RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals continue their 7-game, 8-day home stand (4-PIT, 3-MIA) this afternoon following a 4-0 loss last night, their 3rd shutout defeat of the season...the Cardinals won the series opener on Thu. night with a thrilling 10-8 come-from-behind win that was capped off with a 5-run 9th inning...the Cardinals began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 4.5 games back of the 1st place Milwaukee Brewers...the Redbirds are 4-6 in their last 10 games and 9-11 over their last 20.

FEELING A DRAFT: Major League Baseball's amateur draft starts on Monday, June 4 with the first 78 picks taking place that evening on MLB Network & MLB.com...the Cardinals have selections #19, #43 and #75 on Day 1...the draft will resume with rounds 3-10 on Tue., June 5 and rounds 11-40 on Wed., June 6.

HIGHS & LOWS: After reaching double-digits in runs (10) on Thu., the Redbirds were blanked last night...it was the first time since April 8-9, 2017 vs. CIN that they'd alternated games with double-digit scoring, followed by a shutout defeat...the last time they followed up a shutout loss with 10 or more runs was Sept. 23-24, 2016 at CHI (3-0 loss to the Cubs, followed by 10-8 win).

POWER PLAY: The Cardinals have homered in 39 of their first 55 games, going 27-12 (.692 win pct.) in those games...they are 3-13 when they do not homer... among NL clubs, only Milwaukee (30-7; .811) & Atlanta (28-10; .737) have a better winning pct. when homering. **HOMERS AT HOME:** The Cardinals are 14-4 (.778 win pct.) in games they homer in at Busch Stadium this season...only Milwaukee & Philadelphia (both 16-3; .842) have better marks among NL clubs when homering at home.

MOLINA TO SPRINGFIELD: All-Star catcher **Yadier Molina** is scheduled to begin a 20-day injury rehabilitation assignment today with the Springfield Cardinals (AA)...Molina suffered a pelvic injury with traumatic hematoma after taking a foul tip on May 5 and has missed 24 games...Molina last played in a minor league game in 2014 with Springfield (2 games) while on an injury rehab assignment for a torn ligament in his right thumb.

IT'S NEVER TOO LATE TO BE GREAT: The Cardinals walk-off win Thu. night was their 6th among their 16 wins at home this season...their 6 walk-off wins lead the majors and are their most since 2015 when they had a total of 9...they had 4 all of last season...the Cardinals have hit 4 walk-off homers this season, their most since 2009 (also 4)...Thu. night marked their first walk-off win when trailing by three or more heading into the final inning since 8/19/2005 vs SF, when down 4-0 in the 9th, they got a 3-run HR from **Yadier Molina** and a walk-off 2-run double by **Jim Edmonds** in 5-4 win over the Giants.

MAY'S M.A.S.H. UNIT: The Cardinals made a total of 42 transactions in May, impacting 23 different players and they placed 11 different players on the disabled list last month (**Dominic Leone, Yadier Molina, Carlos Martínez, Tyler Lyons, Adam Wainwright, Luke Gregerson, Carson Kelly, Paul DeJong, Matt Bowman, Greg Holland** and **Alex Reyes**).

PITTSBURGH CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Carlos Martínez** was teammates with Pirates pitcher **Ivan Nova** and outfielders **Starling Marte** and **Gregory Polanco** for the Dominican Republic in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 38th round of the 2014 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Pitching coach **Mike Maddux** signed with the Pirates in April 1995 and pitched in eight games before being released in May.

Pitcher **Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with infielder **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh in exchange for outfielder **Alex Dickerson** (November 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers in exchange for infielder **Chris McGuinness** (December 30, 2013).

Infielder **Jedd Gyorko** was born in Morgantown, WV...played at West Virginia University (2008-10).

First base coach **Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by the Pirates in the 31st round of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

Pitcher **Tyler Lyons** and Pirates infielder **Jordy Mercer** were teammates at Oklahoma State University for two seasons (2007-08).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** and outfielder **Corey Dickerson** were teammates in Colorado in 2013.

Catcher **Francisco Pena's** father, **Tony**, was an All-Star catcher for the Pirates (1980-86)...later traded by Pittsburgh to the Cardinals for pitcher **Mike Dunne**, catcher **Mike LaValliere** and outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** (April 1, 1987.)

Yadier Molina (June 3, 2004), **Matt Bowman** (April 6, 2016), and **José Martínez** (September 6, 2016) and **Luke Voit** (June 25, 2017) all made their MLB debuts against Pittsburgh.

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** and Pirates infielder **Josh Harrison** were teammates on the United States squad in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

Gregerson was previously Astros teammates with Pirates pitcher **Michael Feliz** (2015-17) and infielder **Colin Moran** (2016-17).

Infielder **David Freese** played parts of five seasons in St. Louis (2009-13)...member of the 2011 World Series Champions...hit only walk-off home run in Cardinals WS history in Game 6...recognized as 2011 WS and NLCS MVP...selected to 2012 NL All-Star...later traded by St. Louis with RHP **Fernando Salas** to the Angels for OF **Peter Bourjos** and OF **Randal Grichuk** (November 22, 2013)...graduated from Lafayette (Mo.) High School in Wildwood (same high school as **Luke Voit**).

Manager **Clint Hurdle** was selected by St. Louis from the Mets in the 1985 Rule 5 Draft and played in 86 games for the Cardinals in 1986.

Infielder **Sean Rodriguez's** father, **Johnny**, is the manager of the Cardinals' Springfield Cardinals (AA) of the Texas League.

Pitching Coach **Ray Searage** was selected by St. Louis in the 22nd round of the 1976 MLB Draft...later traded to the Mets for catcher **Jody Davis** in 1979...began coaching career in the Cardinals minor league system as Pitching Coach with Madison (1994), Peoria (1995-96) and Prince William (1997).

Pirates Baseball Operations Senior Advisor **Nick Leyva** was drafted by St. Louis in the 24th round in 1975...played three minor league seasons in the Cardinals system (1975-77)...managed six minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (1978-83)...served as St. Louis' First Base Coach (1984-85) and Third Base Coach (1986-88).

Former Cardinals (1983-86) and Pirates (1987-94) All-Star outfielder **Andy Van Slyke** is being honored and celebrated in a pair of bobbleheads this season at Busch Stadium (April 24 vs. New York Mets) and PNC Park (August 4 vs. St. Louis).

Cardinals Baseball Information & Media Services Coordinator **Chris Tunno** graduated from nearby Canfield (Ohio) High School.

Pirates Manager of Business Communications & Social Media **Terry Rodgers** previously worked as a Public Relations Specialist in the Cardinals Communications department (2010-11).

TODAY'S GAME

- Makes his team-leading 12th start of the season and the 30th of his career (34th appearance).
- Needs 2.1 innings to establish a new single-season high in innings pitched.
- Is facing the Pirates for the second time this season and 5th career. Struck out six over 5.1 innings pitching opposite Pirates rookie Nick Kingham in his first start, which Kingham took a no-hitter into the 8th inning before Paul DeJong broke it up.
- Looking to snap a three-loss streak (5/17-28) with an 0-3, 4.00 ERA mark.

LAST TIME OUT

- Took the loss at MIL (5/28) allowing four runs over 4.0 innings, including a two-out, two-run double by pitcher Brent Suter in the 4th inning which led to removal for a pinch-hitter during a Cardinals rally in the Top of the 5th inning.
- Has lost his last three starts (5/17-28), pitching a season-high 7.0 innings in the first two, allowing just three runs.

- All 3 of his wins this season have come on the road. Ranks T5th among National League pitchers in road wins.
- Of his 26 runs allowed, 11 have come in the 2nd inning.

CAREER

- Averaging 9.87 K/9 IP over his career 155.0 Major League innings.
- His 170 career strikeouts are 3rd to Rick Ankiel (179) and Shelby Miller (173) for the highest total all-time among Cardinals through their first 33 career games.
- Has three double-digit strikeout games in his first 33 games, trailing only Rick Ankiel (5) and tied with Paul Derringer (3) and Alan Benes (3) on the Cardinals all-time list.
- Won team-leading seven consecutive 2017 starts (8/2-9/20/17), was the 4th-longest in the National League and longest by a MLB rookie in 2017...is the first Cardinals rookie to achieve the feat since Ted Wilks (1944) & Johnny Beazley (1942) (Elias).
- Became the fifth rookie pitcher in the last 70 years to allow two runs or fewer over seven consecutive winning starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (eight straight in 1981), Cal Eldred (1992), Jered Weaver (2006) and Steven Matz (2016) (Elias).

2017

- Pitched the majority of the second half of the season with St. Louis, pitching in 13 games (10 starts) over three stints. Was the 7th different Cardinals pitcher to make a start behind the original starting five and Marco Gonzales.
