TRIBE HEADLINES

» Cleveland's "magic number" to clinch its third consecutive American League Central title currently stands at five.
» The Indians own a 34-12 (.739) record in series finales, the best winning percentage in the Majors this season, including a 6-3 record in the finale of a four-game series...Tribes starting pitchers have gone 29-6 with a 2.53 ERA (85ER/302.1IP) in finales, including wins in 21 of their last 25 decisions.
» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is 6-1 with a 2.00 ERA (17ER/76.1IP) in 11 starts in day games this season, the 3rd-lowest day ERA in the American League (4th-lowest in MLB)...he is holding hitters from the A.L. East to a .175 opponent batting average in five starts, the 4th-lowest mark against the division this season (min. 30.0IP).
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has reached base in seven straight games and is one steal shy of becoming the third CLE hitter with 30HR/30SB in a season (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008).

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians erupted for seven runs in the 5th inning and held on, defeating the Blue Jays 9-8 yesterday and taking a 2-1 series lead.
» With the win and Minnesota's 4-1 loss vs. Kansas City, the Tribe's "magic number" to clinch the A.L. Central title is now five.
» Cleveland's seven-run 5th inning marked the club's sixth time scoring seven-or-more runs in a single frame, the most in MLB.
» **ROBERTO PÉREZ** led the Tribe offense, going 2-for-4 with two runs scored, a double, a solo homer and a career-high four RBI...both of Pérez's hits came in the 5th inning, marking the second time this season a Tribe hitter had two extra-base hits in a single inning (**JOSÉ RAMÍREZ**, 5th inning, May 3 vs. Toronto - Game 2).
» After Pérez's homer brought the Tribe to within a run in the 5th, **MICHAEL BRANTLEY** (2-4, 45th multi-hit game) hit a two-run homer to give the Indians a one-run advantage...**JASON KIPNIS** (1-5) extended the lead by a run on a bases-loaded walk, setting the stage for Pérez's bases-clearing double to cap off the frame.
» **ADAM PLUTKO** did not factor into the decision, allowing five runs on nine hits (3HR), with four strikeouts in 4.2 innings...marked his fourth career walkless start and second consecutive...**JOSH TOMLIN** tossed 0.2 scoreless innings (1K) to earn his first win of the season, and **CODY ALLEN** (1.0IP, 1H, 1K) shut the Blue Jays down in the bottom of the 9th for his 26th save (6th-most in A.L.).

THE FINISHERS

» The Indians enter play today with a 34-12 record in series finales...Cleveland's .739 win percentage in finales leads all MLB teams...the Tribe has won 11 of its last 13 series finales overall.
» Cleveland owns an 14-8 record in road finales, with wins in five of the last six instances...this weekend's series also marks the Tribe's 10th four-game set, with the club holding a 3-2-4 record in those nine prior series and a 6-3 record in the finales.
» Tribe starting pitchers have excelled in series finales this season, posting a 29-6 record with a 2.53 ERA (85ER/302.1IP), including wins in 21 of their last 25 decisions.

SUNDAY FUNDAY

» Paralleling the club's series finale success, Cleveland owns a 14-8 record (.636) this season on Sunday, the 3rd-best winning percentage in the American League (T6th-best in MLB).
» The Indians lead the Majors with a .281 (219-778) team batting average, 139 runs scored, 53 doubles, 136 RBI and an .836 team OPS on Sundays...the club's 32 home runs on Sundays are tied for 4th-most in the American League and MLB.

OUR FRIENDS IN THE NORTH

» Cleveland is concluding its season series vs. Toronto with a four-game series at Rogers Centre this weekend...the Indians currently hold a 3-2 record this year vs. the Blue Jays and are looking to take the season series for the third time in the last four years.
» The Tribe has outscored Toronto 48-40 across the six games, with Cleveland plating 44 runs over the last four contests.
» The Indians own an all-time record of 208-208-2 (.500) vs. the Blue Jays, as well as a 20-18 (.526) mark since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...the clubs squared off in the 2016 ALCS, with Cleveland winning the series four games to one.

SUNSHINE SUNDAY

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** is due to take the mound in this afternoon's finale, facing the Blue Jays for the second time this year after taking a no-decision on April 13 at Progressive Field (4.0IP, 3H, 1HR, 4R/ER, 2BB, 5K)...owns a career 1-0 record and 6.75 ERA (4ER/5.1IP) in two appearances (one start) against the Blue Jays
» Clevinger will be pitching on regular four days' rest after making his last outing on September 4 vs. Kansas City, earning his 11th win in a quality start (6.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 10K)...needs one more victory to tie his single-season career high (12 in 2017).
» Owns a career 1-0 record and 6.75 ERA (4ER/5.1IP) in two appearances (one start) against the Blue Jays...today's outing will mark his first career start and appearance at Rogers Centre.
» Clevinger has pitched well on the road this season, posting a 5-4 record and 2.88 ERA (26ER/81.1IP) in 13 starts...he has also shined in day games, going 6-1 with a 2.00 ERA (17ER/76.1IP)...entering today's game, owns the 3rd-best day ERA and 7th-best road ERA in the American League.
» Today's outing marks Clevinger's sixth start against an opponent from the A.L. East, posting a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in his five prior outings...he is holding A.L. East hitters to a .175 (20-114) batting average, the 4th-lowest mark against the division (min. 30.0IP).

STRONG STARTERS

» Cleveland's starting rotation enters play today with a franchise-record 26 starts with 10-or-more strikeouts this year, tied with Houston for the most among Major League starting staffs.
» Tribe starting pitchers have recorded 947 strikeouts this season (2nd in MLB, Houston - 983) and have issued just 213 walks (4th-fewest in MLB)...the rotation's collective 4.45 K/BB ratio is the highest in MLB and currently stands as the best mark by a rotation in MLB history...the 2011 Phillies currently hold the full-season record with a 4.22 K/BB ratio.
» The Indians currently boast four pitchers among the American League top 10 in ERA: **TREVOR BAUER** (3rd, 2.22), **COREY KLUBER** (5th, 2.75), **MIKE CLEVINGER** (7th, 3.11) and **CARLOS CARRASCO** (10th, 3.41).

TAKE WHAT'S LEFT

» **FRANCISCO LINDOR** enters today's game batting .364 (51-140) vs. left-handed pitching, the 2nd-highest mark in the American League and 4th-highest in MLB...six of his 33 homers this season have come off of lefties, the most on the Tribe.
» The Indians have gone 19-16 against left-handed starting pitchers this season, including an 8-8 mark on the road...the Tribe's .259 team batting average and .739 team OPS vs. southpaws are 3rd-best and 4th-best in the American League, respectively.

YAN STOPPABLE

» **YAN GOMES** has hit safely in 10 of his last 12 games, batting .370 (17-46) in that span with two homers, two doubles, four RBI and four runs scored...since August 21, he leads all Major League catchers with 17 hits and his .370 average ranks 2nd (min. 20PA).
» Overall, Gomes ranks 5th among A.L. catchers with 13 home runs, while he sits 3rd (min. 200 PA) with a .260 batting average.
» Gomes began his Major League career with Toronto in 2012...in 19 games against his former club he is batting .268 (19-71) with five homers and 12 RBI.

RUNNING MEN

» The Indians currently lead the Majors with 117 stolen bases, 10 more than the next closest club (MIL - 107)...Cleveland looks to lead MLB in steals for the first time in their 118-year history.
» The club's 79.6% success rate on steal attempts ranks 3rd in MLB (Los Angeles-AL - 81.9%, Baltimore - 79.7%).
» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** enters play today with 29 stolen bases, 4th-most in the American League...he is one steal away from logging the 3rd season in club history with 30-plus homers and 30-plus steals (**Joe Carter** - 1987, **Grady Sizemore** - 2008).
» **GREG ALLEN** leads all Major League rookies with 15 stolen bases this season...the last Indians rookie to lead MLB in steals was **Kenny Lofton**, who stole 66 bases in his 1992 campaign.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1938/41: A pair of Cleveland legends make their Major League debuts...in 1938, 21-year-old **Lou Boudreau** enters the game as a defensive replacement in the Tribe's 11-5 loss vs. Detroit and went 0-for-1 with a walk in his first career plate appearance...in 1941, **Bob Lemon** makes his MLB debut as a pinch hitter/third baseman in the Indians' 13-7 win in Philadelphia...Lemon's first career pitching appearance came later, in 1946, after World War II.
