, .163) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .240 (24-for-100) with no one on base.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/1

- Has fanned 25 batters in his 18.0 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 59 batters in 39.1 combined innings (13.5 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed one run and struck out five.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 5/5 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 45/32 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Has not blown a lead this season...Is a perfect 11-for-11 in hold chances and has converted all five of his save opportunities...Five saves are second most among rookie relievers in the majors.
- Allowed an earned run in just two of his last 18 appearances, dating to 6/12.
- Allowed four runs, three earned, and got one out, 7/10 vs. ARI...The four runs were a career-high total and marked just the fourth time in his career he allowed multiple runs in an appearance...Had allowed two total runs over his previous 16 games.
- Fanned the side on 16 pitches, 7/27 vs. LAD...Was his third career outing that went at least 1.0 inning with him striking out each batter he faced.
- Logged his fifth save of the season, 7/20 at WSH...Is the first left-handed pitcher with multiple saves in a season for Atlanta since Jonny Venters tallied five in 2011.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded seven of 10 runners this season and 11 of 14 in his career.
