CHICAGO CUBS NOTES

JON LESTER exited the game with low back tightness ... has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 26 of his 29 starts this season ... has allowed three runs or fewer in five-straight starts.

KRIS BRYANT (1-for-3, 2B, R, RBI) has doubled in consecutive games.

© Was his first home game since July 23 vs. Arizona.

BEN ZOBRIST (2-for-4) is 8-for-16 in his last five games.

NOTES: The Cubs have lost three-straight games for the first time since August 18-21, a four day stretch which included a rare scheduled off day.

© Willson Contreras (1-for-3, 2B, R, BB) snapped an eight-game streak without an extra-base hit ... his 25 doubles this season are a career-high.

© Albert Almora Jr. (1-for-4) has hit safely in four-straight games (.294/5-for-17).

© Terrance Gore improved to 5-for-5 in stolen base chances this season.

MILWAUKEE BREWERS NOTES

WADE MILEY has allowed two earned runs or fewer in a career-high tying six-straight starts, posting a 2.36 ERA (9 ER/34.1 IP) during that stretch ... has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 12 of his 13 starts this season.

JOSH HADER struck out all six batters he faced ... third relief outing this season with at least six strikeouts ... his 127 strikeouts this season are a new franchise record for a Brewers reliever, surpassing Corey Knebel's 126 strikeouts last season.

LORENZO CAIN (4-for-5, R) tied his season-high with four hits, done for the fourth time ... his most four-hit games in a season since 2014 (five four-hit games).

© Has batted .364 (44-for-121) in his last 29 games.

MIKE MOUSTAKAS (2-for-3, 2B, 2 R, BB) is 6-for-11 with a double, two runs, one RBI, one walk and one HBP in three games at Wrigley Field this season.

NOTES: The Brewers have won six of their last eight games vs. the Cubs.

© The Brewers are 15-5 in their last 20 games.

© Jonathan Schoop (0-for-2, RBI, BB, SF) has 11 RBI in his last five games.

© Christian Yelich (1-for-4, BB) has reached base in a season-high 26-straight games, the longest active streak in the N.L. ... one game shy of his career-high 27 game on-base streak set in 2014.

© Erik Kratz (2-for-4, 2B) notched his first multi-hit game since August 24 vs. Pittsburgh.
