THE TWINS: After completing their 10-game roadtrip out of the break, going 4-6 (0-3 in Kansas City, 3-0 in Toronto and 1-4 in Boston) the Twins began their six-game seven-day homestand with a win over Cleveland last night...tonight they will play the second of three vs. the Tribe...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale the Twins will enjoy an off-day Thursday, then welcome the Royals for three over the weekend...the Twins have gone 14-8 in their last 22...they are 11-2 in their last 13 home games.

TWINS WALK-OFF TRIBE...AGAIN: The Twins beat the Indians last night by a score of 5-4 in walk-off fashion, the Twins fifth walk-off this season (see below)...Ervin Santana made his second start of the season, allowing four runs on six hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded eight hits, two from Miguel Sanó and two from Mitch Garver, who hit the walk-off double, scoring Ehire Adrianza in the bottom of the ninth...2018 walk-offs below:

WORTH NOTING: Duran made his first start in the organization for Single-A Cedar Rapids yesterday, pitching 7.0 shutout innings over Quad Cities with no hits allowed, one walk and eight strikeouts earning the win.

WELCOME BACK, MAY: The Twins announced today that they have recalled right-handed pitcher Trevor May from Triple-A Rochester...May appeared in 13 games (4 starts) for the Red Wings, going 0-4, 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), 16 walks and 25 strikeouts...May missed the entire 2017 season recovering from "Tommy John" surgery on his right elbow after being diagnosed with a torn ulnar collateral ligament on March 11, 2017...May takes the 25-man roster spot vacated by right-handed pitcher Lance Lynn, who was traded to the New York Yankees yesterday.

TWINS AND TRIBE: The Twins are playing the Indians for the 11th of 19 scheduled meetings this season...they have gone 7-3 vs. the Tribe, 4-1 at Target Field, 1-1 in Puerto Rico and 2-1 at Cleveland...they have won six of their last seven over the Indians...they have won four straight home games over the Indians, their longest streak since winning four straight at Target Field August 15-September 23, 2015...their last five-game win-streak over the Indians at home came September 9, 2012-July 20, 2013 (also 5).

EDDIE'S TRIBE: Eddie Rosario is hitting .349 (76-for-218) with 10 doubles, three triples, 15 home runs, 34 RBI and 39 runs scored in 58 career games vs. Cleveland; the homers, hits and RBI all being his personal most vs. any opponent...he is hitting .418 (28-for-67) in last 16 vs. Tribe...his 76 hits vs. CLE since 2015 lead baseball.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: in 1989, the Twins traded the previous season's AL Cy Young Award winner, Frank Viola, to the Mets for five players, including pitchers Rick Aguilera, David West and minor leaguer Kevin Tapani...Viola became the first Cy Young Award winner to be traded during the following season...in 2014, the Twins acquired Tommy Milone from Oakland, in exchange for outfielder Sam Fuld.

- ☞ Jorge Polanco has hit safely in 15 straight starts, dating back to July 10.
- ☞ Joe Mauer is hitting .315 (35-for-111) with eight doubles, two home runs, 20 RBI and a .353 on-base percentage in his last 27 games.
- ☞ Mauer is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with seven doubles in his career against Bauer.
- ☞ The Twins .846 home winning percentage since June 24, ranks second in baseball, trailing Boston (.875).

SWING AND A MISS: Thus far in 2018, Gibson has recorded 126 strikeouts through 21 starts and owns a strikeout rate of 23.6 percent and a swing-and-miss rate of 28.0 percent...

KEEP THE K'S COMING: Gibson has improved his strikeouts-per-9.0 innings rate nearly every year in his career, setting a career-high in 2017 with 6.89 K/9...

LIMITING THE DAMAGE: Gibson has only allowed 34 XBH this season, tied for eighth fewest allowed in the AL among starters with at least 21 starts...

KILLING TWO BIRDS WITH ONE STONE: Gibson induced 26 double plays in 2017, ranking third in the AL...his 1.48 GDP/9 ranked fourth in baseball among pitchers who throw more than 150 innings in 2017...

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Gibson has held opponents to a .165 average (16-for-97) with runners in scoring position, second best in the AL and fifth best in baseball...

2017 RECAP:

- Was the Twins third starter to begin the season.
• Optioned to Triple-A after six starts, going 0-4 and allowing 24 earned runs over 26.1 innings on 39 hits.
• In return to Twins, recorded his first win on May 22 against Baltimore.
• Won his final six decisions, allowing 11 runs over 31.2 innings in the six wins, notching the longest win streak of his career.

• His 2.85 ERA pre-ASG in 2015 was the fourth-lowest for a Twins starter since 1992 with a minimum of 80.0 IP (Liriano - 1.83 in 2006, Santana - 2.75 in 2007, Radke - 2.77 in 1998).
• In 2014, his first full season in the majors, became one of three pitchers in Twins history to win each of their first three games while posting a sub-1.00 ERA.
• Earned the win in his MLB debut 6/29/13 vs. KC allowing three runs on eight hits in 6.0 innings.
• Named the Twins Minor League Player of the Week for May 12, 2013 after tossing a CG SHO.

• Selected to the 2011 Futures Game where he tossed 1.1 inning, allowing two hits.
• Named to the 2010 Eastern League Mid-Season All-Star Team.
• Named the Florida State League Pitcher of the Week, May 3, 2010.
• Selected in the first round (22nd overall) by the Twins in the 2009 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Missouri as a senior...major was communications.
