THE GIANTS: Return home tonight to begin a seven-game homestand against the Reds (three games) and Rockies (four)...the Giants snapped a season-long six-game losing streak with a 5-0 win at Pittsburgh yesterday...the Reds, meanwhile enter tonight having won a season-best six-consecutive games after sweeping the Dodgers in a four-game set in LA, their first four-game sweep at LA since 1976.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVES: Prior to tonight's game the Giants made the following roster moves: IF Alen Hanson placed on the 10-day disabled list (retroactive to May 13) with a left hamstring strain...OF Austin Slater (#53) has been recalled from triple-A and will be active for tonight's game.

ROAD TRIP RECAP: San Francisco concluded their 10-game road trip yesterday with a record of 4-6 (3-0 at ATL, 0-4 at PHI, 1-2 at PIT)...the Giants began the trip 5.0 games behind the Diamondbacks in the NL West and despite the 4-6 record, actually gained 0.5 game in the standings as they enter play tonight just 4.5 back in the West.

HOT AT HOME: The Giants return home where they have been one of MLB's hottest teams since late April, winning seven of their last 10 games here at AT&T Park...only the Yankees (11-2, .846), Pirates (7-2, .778) and Cubs (10-3, .769) have a better home winning pct. than the Giants (.700) since April 23.

2 AWAY FROM 1,500 HITS: OF Andrew McCutchen is just two hits shy from reaching 1.500 hits in his MLB career.

A PAIR OF STREAKS: McCutchen enters tonight having HIGHEST BATTING AVG. THIS hit safely in a season-high 12 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the NL and the second-longest in the big leagues behind Cleveland's Francisco Lindor (14 games)...McCutchen has also reached base safely via hit, walk or hit by pitch in his last 23 games, the secondlongest active streak in MLB behind Philadelphia's Odubel Herrera (41 games).

CRAWFORD IN MAY: IF Brandon Crawford, who batted .190 (15-for-79) with five extra base hits and three RBI in 24 games last month, is hitting .404 (19-for-47) with five extra base hits and 10 RBI in 12 games this month...his .404 batting average in May is the third-best in the Majors.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Giants are hitting .230 with runners in scoring position this season, the fifth-lowest figure among NL teams.

NOT A GOOD WEEK FOR THE WEST: All five NL West teams combined for an 8-24 (.250) record this past week, May 7-13, with Arizona at 1-5, Colorado going 2-4, San Francisco at 1-6, Los Angeles at 1-5 and San Diego posting a record of 3-4.

BELTING: IF Brandon Belt is one of four NL players to lead his team in hits, slugging percentage and on-base percentage.

AGAINST RIGHTIES: The Giants are just 9-14 against right-handed starters this season (11-7 against left-handed starters)...tonight will be the 11th-straight game the Giants will have faced a RH starting pitcher.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#34 RHP Chris Stratton 6-2, 211, 27 years old (August 22, 1990) 3-3 Record, 4.60 ERA

- The 27-year-old right-hander is making his ninth start of the season...the Giants are 5-3 in his outings this year and have been outscored 35-9 in those three losses.
- Last started Wednesday at Philadelphia and was tagged with the loss after allowing five runs on five hits over 4.2 innings pitched...has now allowed four home runs in his last three starts after not allowing a home run in six consecutive starts dating back to last season.
- Missed four days on the Paternity List (April 25-29) when he flew home to Mississippi where he was able to meet his wife, Martha Kate for the birth of their second child, Mary Bennett Stratton, born April 25 at 11:53 p.m.
- Has a 7.88 ERA (7er, 8.0ip) in the first inning and a 3.86 ERA (15er, 35.0ip) in all other innings combined.
- Has never faced the Reds...his 2.08 ERA against the NL Central is his lowest against any division.
- Has a 6.92 ERA (10er, 13.0ip) in three starts at home compared to a 3.60 ERA (12er, 30.0ip) in five starts on the road.
- According to FanGraphs, opponents are hitting .179 (17-for-95) off Stratton this year against his four-seam fastball, .261 (6-for-23) off his curveball, .389 (7-for-18) off his slider, .200 (2-for-10) off his changeup and .444 (4-for-9) off his sinker.
- Threw his curveball 193 times last season and the pitch averaged 3,105 revolutions per minute, according to Statcast - the highest spin rate among all Major League pitchers who threw the curveball at least 50 times.
- Opponents have a .155 career batting average against Stratton's curveball.
