SAN DIEGO NOTES

- **Bryan Mitchell** made his Padres debut and his first start since July 17, 2017 (his only start last season)...he collected his first-career hit in the second inning, beating out an infield single...his five extra-base hits and four doubles allowed are both the most he's allotted in a single game his career.
- **Eric Hosmer** went 2-for-4, and he now has four doubles in his last three games...he has doubled in three consecutive games on four occasions previously (last: June 26-28, 2016), but he has never doubled in four consecutive games in his career.
- **Wil Myers** homered in the first inning, and his 14 career homers against Colorado are the most he's had against any club...he has a career .317 average against COL (63-for-199).
- The Padres have not lost four games to open a season since they dropped four consecutive games to begin the 1994 season...the last time the Padres lost five straight at the season's inception was in 1988 (also lost five in '87)...the most consecutive losses San Diego has sustained to start a campaign dates back to six losses to begin the 1974 season.

COLORADO NOTES

- **Carlos Gonzalez** went 2-for-5 in the game, surpassing Vinny Castilla for fourth-most hits in Rockies franchise history (1,207).
- **Charlie Blackmon** hit two doubles and a home run, one game after he logged his ninth career multi-home run game...Blackmon had five multi-double games last season, and it's the fifth time in his career in which he's had multiple extra-base hits in consecutive games...he has never gone three straight games with more than one extra-base hit in each game.
- **DJ LeMahieu** followed Blackmon with a home run of his own, marking the first time this season the Rockies have gone back-to-back.
- Tonight's game represented the first of 19 the Padres will play against the Rockies in 2018, and the teams will meet nine more times just this month.
