



# SAN DIEGO PADRES 2018 GAME NOTES

**EL SEGUNDO JUEGO:** The Padres look to get back in the win column today in the second of this three-game tilt against Kaitlyn French's Miami Marlins...last night, the Padres were shutout for this sixth time this season in the 4-0 defeat, and the Marlins shut out their opponent for the fifth time in 2018.

- The Padres got most of their production from the top of the order Friday night, with **Jose Pirela** (2-4) and **Eric Hosmer** (2-4, 2B) each turning in multi-hit efforts...**AJ Ellis'** single and **Manuel Margot's** double accounted for the Padres' other two hits.
- Starter **Eric Lauer** tossed a career-high 111 pitches, allowing a career-high seven free passes and three runs on six hits and six strikeouts...it's the most walks by a Padre starter since **Tyson Ross** walked seven on June 6, 2014 at SEA...Lauer recorded his Major League-leading sixth pickoff of the season, picking off Brian Anderson at first base in the third inning...only SEA's **Marco Gonzales** and ATL's **Julio Teheran** rank second with five pickoffs...the Padres' 12 pickoffs lead the majors, ahead of ATL's 11.

**KEEP THE GOOD TIMES ROLLING:** The Padres aim to even the series at one apiece tonight, in an effort for the opportunity to win their fourth consecutive series tomorrow... the last time the Friars won four straight series dates back to August 10-23, 2015 (vs. CIN, @COL, vs. ATL and vs. STL), in which they went 9-3.

- Since May 1 the Padres are 19-16 overall (.543), including 6-7 on the road and 13-9 at home...over the stretch, the Padres rank seventh in the National League in winning percentage (.543) and ninth in ERA (4.12) and SO/9 IP (8.30)

**WHEN IT MATTERS MOST:** Despite going 0-for-1 with RISP/2 out last night, San Diego still has a .283 batting average (65-for-231) in such a scenario...it's the highest mark in the majors this season, and their .485 SLG ranks second... however, the Friars are hitting .222 with nobody on and nobody out, tied for the third-lowest mark in the big leagues.

**DOUBLE MACHINE:** With his 19th double of the season last night, 1B **Eric Hosmer** now ranks tied for first in the NL in two baggers and is on pace for 47 doubles, two shy of the single-season doubles record held by **Tony Gwynn** (49 in 1997).

- The Padres are 21-18 (.538) when **Eric Hosmer** records a hit, compared to 6-16 (.273) when he goes hitless.
- Since May 28, the Padres are 7-4 and Hosmer has hit safely in eight of 11 games with a .439/.477/.585 slash line.

**COASTING UPSTREAM:** A win today would seal the season series against the Marlins...the Padres have won three of the five games played between the two clubs in '18...the Padres went 1-5 against the Fish in '17...a win today would secure their first season series victory since 2015 (5-2).

**YOUTH MOVEMENT:** To begin the series, SD rookies had seen 212 games played by the team's rookies, the second-most games played of any team this season, trailing only the Marlins, who had 220 games played by rookies.

**IN TYSON WE TRUST:** RHP **Tyson Ross** takes the mound tonight and the Padres have recorded the win in each of his last five starts...the Padres are 9-3 on the season when Tyson takes the ball and are 7-0 when he has a quality outing.

**PADRES ON DECK:** INF **Luis Urias**, 21, the Padres' No. 3 prospect, drew walks in all four plate appearances and scored a run for El Paso (AAA) Friday night. ..LF **Josh Naylor**, 20, was 3-for-5 with a RBI and a run scored for San Antonio (AA)...Naylor is hitting .319 and shares the Texas League lead in RBI with 47.

## STARTING PITCHER NOTES

**#38 RHP TYSON ROSS (5-3, 3.31)** @TysonRoss

**TYSON'S TURN:** 31-year-old RHP **Tyson Ross** is set to face the Marlins second time this season...it will be his third career start against the Fish and first at Marlins Park (second appearance)...he is 1-1 with a 3.50 (7 ER, 18.0 IP) with 20 strikeouts against three walks in those three career starts.

**QUALI-TY-SON:** Has seven quality starts in his 12 outings, tying him for the ninth-most in the NL...the Padres are 7-0 when he has a quality outing and 9-3 overall in games which Ross starts.

**STATCASTED:** Starter Tyson Ross has thrown 561 sliders this season, just 13 fewer than his four-seamer (574)...this season, he's relied on a four seamer (47.7%), slider (46.6%) and sinker (5.7%)...opposing batters have hit just .180 this season against his slider and .200 against his sinker.

**THE TYSON WE KNOW & LOVE:** While battling injuries from 2016-17, Tyson posted a 8.12 ERA, a 1.84 WHIP, a .286 opponent batting average and ratios of 6.79 K/9 IP and 1.08 K/BB across 13 appearances (11 starts).

- Over his 99 games (80 starts) from 2013-15, he posted a 3.07 ERA, a 1.23 WHIP, a .232 batting average, and ratios of 9.16 K/9 IP and 2.63 K/BB.
- Returning to form over his 12 starts in 2018, Tyson has posted a 3.31 ERA, 1.22 WHIP, .226 average and ratios of 9.04 K/9 IP and 2.73 K/BB.

**TRIPLE DIGIT TYSON:** Tossed 100-or-more pitches in five consecutive outings from 5/1-23, the longest stretch of his career and the longest by a Padre since James Shields in '16 (May 2-25).

- Ross threw a career-high 127 pitches as he took a no-hitter into the eighth inning on 4/20 at ARI, tossing 7.2 IP of one-hit, one-run ball behind 10 strikeouts, one shy of his career high in the Padres' 4-1 victory.
- Ross' 127 pitches in that game are tied for the most thrown in a single outing this season (CLE Trevor Bauer on 5/27 vs. HOU ...teammate **Clayton Richard** threw the single-game high in 2017 (127 on June 13 vs. CIN).
- His 100.5 pitches per game are the third-most in the NL.

**YOU SHALL NOT PASS FIRST:** Has allowed 18 extra base hits, which is tied for the fourth-fewest among all pitchers (min. 70.0 IP).

**A LITTLE HELP HERE:** Tyson's 3.69 run support average (runs scored while he's in the game) is the fourth-lowest among all qualifying starting NL pitchers.

- His 26 total runs of support are tied for the eighth-fewest among all pitchers with at least 70.0 IP

**ALL-STAR SEASON:** In his first full season as a starter in 2014, he earned his first career All-Star nod and set career highs in starts (31), innings pitched (195.2), strikeouts (195) and ERA (2.81).

- Posted a streak of 14 consecutive quality starts from 6/21 to 9/1 that season, posting a 1.93 ERA over the stretch along with a 9.06 SO/9 IP ratio.
- His 1.88 ERA at Petco was the four-best mark for a home ERA in MLB.

### TOMORROW'S STARTER

**CLAYTON'S TURN:** LHP **Clayton Richard** is set to make his club-leading 14th start of the season tomorrow for the series finale at Marlins Park.

- Over his last six starts, he is 3-2 with a 3.32 ERA (16 ER, 43.1 IP) with 34 strikeouts and seven walks.
- Became the first Padre since **Brian Lawrence** in 2005 to pitch into the eighth inning in three-straight starts from 5/8-19.
- The last Padre to toss at least 7.0-innings-or-more in three straight was **Drew Pomeranz** in 2016.

- Made two starts for the Padres in 2018...is the longest tenured pitcher who has appeared for the Padres at the big league level.

- Since trading closer Brandon Maurer on July 24, 2017, his 36 saves in that time rank second in MLB, behind only SEA Edwin Diaz (37).
- According to Statcast data, 51% of his pitches this season have been sliders...13.9% of his sliders are called strike, the second-highest percentage across Major League relievers.
- Was named the National League Reliever of the month for May, the second such honor of his career (also, July 2017)...pitched to a 0.61 ERA (1 ER, 14.2 IP) during May with a 0.89 WHIP, 22 strikeouts and a .120 opponent average.
- Joined Trevor Hoffman as the only two Padre pitchers (third time) in team history to record 11-or-more saves during the month of May (Hoffman had 12 saves in 2005 and 11 saves in 2007).
- Is just the fourth reliever in Padres history to tally 11 saves in a single month, joining Craig Kimbrel (July 2015), Trevor Hoffman (May 2007, September 2006, May 2005, July 2004, July 1998) and Mark Davis (September 1989, April 1989).
