NATIONALS NEWS

LET'S TRY AGAIN

The Washington Nationals open a three-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies on Tuesday with their second doubleheader in the last four days...Monday's game was postponed due to "wet grounds" after both teams decided it was unsafe to play...According to Retrosheet, it was the first game postponed because of "wet grounds" since Sept. 21, 1987, at County Stadium in Milwaukee.

- Since Friday against Chicago, the Nationals have had 6 hours, 23 minutes of play while waiting out 10 hours, 58 minutes of delays.
- The Nationals are 9-4-21 (sweeps-swept-splits) when playing twice in a single day, and 39-29 overall in doubleheaders since baseball returned to Washington in 2005.

WHISPERING SWEEP NOTHINGS

The Washington Nationals swept the Chicago Cubs in Saturday's doubleheader, taking Game 1, 10-3 and coming back to win Game 2, 6-5...It was Washington's first doubleheader sweep since Oct. 3, 2015 at NYM.

- **Max Scherzer** was the story of Game 1...He tossed his second complete game of the season and 10th of his career, striking out 11 batters while allowing three earned runs on nine hits...He did not walk a batter.
- Trailing 4-0 in the bottom of the fourth inning, the Nationals clawed their way back, eventually taking the lead in the seventh inning on a two-run home run by **Bryce Harper**, giving Washington the 6-5 lead.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Bryce Harper was named National League Player of the Week on Monday after hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, two homers, seven RBI, 12 walks, two strikeouts and six runs scored in six games...This award is the first for Harper this season and the ninth taken home by a Nationals player so far in 2018

- He reached base safely in seven of his eight plate appearances during the doubleheader, going 2-for-3 with a home run, two RBI, five walks and three runs scored...Including Saturday, he has reached base safely in 22 of his last 33 plate appearances dating to Sept. 1 vs. Milwaukee (8th inn.).
- Harper has reached base safely in 12 straight games dating to Aug. 25...He has a .526 OBP (11 H, 19 BB) and just nine strikeouts.
- Since the All-Star break, Harper ranks in the National League in doubles (T3rd, 14), RBI (2nd, 37), OBP (3rd, .448), runs (4th, 35), OPS (7th, 1.041) and SLG (10th, .594).
- On the season, he ranks in the NL in homers (T3rd, 32), RBI (7th, 91), OBP (5th, .391), OPS (9th, .899) and SLG (10th, .508).

DOING JUAN SOTO THINGS

Juan Soto has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 games, hitting .358 (19-for-53) with three doubles, one HR, 11 RBI, 10 walks and six runs scored...He is on pace to have one of the best seasons for a teenager in Major League Baseball history (see boxes to the right).

ANTHONY'S SO EXTRA

Anthony Rendon has hit safely in six straight games and has produced at least one extra-base hit in five of the six...During this stretch, he is 10-for-27 (.370) with five doubles, one homer, five RBI, a walk and six runs scored.

- Rendon's 37 doubles this season are tied for fourth in the National League...His career-high for doubles in a season is 41 in 2017.
- He ranks third among National League third basemen in extra-base hits (57) and slugging percentage (.508)

ARMS OF NOTE

Some notes on a few members of Washington's bullpen that have been offering strong relief as of late:

- **Koda Glover** has tossed scoreless relief in seven straight outings dating to Aug. 26...During this stretch, he has allowed just one hit and issued one walk while striking out three batters in 5.2 innings...Opposing batters are 1-for-18 (.056) against him.
- Since Aug. 22, **Matt Grace** has struck out seven batters without issuing a walk in seven straight scoreless outings (5.0 IP)...Opposing batters are hitting .167 (3-for-18) against him during this stretch.
- **Greg Holland** has pitched to a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) with 14 strikeouts and a .114 (5-for-44) opp. AVG since joining Washington Aug. 7.

TURNING IN THE HITS

Trea Turner has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games dating to Aug. 21...During this stretch, he is 21-for-67 (.313) with two doubles, two homers, seven RBI, eight walks, three stolen bases and 11 runs scored...Turner has not been held hitless in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5.

- Turner leads the Nationals with 40 multi-hit games this season and his career-high 156 hits are tied for ninth in the National League.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#23 - ERICK FEDDE - RHP

Former first-round pick (No. 18) in the 2014 First-Year Player Draft has provided depth to Washington's starting rotation since making his debut in 2017...Has made three starts in his Major League career...Entered the 2018 season rated as the No. 3 prospect in Washington's Minor League system per Baseball America...As a starter, has recorded 8.7 strikeouts per nine innings across 60 career Minor League starts.

AGAINST THE PHILLIES: Faces the Phillies for the third time this season...Is 1-1 with a 6.55 ERA in his two starts this season...Faced them twice in a span of a week, June 23 vs. PHI and June 29 at PHI.

LAST START: Returned to action after missing two months with right shoulder inflammation...Allowed four earned runs on four hits with two walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work in the Nationals' 11-8 loss to the Cardinals.

2018 NOTES

- Made three rehab starts before returning to the active roster on 9/4...Recorded a 2.45 ERA (4 ER/14.2 IP) with 13 strikeouts against five walks.
- Allowed just three Triple-A home runs in 14 starts for the Chiefs...All three homers came on May 2 at Lehigh Valley.
- Did not issue a walk in his previous two Minor League starts prior to his promotion on June 13...Has posted a 4.07 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 11 Triple-A starts (61 SO/15 BB).
- He tossed 5.0 innings giving up four runs on six hits, while walking one and striking out three against the New York Yankees on June 13 ...Did not earn a decision in the Nationals 5-4 win over the Yankees.
- Made his first MLB start of the season on May 23 vs. San Diego...Allowed three earned runs on six hits in 5.2 innings of work as the Nationals fell to the Padres, 3-1...Struck out six batters while walking just one.
- Began the season with Triple-A Syracuse...Made eight starts, going 1-1 with 4.35 ERA (20 ER/ 41.1 IP) before being recalled on May 23.
- On May 18 vs. Lehigh Valley (PHI), tossed 6.2 innings, allowing one unearned run on four hits...Struck out six and walked two.
- Fanned a season-high 10 batters on May 7 vs. Scranton-Wilkes/Barre (NYY).
- Started the season strong, allowing three earned runs in 15.0 IP (1.80 ERA) across his first three starts.
- Tossed shutout appearances on April 8 at Scranton-Wilkes/Barre (5.0 IP, 4 H, BB, 2 SO) and April 20 at Louisville (5.0 IP, 2 H, BB 7 SO).

2017 NOTES

- Began the season with Double-A Harrisburg before being promoted to Triple-A Syracuse on June 13...Made seven starts for Harrisburg (2-3, 3.16 ERA, 35 SO, 14 BB, 3 HR) and 10 appearances out of the bullpen (1-0, 2.63 ERA, 19 SO, 4 BB, HR).
- Began his stint with Syracuse in the bullpen (6 G, 1-0, 3.86 ERA, 7 SO, BB) before moving to the rotation (6 GS, 0-2, 5.11 ERA, 18 SO, 4 BB).
- Had his contract selected from Syracuse on July 30...Made his MLB debut that day against Colorado (4.0 IP, 10 H, 7 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO).
- In his second start, Aug. 6 at CHI, struck out seven batters in 5.1 innings of work...Enjoyed four MLB stints with Washington.
- Placed on the 60-day DL on Sept. 4 with a right forearm flexor strain, ending his 2017 season.

2016 NOTES

- Went 8-5 with a 3.12 ERA in 23 games (22 starts) between Single-A Potomac and Double-A Harrisburg.
- Ranked second among Nationals farmhands in ERA (3.12) and fourth in strikeouts (123).
- Posted a 4.24 strikeout-to-walk ratio (123 SO/29 BB).
- Was named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week on July 17.
- From May 23 to Aug. 5, posted a 0.62 ERA (4 ER/57.2 IP), struck out 60 batters and walked 10 while posting a 4-1 record over 11 games (10 starts).
- Entered the season rated as the No. 82 prospect in all of baseball, according to *Baseball America*...For the second straight season, boasted the "Best Slider" in the organization, per BA.

- Pronounced fed-EE...Graduated from Las Vegas High School...Attended the University of Nevada-Las Vegas.
- Was named the 2014 Mountain West Pitcher of the Year and to the All-Mountain West First Team...Named a Louisville Slugger Second-Team All American by Collegiate Baseball and to the midseason Golden Spikes Award watch list.
- A graduate of Las Vegas High School where he played alongside Nationals outfielder Bryce Harper.

#57 - TANNER ROARK - RHP

Right-hander is one of MLB's top unheralded pitching performers...Is 58-50 with a 3.58 ERA in 139 career starts...He has eclipsed the 13-win mark in each of his seasons as a full-time starter (2014, 2016-pres.)...Since 2014, he ranks fifth among MLB starting pitchers in hard-hit rate (25.6%), according to FanGraphs.com...Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 53 of his 139 starts, going 31-11 with a 1.71 ERA in those 53 starts...Helped Team USA bring home the Gold Medal in the 2017 World Baseball Classic...Is stellar with the glove, having committed just two errors in 135 games (67.2 IP) since the start of 2015 - a .985 fielding percentage.

AGAINST THE PHILLIES: Faces the Phillies for the fifth time this season...Is 0-3 with a 4.58 ERA in four previous starts...Has appeared in 21 games (19 starts) against Philadelphia in his career...The 19 starts are his most of any opponent.

LAST START: Suffered his third loss in a row on Sept. 5 vs. St. Louis...Allowed six earned runs on 10 hits...Struck out four batters without issuing a walk for the fourth straight starts..

2018 NOTES

- Has not issued a walk since Aug. 16 at STL (Harrison Bader, 5th inn.), a streak of 21.0 IP spanning five starts...In his last four starts (21.0 IP), he has recorded 15 strikeouts without a walk.
- Since July 25, ranks in the National League in SO/BB (4th, 8.60), opp. OBP (9th, .233) and WHIP (11th, 0.97)
- Ranks tied for seventh in the National League having induced 15 double plays...His 17 quality starts are tied for sixth in the National League.
- Has tossed at least 7.0 innings in 11 of his 28 starts...His 11 starts of at least 7.0 IP rank fifth the National League.
