FISH BITES

The Marlins continue a seven-game road trip with game two of this four-game series against the Philadelphia Phillies tonight at 7:05 p.m. RHP **Trevor Richards**, making his 16th career start, is facing the Phillies for the third time this season, having gone 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0 ip/3 er). Philadelphia is countering with RHP Vince Velasquez, who in seven career starts against the Marlins has gone 3-1 with a 2.63 ERA (37.2/11). The Marlins concluded a 3-3 homestand Sunday, splitting a two-game series with the Braves and a four-game set against the Nationals. The current road swing began with Miami dropping two games to the Atlanta Braves, with the final game being postponed due to weather. Tonight's game continues a stretch of 12 straight games (3-6) against NL East opponents. Miami plays 35 of their remaining 51 games (71%) against division foes.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami took a 2-1 lead into the bottom of the ninth, but Philadelphia came away with a 5-2 walk-off win. The Marlins turned a scoreless game into a 2-0 lead in the fourth after **Justin Bour** deposited his 17th home run of the season into right-center, a two-run shot to score **J.T. Realmuto**. **Pablo López** tossed 5.0 scoreless innings before surrendering a solo home run in the sixth, and left after 6.0 full innings with a 2-1 lead. The Marlins recorded just one hit over the final five innings leading to the fateful ninth. **Derek Dietrich** recorded two of Miami's five hits to up his season total of multi-hit games to 27, a new career high. López finished his night with one run on five hits, no walks and five strikeouts in 6.0 frames. **Kyle Barraclough** fell to 0-5 with the loss.

RISING STOCK

Over his last seven starts since June 23, **Trevor Richards** has posted a 2-1 record with a 2.65 ERA (37.1/11), limiting opponents to two or fewer runs five times, and 1-or-zero runs four times. His ERA in that span ranks 10th in the National League (min. 37.0 ip). He has surrendered just one home run in that time frame, which is tied with Zack Godley, Miles Mikolas, and Aaron Nola for the fewest in the Senior Circuit. Over the month of July, Richards pitched to a 1-0 record and 2.30 ERA (27.1/7) in five starts. His seven runs allowed were tied with five others for the third fewest in the NL (min. 25.0 ip), behind Zack Greinke and Derek Rodriguez, who both allowed six.

STEPPING UP

Trevor Richards is looking to continue a hot streak by Marlins rookie starters. Over the last six combined starts between **Pablo López** and Richards, the pair has combined on a 2-1 record and 1.73 ERA (36.1/7), with 26 hits allowed, eight walks and 32 strikeouts. Richards has allowed just one run over his last 18.2 innings, while Lopez has allowed six earned over his last 17.2 frames.

RUN ALONG, ROOKIE

Adding to what has already been a breakout season, **Brian Anderson** is continuing to be one of the main contributors to Miami's offense. He has accounted for 14.9% of the Marlins run total, which is the fifth-highest percentage by a rookie in the last 50 years. Mike Trout accounted for 16.8% of the Angels team run total in 2012, while Hanley Ramirez owned 15.7% of the Marlins total in 2006. Ron Gant had 15.3% of Atlanta's runs in 1988, and Ryne Sandberg accounted for 15.2% of the Cubs total in 1982. - Stats LLC

HISTORY REPEATS ITSELF

Miami began the season with just a .225 team average over its first 28 road games, which ranked 27th in the Majors. Over their last 25 road games since June 1, the Marlins have hit at a .269 clip to rank third in the Majors behind Atlanta (.273) and Oakland (.272). Since 2014, Miami leads the Majors in road average with a .261 mark, ahead of Houston (.259) and Kansas City (.256).

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

When facing a pitcher for the third time in a game, the Marlins have hit .306, which leads the National League and ranks second in the Majors to only Boston (.328). The .306 average when facing a pitcher for the third time would go down as the second-highest in Franchise history, as the current best is a .307 mark in 2001. - Stats LLC

ROAD WELL TRAVELED

The Marlins have two of the best road hitters in the National League in **Derek Dietrich** and **J.T. Realmuto**, as Dietrich ranks 10th in the NL with a .320 average and Realmuto 14th at .315. Dietrich has hit in 11 of his last 14 road contests, batting .420 (21x50) with four doubles, five home runs, and nine RBI in that span. He has scored 35 runs in visiting ballparks this season, tied for 10th in the NL, while his .396 OBP and .539 SLG rank 10th. Realmuto has hit in 14 of his last 16 road games with an average of .338 (23x68), seven doubles, three home runs, and 14 RBI. The All-Star catcher ranks seventh in the NL on the road this season with a SLG of .567, T-14th in runs with 34, and 21st with an OBP of .374.

FLIPPING THE M

Since June 5, the Marlins have gone 26-25, and have won nine of 16 series in that span (two splits), including consecutive series wins against then-first-place Milwaukee and Philadelphia to end the first half. Miami opened the season 20-39, and dropped a season-high six straight games just prior to this current stretch.

ONE TOUGH SHRIMP

The Southern League today announced that Jacksonville RHP **Dylan Lee** today was named the BC Relief Pitcher of the Month after going 1-0 with three saves in three changes in 15.0 scoreless innings over 12 appearances with the Jumbo Shrimp. He allowed just five hits, walked one and struck out 19. Not included in those totals was a scoreless 2.0-inning outing (1 H, 4 SO) with Triple-A New Orleans on July 29 after being promoted the day before.

PROVING HIS WORTH

In his final game before the break, **Brian Anderson** recorded his sixth three-hit game of the season to run his season hit total to 109. His hit total prior to the break tied Rocco Baldelli for the second-most by a Major League rookie since 2003, behind only Hideki Matsui (114 in 2003). He is the only Marlins rookie in franchise history to record 100+ hits prior to the break.

- Anderson recorded 101 hits over his first 92 games of the season, becoming the 142nd rookie since 1958 to record 100+ hits in 92-or-fewer games. Of those, 34 went on to win Rookie of the Year honors, including most recently Aaron Judge (2017), Corey Seager (2016), Carlos Correa (2015), José Abreu (2014), Mike Trout (2012) and Buster Posey (2010). - Stats LLC
- He leads all MLB rookies in games (109), at-bats (423), hits (120), multi-hit games (35), three+-hit games (7, tied), average with RISP (.398), runs (63), on-base percentage (.364), and RBI (51); ranks second in doubles (24, tied), average (.284), and slugging (.418); is tied for second in walks (43); is tied for third in triples (3), and tied for ninth in HR (9).
- He is on pace for 176 hits this season, which would rank as the second-most by a National League rookie since 2010, behind Corey Seager's 193 in 2016, and would tie Ryan Zimmerman for the sixth-most by a rookie since 2000. He is also on pace to score 92 runs, which would rank as the ninth-most by a rookie since 2000.

AUGUST 3

In **2010**, Dan Uggla recorded his 144th home run as a Florida Marlin, surpassing Mike Lowell (143) as the Franchise Leader at the time. The Marlins lost the game, 6-1, to Philadelphia, as Uggla's solo-shot would be the lone run scored. In **1993**, Charlie Hough and Bryan Harvey combined to allow just six hits and a walk, with five strikeouts, while recording the Franchise's third shut-out win.

YOUNG GUNS

Of the Marlins' 46 wins this season, 23 have been recorded by rookie pitchers (50.0 pct.). Overall, have 10 different rookies own a win. The 10 different rookies to record a win are tied with three teams for fifth-most in a single season in MLB history. The 2017 Reds, '07 Yankees, '03 Tigers and '02 Padres each had 11. - Stats LLC
