## 2018 NOTES

- Had his contract selected by Miami on August 15, his first call-up to the Major Leagues.
- Between Double-A Jacksonville and Triple-A New Orleans, he combined to hit .345 (137x397) with 71 runs scored, 20 doubles, five triples, 12 home runs, 68 RBI, 39 walks against 56 strikeouts, a .410 on-base percentage, and a .511 slugging percentage.
- The 12 home runs mark a new single-season career high.
- At the time of his selection, his 137 hits ranked tied for eighth among all minor leaguers. Also, he was tied for fourth in the Pacific Coast League in average (.326; 103x316) and ranked seventh in OBP (.397).
- Had two-homer games on August 11 vs. Iowa with Baby Cakes and April 22 at Tennessee with Jumbo Shrimp.
- Had 39 multi-hit games in 109 outings between his two Minor League clubs, including 10 three-hit games and three four-hit games (April 11 vs. Mobile, May 15 vs. Omaha, August 4 at Albuquerque).
- Opened the season at Jacksonville and appeared in 22 games in April, batting .420 (34x81) with 13 runs scored, eight doubles, a triple, three home runs, 14 RBI, a .466 OBP, and a .654 SLG.
- Performance earned him Southern League Player of the Month award, his first career Monthly award.
- Was also named SL Player of the Week for April 16-22 after batting .520 (13x25) with six runs scored, three doubles, a triple, two homers, six RBI, a .571 OBP, and a .960 SLG in seven games.
- Had an 18-game on-base streak from April 5-24 (.500; 32x64).
- Was promoted to New Orleans on April 29.
- In 87 games with Baby Cakes prior to being selected by Miami, batted .326 (103x316) with 58 runs scored, 12 doubles, four triples, nine home runs, 54 RBI, a .397 OBP, and a .475 SLG.
- Named PCL Player of the Week for August 6-12 after batting .647 (11x17) with seven runs scored, three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .700 OBP, and a 1.353 SLG in five games. It marked his second Weekly award of the season, and the third of his career (also, May 4-10, 2015 in Florida State League).
- At time of his selection, was batting .465 (20x43) in 11 games in August, with 15 runs scored, seven doubles, four home runs, and 12 RBI.
- Had a six-game hitting streak when selected (.571; 12x21, 7 RS, 3 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI).
- Also had a hit in 18 of last 21 games for the Baby Cakes (.420; 34x81, 8 2B, 4 HR, 19 RBI since July 19).
- Had a 17-game on-base streak from May 30-June 18 (.313; 21x67).

## 2017 SUMMARY

- Spent most of season with Jacksonville, missing time on disabled list from April 15-July 3.
- Limited to 61 games with Jumbo Shrimp.
- Hit .273 (6x22) in first six games prior to DL stint, then hit .250 (8x32) in first nine games after being reinstated.
- Hit .289 over his final 46 games (July 13-September 4); had hitting streaks of 10 games (.410; 16x39, from July 28-August 7) and nine games (.359; 14x39 from July 13-23) in that time.

## MINOR LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Named a Southern League Midseason All-Star in 2016 for Jacksonville, batting .261 (65x249) with 32 runs scored, 13 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 42 RBI, and 32 walks in the first half.
- Posted two-homer games on May 10 at Biloxi and May 31 vs. Montgomery.
- Spent 2015 with Single-A Jupiter in Florida State League, earning Midseason All-Star honors.
- Batted .282 (77x273) in first half, with 37 runs, 19 doubles, two triples, three homers, and 29 RBI in 68 games.
- Earned first career Weekly award for period of May 4-10, when he hit .478 (11x23) with six runs scored, four doubles, a triple, and eight RBI.
- Spent all of 2014 season with Single-A Greensboro in the South Atlantic League, earning Midseason All-Star honors after batting .288 (55x191) with 26 runs scored, nine doubles, two triples, three home runs, and 25 RBI in first half.
- Combined to hit .368 (56x152) in 38 games in June and July.
- Posted career-long 16-game hitting streak from June 28-July 13, batting .403 (27x67) with three doubles, a triple, four home runs, and 18 RBI, including a five-RBI game on June 28 at Asheville.



- Posted a 12-game hitting streak from July 17-30, batting .408 (20x49) with a home run and five RBI.
- Between start of 16-game streak and end of 12-game streak, posted a hit in 28 of 30 games, batting .385 (47x122) with 28 runs scored; had a pair of seven-game streaks with at least one run scored during that time.
- Opened **2013** at Short-Season A Batavia. After posting .170 average in opening month, combined to hit .295 (49x166) in July and August, earning promotion to Greensboro on August 21 for his final seven games of the season.

## PERSONAL/MISCELLANEOUS

- Austin James Dean...attended Klein Collins HS in Spring, Texas...was named a preseason All-American by *Baseball America* prior to his senior season, and ranked No. 84 in the nation by Perfect Game USA...batted .379 with 12 homer runs and 45 RBI as a senior, earning All-Greater Houston Team and Texas Coaches Association All-State Team honors...had scholarship offer to University of Texas prior to signing with Marlins.
