TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Marlins continue a three-game series tonight with the 11th meeting between the clubs this season...The teams split a two-game series in Miami last week, July 23-24... Miami will return to Atlanta for one final time this season, August 13-15.

A The Braves took last night's series opener, 5-3, and have won 10 of their last 13 games against the Marlins in Atlanta, including rallying from a five-run, ninth-inning deficit for a 10-9 Braves win on May 20 in the teams' last series here.

A LHP Kolby Allard is set to make his MLB debut tonight and become the 27th pitcher to appear in a game for the Braves this season...The club used 26 pitchers all of last season.

A RHP Dan Straily is 4-1 with a 3.41 ERA (14 ER/37.0 IP) in seven starts against Atlanta since joining Miami last season...He has won both his starts against the Braves this season, including tossing 7.0 shutout innings in his last outing, a 2-0 win on May 18 at Marlins Park.

TRADE: The Atlanta Braves yesterday acquired OF Adam Duvall from the Cincinnati Reds in exchange for RHP Lucas Sims, RHP Matt Wisler, and OF Preston Tucker.

A Duvall, 29, hit .205 with 15 home runs and 61 RBI in 105 games with Cincinnati this season... The 6-foot-1, 215-pound native of Louisville, Ky., hit 64 home runs over the previous two seasons (33 in 2016 and 31 in 2017) and made the National League All-Star team in 2016.

A His 79 home runs since the beginning of the 2016 season are tied for the fifth most in the National League. He also was a finalist for the Rawlings Gold Glove Award in each of the last two seasons.

ROSTER MOVE: In order to make room on the active roster for LHP Kolby Allard and OF Adam Duvall, the club placed RHP Peter Moylan on the 10-day disabled list (right forearm strain) and optioned OF Michael Reed to Triple-A Gwinnett.

MULTIPLE HOME RUNS: The Braves hit two home runs last night, their first multi-homer game in Atlanta since July 11...1B Freddie Freeman went deep in the third inning before OF Ronald Acuña Jr. followed with a fifth-inning solo shot.

A It was also just their second multi-homer game over the last 20 games here...They have hit more than two homers in a game here once this season: three on Opening Day vs. Philadelphia.

A For the season, the Braves have hit 43 home runs at home, or 0.86 per game...That ratio is the seventh lowest in the majors.

A On the road, the Braves hit 1.28 home runs per game, the 11th most in baseball.

DEBUT: LHP Kolby Allard is set to make his Braves debut today, becoming the second 20-year-old pitcher to start a game for the Braves this season...Fellow 2015 first-round draft choice and 20-year-old Mike Soroka made five starts for the Braves earlier this season.

A Allard went 6-4 with 2.80 ERA (34 ER/109.1 IP) in 18 games for Triple-A Gwinnett, where he became the second youngest pitcher ever for the Stripers...Only RHP Julio Teheran pitched for Gwinnett at a younger age than Allard.

A At 20 years, 352 days, Allard is the youngest pitcher in the majors and the third youngest player overall... Only OF Juan Soto and teammate OF Ronald Acuña Jr. are younger.

A The last time the Braves had three 20-year-olds play in the same season was 1969, when OF Dusty Baker (three games), 1B Jim Breazeale (two games), C Bob Didier (114 games) and LHP Mike McQueen (one game) all appeared for the club.

A This year marks just the second time in the last 110 seasons the Braves have had two pitchers make a start prior to their 21st birthday...LHP Chet Nichols and RHP Dave Cole did it in 1951.

A The last major league team with two pitchers under the age of 21 to make a start in the same season was the 1985 Chicago White Sox...RHP Joel Davis and RHP Ed Correa accomplished the feat that season.

FREEMAN VS. MIAMI: 1B Freddie Freeman hit a go-ahead solo home run last night, and the first baseman is now hitting .450 (18-for-40) with six home runs, four walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a .925 slugging percentage (1.425 OPS) in 10 games against the Marlins this season.

A The last Braves player to hit more home runs against a single opponent in a season was Jeff Francoeur, who had seven home runs in 2006 against Miami.

A The Atlanta franchise history record is 11 by Dale Murphy against San Francisco in 1983.

YOUNGSTER HOME RUNS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr. hit his 10th home run of the season last night, lifting a solo shot over the center-field fence in the fifth inning.

A Acuña Jr. became just the seventh Braves player over the last 110 seasons to reach double-digit home runs prior to turning 21...The others were Andrew Jones (26 total), Eddie Mathews (25), Hank Aaron (13), Jason Heyward (11) and Bob Horner (10).

CONVERTED: LHP A.J. Minter remained perfect in preserving leads last night, converting his sixth save of the season with a scoreless ninth...He also has 16 career holds.

A The Braves bullpen has not blown a lead since June 27 vs. Cincinnati...They have collected five saves and 11 holds since then.

Tonight's Game

- A** Atlanta selected his contract today and he is set to make his major league debut.
- A** Becomes the sixth Atlanta player to debut this season, and the second starter... RHP Mike Soroka started against the New York Mets on 5/1, while OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (4/25), LHP Jesse Biddle (4/21), OF Dustin Peterson (5/28) and RHP Evan Phillips (7/3) have also debuted this season.
- A** Makes his debut at 20 years, 352 days old...Is the second-youngest starter to pitch in the majors this season...Only teammate Mike Soroka, who debuted at 20 years and 270 days, has pitched in a game at a younger age than Allard.
- A** Atlanta has three of the four youngest pitchers to start a game this season... Soroka and Allard are the two youngest, while Luiz Gohara is fourth.
- A** Allard is the youngest left-handed pitcher to make a start for Atlanta since Odalis Perez (20 years, 302 days) in 1999.
- A** Since the Braves moved to Atlanta in 1966, only four left-handers have debuted at a younger age than Allard: Charlie Vaughan (18 years, 332 days on 9/3/66), Mike McQueen (19 years, 033 days on 10/2/69), Steve Avery (20 years, 060 days on 6/13/90) and Odalis Perez (20 years, 082 on 9/1/98).
- A** Becomes the first Atlanta starter to debut against Miami in franchise history.
- A** Ten Braves pitchers have made their debuts against the Marlins, all in relief... RHP Tyrell Jenkins was the last to do so, 6/22/16.
- A** Made 18 starts with Triple-A Gwinnett, going 6-4 with a 2.80 ERA (34 ER/109.1 IP) and 87 strikeouts.
- A** Led the Stripers staff in starts, wins (tied), innings and strikeouts.
- A** Allowed three hits and two runs (one earned) over 5.0 innings in his last start, 7/22 vs. Pawtucket...Walked two and struck out six.
- A** Entered the 2018 season tabbed by MLB.com as the No. 58 overall prospect in the minors, the seventh-best left-handed pitching prospect and as Atlanta's No. 6 farmhand.

2018 Recap

- A** At the time of his purchase, ranked among qualified International League leaders in ERA (3rd, 2.80), hits per 9.0 innings (4th, 8.15), walks per 9.0 innings (7th, 2.72) innings pitched (8th, 109.1) and starts (T14th, 18).
- A** Among Atlanta's full-season farmhands ranked tied for third in innings pitched, fifth in ERA, sixth in WHIP (1.207), tied for ninth in starts and 10th in strikeouts,
- A** Surrendered just six home runs over 109.1 innings (0.49 HR/9.0 IP), and has tossed 27.1 consecutive homerless innings.
- A** Made a team-high 11 quality starts in 18 turns for Gwinnett.
- A** Made 10-straight quality starts from 4/28-6/21, going 4-1 with a 2.17 ERA (16 ER/66.1 IP) and a .248 opponents' batting average in that span.
- A** Named Gwinnett's May Pitcher of the Month by Atlanta after going 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA (7 ER/35.0 IP) and a .240 opponents' average in five starts.
- A** Named an International League Mid-Season All-Star.
- A** Did not pitch in the Pacific Coast League's 12-7 win over the International League.
- A** On 4/10 at Durham, became the second youngest starting pitcher in Gwinnett's 10-year history at 20 years, 7 months and 28 days...Was older than only Julio Teheran (20 years, 2 months, 12 days on 4/8/11 vs. Durham).
- A** Was invited to his first major league spring training and tossed 3.0 scoreless innings across two appearances...Walked three and struck out one.

2017 Recap

- A** Set new career highs in games (27), starts (27), complete games (2), shutouts (1), innings (150.0) and strikeouts (129) while going 8-11 with a 3.18 ERA (53 ER/150.0 IP) at Double-A Mississippi.
- A** Earned a pair of Southern League Pitcher of the Week honors (5/1-7, 8/28-9/4), picked up SL Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star honors and was named the best left-handed pitcher in the SL following the season.
- A** Led the Mississippi staff in starts and strikeouts, and his 129 K's ranked fifth most in the SL.
- A** Pitched to a 4-1 record and a 1.23 ERA over his first eight starts, before posting a 1-8 record and a 5.55 ERA over his next 12 turns...Ended his season by going 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA over his final seven starts, including 14.0 scoreless innings pitched in his last two turns.
- A** Entered the season named by Baseball America as Atlanta's No. 3 prospect, and as the No. 37 prospect in the minor leagues.

- A** Selected by Atlanta with the 14th overall pick in the 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of San Clemente (CA) High School.
- A** Went 22-18 with a 2.96 ERA (116 ER/353.0 IP) in 64 career minor league games, all of which were starts.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** 34/25 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 9/3

- Over his last 25 appearances, dating to 5/19, has a 2.17 ERA (7 ER/29.0 IP) with a .172 (17-for-99) opponents' average and four holds...Six of the 25 games have spanned at least 2.0 innings.
- Tossed a scoreless ninth and 10th innings, 7/2 at NYY, to earn his second win of the season... Has gone more than 1.0 inning in 10 outings this season, compiling a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP) with 29 strikeouts.
- Earned his first career hold with a scoreless seventh inning, 6/24 vs. BAL...Became the sixth Atlanta pitcher with a hold this season.
- Right-handed batters have just 12 hits in 85 at-bats (.141) against him...Lefties are hitting .286 with 16 hits (56 at-bats), seven walks, three doubles, four home runs and 11 RBI.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

Brad Brach • RHP • 6-4 • 205 • 32 yrs • #46

Saves/Opp: 11/13 **Holds:** 4 **1st Batter/Retired:** -- **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 15/2

- Atlanta acquired him, 7/29, from the Baltimore Orioles in exchange for an international signing slot...Made his Braves debut, 7/30 vs. MIA, with a scoreless eighth inning to earn his fourth hold of the season.
- Went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA (21 ER/39.0 IP) in 42 games with Baltimore, converting 11-of-13 save chances.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .274 (26-for-95) average, while lefties are hitting .333/.412/.440 in 86 plate appearances.
- Since 2015, ranked fourth in the American League with 242 appearances.
- The 32-year-old as an eight-year major league veteran, pitching to a career record of 30-21 with a 3.16 ERA (152 ER/432.1 IP) in 397 games prior to Atlanta acquiring him...Was named an American League All-Star in 2016 while going 10-4 with a 2.05 ERA.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 **Holds:** 12 **1st Batter/Retired:** 42/27 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 19/5

- Is one of three rookie relievers for Atlanta with at least 10 holds...No other team has more than one...Ranks second on the team with his 12 holds...Dan Winkler leads the club with 17.
- Has a 4.44 ERA (13 ER/26.1 IP) in his last 22 appearances dating to 5/21 at PHI...Pitched to a 0.69 ERA in his first 20 games of the season with just six walks...Has walked 12 over this skid.
- Tossed 3.0 perfect innings of relief, 7/5 at MIL.
- Leads Atlanta relievers with four wins.
- Holding batters to a .184 (16-for-87) average with men on base and has allowed just eight hits (8-for-49, .163) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .252 (26-for-103) with no one on base.

Luke Jackson • RHP • 6-2 • 210 • 26 yrs • #64

Saves/Opp: 1/1 **Holds:** 0 **1st Batter/Retired:** 16/10 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 6/1

- Has fanned 25 batters in his 18.0 innings with Atlanta, and has struck out 59 batters in 39.1 combined innings (13.5 SO/9.0 IP) between the Braves and Triple-A Gwinnett.
- Threw a career-most 62 pitches over 3.0 innings, 7/3 at NYY...Allowed one run and struck out five.
- Earned his first win of the season with a scoreless 11th inning, 6/25 vs. CIN...Is 3-0 in his major league career.
- Earned his first career save on 6/5 at SD.
- Signed as a major league free agent, 6/17, his fourth stint with Atlanta this season...Was with the Braves most recently from 6/5 before being DFA'd on 6/13 and outrighted to Gwinnett on 6/14...He elected free agent on 6/15...Also with Atlanta from 4/4 to 4/15 and 5/6 to 5/8.
- Went 2-1 with a 1.69 ERA (4 ER/21.1 IP) in 10 appearances (one start) w/ Gwinnett.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 6/6 **Holds:** 11 **1st Batter/Retired:** 46/33 **Inherited Runners/Scored:** 10/3

- Has not blown a lead this season...Is a perfect 11-for-11 in hold chances and has converted all six of his save opportunities...Six saves are second most among rookie relievers in the majors.
- Allowed an earned run in just two of his last 19 appearances, dating to 6/12...Has a 2.08 ERA in that span.
- Allowed four runs, three earned, and got one out, 7/10 vs. ARL...The four runs were a career-high total and marked just the fourth time in his career he allowed multiple runs in an appearance...Had allowed two total runs over his previous 16 games.
- Fanned the side on 16 pitches, 7/27 vs. LAD...Was his third career outing that went at least 1.0 inning with him striking out each batter he faced.
- Logged his six save of the season, 7/30 vs. MIA...Is the first left-handed pitcher with multiple saves in a season for Atlanta since Jonny Venters tallied five in 2011.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 5/9 at TB, and allowed two runs to score...The runs were the first inherited runners he has allowed to score in his career...Has stranded seven of 10 runners this season and 11 of 14 in his career.
