**THE GIANTS:** Will attempt to win their fourth-straight game today in the final game of this three-game set against the Cincinnati Reds.

**INSIDE THE SERIES:** A win today and the Giants would earn their second sweep of the season and their first against the Reds in a three-game set since May 3-5, 2002...the Giants have won their last five games against Cincinnati dating back to last season...the Giants have outscored the Reds by a 29-16 margin during this five-game win streak.

**HOT AT HOME:** The Giants have been one of MLB's hottest teams since late April, winning nine of their last 12 games here at AT&T Park...only the Yankees (11-2, .846) and Pirates (8-2, .800) have a better home winning pct. than the Giants (.750) since April 23.

**AGAINST HARVEY: IF Brandon Belt, OF Andrew McCutchen and C Buster Posey** all have home runs in their careers against today's opposing starter Matt Harvey, who has never beaten the Giants in three starts (0-2, 5.68)...McCutchen is 4-for-9 (.444) lifetime against Harvey while Posey is 5-for-8 (.625) in his career.

**CRAWFORD IN MAY: IF Brandon Crawford** recorded four more hits last night and now has nine hits in his last 12 at-bats...beginning May 1, Crawford has hit .455 (25-for-55) with seven doubles, a homer and 12 RBI in 14 games...his .455 batting average this month is the best among all big league players...Crawford has raised his batting average from .189 to his current .290 mark in his last 14 games.

**BELT'S SPLASH HOMER: IF Brandon Belt** hit his eighth home run of the season last night, tied with **IF Evan Longoria** for the team lead...Belt's homer was also his eighth career "Splash Hit" home run, tied with **IF Pablo Sandoval** for the second-most all-time in the 19-year history of AT&T Park, trailing only **Barry Bonds** (35)...Belt has now homered in his last four-straight games against the Reds.

**CLOSE CALLS:** The Giants have played 23 games this year that have been decided by just two runs or fewer, the fifth-most games in the Majors behind Arizona (25), Washington (25), Detroit (25) and Milwaukee (24)...SF is 13-10 in such games.

**RUNS AT HOME:** San Francisco is averaging 5.11 runs per game at AT&T Park this season (97 runs in 19 games)...only the Pirates (5.68 r/g), Cubs (5.57), Braves (5.50) and Phillies (5.41) are averaging more runs at home than the Giants.

**AGAINST RIGHTIES:** The Giants are just 11-14 against right-handed starters this season (11-7 against left-handed starters)...today will be the 13th-straight game the Giants will have faced a RH starting pitcher.

**WITH RISP:** The Giants are hitting .235 with runners in scoring position and .193 with runners in scoring position and two outs.

**ON DECK:** Following this series the Giants will host the Colorado Rockies for the first time this season in a four-game set starting tomorrow night...the Giants went 7-12 against the Rockies last season, but went 6-3 here at AT&T Park.

**ON THE MOUND:** The Giants starting pitchers have pitched past the 5th inning just three times in the last 10 games (Suarez, Samardzija and Holland)...the rotation has combined for a 6.14 ERA (33er, 48.1ip) in this stretch.

**Jason Schmidt** struck out 13 of the 28 batters he faced as the Giants defeated the Mets by a score of 7-5...**Edgardo Alfonzo** went 2-for-4 and drove in four runs against his former squad.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#59 LHP Andrew Suárez**  
**6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)**  
**1-2 Record, 4.57 ERA**

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his fifth career Major League start...has gone 1-2 with a 4.57 ERA (11er, 21.2ip) in four outings, with the Giants going 1-3 in those games.
- Was tagged with the loss in his last start at Pittsburgh on Friday, the shortest of his young career...gave up five runs on seven hits over 4.0 innings in SF's 11-2 loss to the Pirates.
- Has been recalled twice from triple-A Sacramento, first on April 11 to make a spot start and again on May 1 as the Giants needed an extra starter due to a doubleheader April 28...with **RHP Johnny Cueto** being placed on the 10-day disabled list May 1, Suárez slid into the Giants' starting rotation.
- Has registered 23 strikeouts while allowing just four walks in 21.2 innings in his big league career.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .154 clip (4-for-26) with eight strikeouts...righties are hitting .333 (18-for-54) off him.
- Opponents are hitting just .129 (4-for-31) off his slider this year and .360 (9-for-25) off his fastball.
- Made his Major League debut April 11 against the Diamondbacks...he became the sixth pitcher to make his MLB debut in a start for the Giants over the last 10 seasons (2009-18), which ranks as the fewest among all NL clubs.
- Was named an Organizational All-Star by MiLB.com following the 2017 season.
- Entered the season with a career 21-18 minor league record with a 3.24 ERA (122er, 338.2ip) in three seasons.
- Was drafted by San Francisco in the second round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft...entered the season as the 10th-best prospect in the Giants' organization according to MLB.com.
- Attended the University of Miami and was named a third-team All-ACC selection in 2013.
