SAN DIEGO NOTES

- Luis Perdomo** worked a season-high 7.0 IP while also tossing a season-high 111 pitches...allowed three doubles in the fourth inning, tying Robbie Erlin and Jordan Lyles for the most a Friar pitcher has allowed in one frame this season.
 - Has a 9.23 career ERA vs. LAD (41 ER, 40.0 IP), the second-highest ERA of any pitcher vs. the Dodgers (min. five starts) since 1958 (behind Glendon Rusch's 10.95 ERA).
 - Recorded his second hit of the season.
- Wil Myers became the third Padre in club history to hit five home runs in a three-game span, joining Nate Colbert (in 1972) and Brian Giles (in 2007)**...is tied with Jedd Gyorko for the fifth-most home runs by a Padre at Petco Park with 32 (per Jeff Praught).
 - Has hit in eight of his last 10 games and has reached base safely in nine of those 10, going 14-for-37 (.378) with two doubles, a triple, six home runs, 13 RBI and five multi-hit games.
- Eric Hosmer** logged his team-leading 23rd double of the season...since the beginning of June, has hit .286 at Petco Park (14-for-49) with three doubles and a home run.
 - Committed his second error this season (also: April 30 at SF).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Dodgers have won each of Kershaw's last 13 starts against the Padres, tying the Cardinals' Michael Wacha vs. the Reds for the longest active streak by any starter versus an opponent, according to Stats LLC.
- Clayton Kershaw** became the 13th Dodger in franchise history to reach 2000.0 career innings...is now the 11th active pitcher in the Majors to toss 2000.0 or more innings.
 - Earned his third win of the season...is 10-0 with a 0.89 ERA (9 ER, 90.2 IP) over his last 13 starts vs. SD.
- Cody Bellinger** logged his fifth three-hit game of the season...has gone .317 (20-for-63) with five home runs, three doubles and two triples in 15 career road games against the Padres.
- Andrew Toles** went 2-for-3 tonight with two runs scored after being recalled from Triple-A Oklahoma City earlier this afternoon.
