BACK IN CINCY: The Padres defeated the Cincinnati Reds 7-6 in the last of the four-game series, finishing the season with a 4-3 record vs. CIN...starter **Jacob Nix** worked just 4.0 innings, allowing seven hits and a career-high six runs...he also walked two and fanned a career-high five batters...**Robert Stock, Rowan Wick, José Castillo, Craig Stammen** and **Kirby Yates** all compiled for 5.0 innings of two-hit, no-run ball...Stammen earned the win (now 7-2), and Yates was credited with the save (his seventh)...at the plate, **Luis Urías, Eric Hosmer** and **Austin Hedges** each contributed a home run.

WE SHALL NOT FORGET: MLB and all 30 Clubs will conduct 9/11 commemorations throughout the league as part of Baseball's ongoing effort to honor and remember those whose lives were affected or lost on that tragic day.



THEY LIKE TO MOVE IT, MOVE IT: The Padres recalled INF **Javy Guerra**, RHP **Kazuhisa Makita**, RHP **Colten Brewer** and LHP **Brad Wieck**...Wieck (pronounced simply as WICK) will wear No. 57, and his first appearance will be his debut...SD has 33 players on its active roster.

GOING FOR 50: The Padres have an all-time record of 49-55 against the Seattle Mariners...San Diego has not won a series @ Safeco Field since they swept the Mariners from June 12-14, 2012 in Seattle...since then, the Padres have won just two of eight games in Seattle (2-6)...a win tonight would be the first time the Friars have won three-straight games against SEA since they won four in a row from June 12-22, 2012.

MITCHELL IN THE MIDDLE: Tonight, RHP **Bryan Mitchell** looks to record his second win in as many appearances, something he has yet to do in his career...in his last time out on Sept. 3 @ ARI, he was awarded the win in 5.0 innings of two-hit ball, allowing one run (earned) on two strikeouts and three walks...he's relied on five pitches this season: four-seamer (57.8%), curve (20.9%), cutter (14.9%), changeup (5.8%) and sinker (0.6%).

HIS NAME IS HEDGES, AND HE'S A HITTIN': **Austin Hedges** has hit in a career-high eight straight games, batting .300 (9-for-30 with 3 2b, 2 3b and 1 hr) since Aug. 29...he has also hit in 10 of his last 11 contests (.279, 12-for-43), and he has an extra-base hit in six of his last seven games, in which he's accrued a 1.049 OPS (.357 OBP & .692 SLG).

NO REST FOR THE DOMINANT: Since the All-Star break, the Padres bullpen has the second-best ERA in the NL (3.30) next to just Pittsburgh's 3.24...in the second half of the season, the SD bullpen has the best opponent clip in the NL (.222).

PLAY AT THE PLATE: The Mariners lead the majors this season in runs scoring from second base when a single is hit (94)...SD ranks last in that category (66).

AND NONE FOR GRETCHEN WIENERS: Seattle has been caught stealing 34 times this season, tied for fourth-most in the majors...they've been caught stealing second 31 times, the third-most in the ML.

PADRES ON DECK *POSTSEASON ADDITION: Tonight in Tulsa, San Antonio (AA) opens the best-of-five Texas League Championship Series...the Missions seek a second Texas League title since joining the Padres family of affiliates in 2007 (San Antonio defeated Arkansas for the 2013 Texas League title)...after the conclusion of the 2018 Texas League Championship Series, San Antonio will be leaving the Texas League to join the Triple-A Pacific Coast League...starting tonight's series opener will feature RHP **Michel Baez**, the Padres' No. 7 prospect...RHP **Emmanuel Ramirez** will start the second game in Tulsa, and RHP **Jesse Scholtens** will get the ball in Game 3 in San Antonio.

STARTING PITCHER NOTES

#50 RHP Bryan Mitchell (1-3, 6.58)

BRYAN'S TURN: 27-year-old RHP Bryan Mitchell is set to make his second start since being reinstated from the 10-day DL (right elbow impingement) on 9/1...tonight is his first career start and appearance against Seattle.

IN THE WIN COLUMN: Earned his first win as a Padre and his first since 4/2/17 while with NYY his last time out on 9/3 at ARI...tossed 5.0 IP of one-run ball, allowing just two hits in the Padres' 6-2 victory.

GOING FOR CONSECUTIVE W'S: With a win today, it would be the first time Mitchell has ever received a victory in back-to-back appearances.

WHAT'S HE GOT!?: This season, he's relied on five pitches: four-seamer (57.8%), curve (20.9%), cutter (14.9%), changeup (5.8%) and sinker (0.6%).

AL IN: Tonight will be his second appearance this season vs. an American League club (first one April 7 @ HOU, in which he worked 5.2 innings of three-hit and no-run ball)...as a starter vs. AL teams, he has a career 2.45 ERA (12 er, 44.0 ip) in nine starts.

WHILE YOU WERE AWAY While on the DL, Mitchell made six rehab appearances (all starts) with Lake Elsinore (A) from 8/2-27, posting a combined 4.13 ERA (13 ER, 28.1 IP) and a 1-3 record with 28 strikeouts against 12 walks.

- He most recently had tossed a season-high 7.0 IP in his last outing on 8/27 at Lancaster, allowing five runs (four earned) with five strikeouts and two walks.

STARTER VS. RELIEVER: Mitchell made seven starts to begin the season from 4/2 to 5/5, going 0-3 with a 6.47 ERA (23 ER, 32.0 IP) as a starter...was moved to bullpen after his start on 5/5 and made five relief appearances, posting an 8.27 ERA (15 ER, 16.1 IP)...after his most recent start, he is now 1-3 with a 5.84 ERA (24 ER, 37.0 IP).

BACK ME UP: The Padres are 3-5 in games which Mitchell has started...he has received more than two runs of support on just two occasions (four on 4/17 vs. LAD and 9/3 at ARI).

- His 15 total runs of support as a starter (runs scored while he's in the game) are tied for the second-fewest among pitchers with at least 37.0 IP...his 3.65 run support average is the 11th-fewest among NL such NL starters.

NO FREE PASSES: Mitchell has issued 38 walks compared to 25 strikeouts...his 0.66 SO/BB ratio is the lowest in the majors and his 6.41 BB/9.0 IP ratio is the second-highest in the majors (min 53.0 total IP).

KEPT IN CHECK: Mitchell and the rest of the Padres pitching staff didn't surrender an extra-base hit to the Astros in the first two games of their series on 4/6 & 4/7...it was the first time Houston was held without an extra-base hit in back-to-back contests since September 17-18, 2014 vs. CLE.

- Mitchell tossed 5.2-shutout innings on 4/7 at HOU, allowing just three hits but a career-high six walks in SD's 1-0 extra-inning defeat.

TOMORROW'S STARTER — #37 LHP Joey Lucchesi (7-8, 3.59) — joeyfuego23

LET'S GET FUEGO: LHP Joey Lucchesi is set to make the 23rd start of his career and his second in his last three outings against the Seattle Mariners tomorrow.

- It will be his fourth start against an AL opponent...is 1-1 with a 3.65 ERA (5 ER, 12.1 IP) in his three previous Interleague starts.
- Along with LHP Eric Lauer this season, is one of just 20 rookies to have reached the 20-start plateau in Padres franchise history...prior to Dinelson Lamet (2017) and Luis Perdomo (2016), the most recent Friar rookie arm to do so was Justin Germano in 2007.
