TODAY'S GAME: The Braves and Red Sox finish a three-game set today with the sixth and final meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves dropped two of three in Boston earlier this season, May 25-27.

A Since the beginning of the 2006 season, the Braves have lost 14 of 17 against the Red Sox in Atlanta, including each of the last five after dropping the first two games of this series...The club has not beaten the Red Sox here since June 17, 2015 and has not won consecutive games against Boston in Atlanta since June 14 and 15, 2002.

A RHP Mike Foltynewicz tossed 7.0 innings and allowed one run, earned, to beat Boston earlier this season, 7-1 on May 27 at Fenway Park...The win came in Foltynewicz's first career start against the Red Sox; he made two relief appearances while with Houston in 2014.

A RHP Héctor Velazquez faced the Braves twice in the relief during the clubs' early season matchup at Fenway Park...The righty allowed one run, earned, over 2.2 innings...As a starter this season, Velazquez is 2-2 with a 3.91 ERA (10 ER/23.0 IP) in six games...He has lost his last two starts.

INTERLEAGUE: Today's games marks the Braves' final interleague matchup of the season...They are 8-11 against the American League so far this season...They have not finished with a winning interleague record since 2013, when they went 11-9.

A Since winning consecutive series against Los Angeles and Oakland at Turner Field in 2014, the Braves have won one interleague set in Atlanta...They beat Detroit in two of three games to close out 2016.

A From the start of interleague play in 1997 through the 2003 season, the Braves went 71-47 (.602) against the American League...That record was the best in the National League and trailed only Oakland (75-47) for the best in the majors.

A Since 2004, the Braves have gone 115-145 (.442) in interleague play, the fourth-worst record in baseball...Only San Diego (.390), Cincinnati (.410) and Philadelphia (.423) have been worse over that time frame.

DEBUT: RHP Kyle Wright tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in his major league debut yesterday, becoming the 10th Braves pitcher to debut this season...That total is tied for the second most in the franchise's modern-era...The 2016 club also had 10 pitchers debut, while the 2015 team set the record with 13.

A Wright became the first player from the 2017 draft to appear in a MLB game...He was the fifth overall selection last season...He is also the first Braves player to appear in the majors the year after he was drafted since Alex Wood, who debuted in 2013 after Atlanta selected him in the second round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft.

HOME RUNS: C Kurt Suzuki hit his 10th home run of the season yesterday, driving a 2-2, second-inning pitch from Rick Porcello over the wall in center field...Suzuki reached double-digit home runs for the second consecutive season and for the fifth time in his career on the same day he was named the club's nominee for the Roberto Clemente award.

A Suzuki became the eighth different player to reach double figures home runs in an Atlanta uniform this season, joining Ronald Acuña Jr., Ozzie Albies, Johan Camargo, Charlie Culberson, Freddie Freeman, Nick Markakis and Dansby Swanson.

A The eight different players with double-digit home runs is tied for the second-highest single-season total in franchise history and the most since the 2013 club also had eight players.

A The 2007 team set the franchise record with nine different players.

A OF Ender Inciarte has nine home runs, while Tyler Flowers has six.

200 STRIKEOUTS: RHP Mike Foltynewicz enters today's start with 174 strikeouts, 26 away from becoming the first Braves pitcher with 200 in a season since RHP Javier Vazquez fanned 238 in 2009...Foltynewicz is averaging 6.69 strikeouts per start this season.

A Since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966, only five different pitchers have reached 200 strikeouts in a season: John Smoltz (five times), Phil Niekro (three times), Vazquez (once), Kevin Millwood (once), Greg Maddux (once).

A Foltynewicz also carries a 2.80 ERA, the fourth-best mark in the National League into today's start...He is trying to become the first qualifying Braves pitcher to finish with a sub-3.00 ERA since LHP Alex Wood and RHP Julio Teheran did so in 2014.

UP NEXT: The Braves are set to travel to Arizona following today's game to begin a four-game set with the Diamondbacks tomorrow...After that series, the team will play three games in San Francisco before returning for 10 games at SunTrust Park to close out their home schedule.

A Over the last six years, dating to the start of the 2013, the Braves are 29-64 (.312) on the road against the National League West.

A They are 4-5 on the road and 9-18 overall against the West this season...They have lost seven of the last eight.

LEADOFF HOME RUNS: OF Ronald Acuña Jr.'s seven leadoff home runs are tied with Marquis Grissom's total from 1996 for the most such homers in a single season in franchise history.

A Grissom set the record over 157 games; Acuña Jr. has led off 43 times.

Today's Game

- A* Set to make his 27th start of the season and the 92nd of his career...Is his 112th career appearance.
- A* Makes his fourth career appearance and his second start against the Red Sox...Is 1-0 with a 1.74 ERA (2 ER/10.1 IP) over his first three games, including a start earlier this season.
 - A* Is the only Atlanta pitcher to defeat the Red Sox this season...Allowed three hits and one run over 7.0 innings to earn the win, 5/27 at Fenway Park.
 - A* Made two relief appearances against Boston while with Houston in August of 2014 and allowed one run in 3.1 innings...The games were the fifth and sixth of his career.
- A* Is 2-0 in his only two Interleague starts this season, pitching to a 3.95 ERA (6 ER/13.2 IP)...Defeated Boston and Toronto.
 - A* Is 7-3 with a 4.38 ERA in 13 career Interleague games, including 11 starts.
- A* Has fanned 174 batters in 151.0 innings on the season, and has allowed just 15 home runs...Is one of nine pitchers in the majors to average at least 10 strikeouts per 9.0 innings (10.37) with less than one home run (0.89).
 - A* The last Braves starter with at least 150.0 innings and fewer than 1.0 home run per 9.0 innings was Shelby Miller, who did so in 2015 (0.57 HR/9.0 IP).
 - A* No qualified Braves pitcher has averaged 10.0 SO/9.0 IP in a season in franchise history...John Smoltz has come closest, with 9.79 SO/9.0 IP in 1996.
- A* Made six starts in August, and went 3-2 with a 2.09 ERA (9 ER/38.2 IP) and 41 strikeouts.
 - A* His run last month followed five starts in July during which he went 2-3 with a 5.72 ERA (18 ER/28.1 IP).

2018 Recap

- A* Faced the Cubs in his last start, 8/30, and allowed five runs (four earned) over 6.0 frames to take the loss...Was his second start against Chicago at SunTrust Park this season.
 - A* Became the first Atlanta pitcher to make two starts against the Cubs at his home park in a single season since Greg Maddux did so in 1998.
- A* Made his eighth career appearance against Colorado, 8/18, and tossed 7.0 scoreless innings...Did not earn the win after the Rockies won, 5-3, in 10 innings.
 - A* All eight of his appearances against Colorado have come with Atlanta, and the Braves are 0-8 in those games...Atlanta has been outscored 49-17.
- A* Stopped a two-game losing streak with a win, 8/2 at NYM...Allowed five hits and two runs over 6.0 innings...Struck out five.
 - A* The two-game skid was his first time losing consecutive starts since dropping each of his final seven starts of 2017.
- A* Was selected to his first major league All-Star Game after going 7-5 with a 2.66 ERA (30 ER/101.2 IP) over 18 games to open the season...Fanned 120 batters over 101.2 innings of work.
 - A* Tossed a scoreless fourth inning in his All-Star Game debut, retiring José Ramírez, Manny Machado and José Abreu, while walking Aaron Judge.
 - A* His 120 strikeouts before the All-Star break are tied for sixth most in Atlanta franchise history...John Smoltz fanned 149 batters in 134.0 innings before the break in 1996 to set the Atlanta franchise mark.
- A* Held the Cardinals scoreless over 5.0 innings, 7/1 at STL...Allowed just one hit and fanned nine.
 - A* The start was his 11th of the season allowing one run or fewer, and those 11 starts came in his first 17 turns on the season...The Atlanta franchise record for starts allowing no more than one run is 19, set by Greg Maddux over 34 starts in 2002.
- A* Reinstated from the 10-day disabled list, 6/25, and started vs. Cincinnati...Allowed one hit and one run over 5.0 innings...Missed seven games with right triceps tightness.
- A* Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings, 6/12 vs. NYM, allowing just two hits while fanning six.
 - A* Threw a season-low 73 pitches before exiting the game with right triceps tightness...Was placed on the 10-day disabled list, 6/16.
- A* Threw the first shutout of his major league career, 6/1 vs. Washington...Allowed just two hits and struck out 11.
 - A* Became the seventh pitcher in Atlanta-era history to throw a two-hitter or better with double-digit strikeouts and the first since Greg Maddux fanned 14 Brewers in a two-hit, 1-0 win on May 2, 2001 at Turner Field.
- A* Was saddled with the loss, 5/21 at PHI, despite allowing one run over 6.0 innings of work...The start was his fourth against Philadelphia this season and the fourth time in which he faced Phillies starter RHP Nick Pivetta.
 - A* According to the Elias Sports Bureau, the last time two pitchers faced off for a fourth time in a team's 46th game or earlier was on 5/31/59, when Lew Burdette faced Robin Roberts in the Braves' 44th game and the Phillies' 45th.

- A* Acquired by the Atlanta Braves along with RHP Andrew Thurman and INF Rio Ruiz from the Houston Astros in exchange for C/OF Evan Gattis and RHP James Hoyt on 1/14/15.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Has a 2.28 ERA in 49 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the second lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Only Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lower.
- Allowed a pair of unearned runs, 9/4 vs. BOS, but has an eight-game streak without an earned tally dating to 8/19...Has fanned 10 over 7.1 innings.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his four wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 8-for-42 (.190) with runners in scoring position, including 3-for-19 (.158) with two outs.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arodys Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson, Jonny Venters and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.

- Has allowed just one earned run in 17 appearances (15.1 IP) since the Braves acquired him on 7/29...Has seven holds since being acquired by Atlanta, tied for the fifth most in the majors in that time span.
- Took his second loss with Atlanta, 8/31 vs. PIT after allowing one unearned run in 0.2 innings...Both of his losses with the Braves have come in games in which he did not allow an earned run.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .231 (30-for-130) average, while lefties are hitting .340/.431/.436 in 110 plate appearances.
