SAN DIEGO NOTES

- The Padres secured their fourth walk-off win of the season and their first since August 18 vs. ARI...it was the first walk-off home run for the Padres this season and the first since Yangervis Solarte did so on September 2, 2017 vs. LAD (Game 1).
 - The Padres' four walk-off wins in 2018 are their most since they secured eight walk-off victories in 2016.
- **Eric Lauer** tossed 5.0-hitless innings today, improving to a 3.09 ERA (15 ER, 43.2 IP) in eight career starts vs. NL West teams while allowing three earned runs or less in seven of those outings...has worked 5.0 innings-or-more in 10 of his 12 starts since June 2.
 - Has pitched to a 5-2 record when he throws at least 5.0 innings with a 2.33 ERA (19 ER, 73.1 IP) and a .259 opponents' batting average.
- **Franmil Reyes** belted his first career walk-off hit and his 12th home run of the season...Reyes has hit in eight of his last nine games (.455, 10-for-22 with a double and three homers)...has hit .438 (7-for-16) in six games vs. COL.
- **Hunter Renfro** extended his hitting streak to seven straight games, batting .367 (11-for-30) in that time with a double, a home run and eight RBI since August 23 at COL.
- **Austin Hedges** logged his first career triple in the second inning.
- **Luis Urías** recorded his first career stolen base in the ninth inning.
- **Wil Myers** recorded his first-career multi-error game.

COLORADO NOTES

- Rockies pitchers combined to record 16 strikeouts, the ninth time in team history they've accomplished this feat and the fourth time against the Padres (last: April 25 vs. SD)...Colorado's franchise record is 17 combined strikeouts.
- **German Márquez** recorded a career-high 13 strikeouts tonight, surpassing his previous career-high of 10 strikeouts (4x; last: August 8 vs. PIT)...the last Rockies pitcher to tally 13-or-more strikeouts in a game was Jon Gray when he struck out a career-best 16 batters on September 17, 2016 vs. SD...Márquez is the fifth pitcher in Rockies' history to strike out at least 13 batters.
 - Has tossed seven consecutive quality starts since July 29, the longest streak by a Rockies pitcher this season and the first Rockies starter to do so since Jhoulys Chacin in 2013...he's posted a 2.17 ERA (12 ER, 49.2 IP) in that span with 61 strikeouts against 10 walks.
 - His 8.0 IP tie a career high (3x; last: June 30 at LAD).
- **Carlos González** has hit safely in seven straight games (.375, 12-for-32)...is batting .324 (90-for-278) since May 27.
- **Matt Holliday** has hit safely in five straight games, going 5-for-12 (.417) in that time.
- **Charlie Blackmon** swiped his ninth stolen base of the season.
