OAKLAND NOTES

- With a double in the bottom of the first inning **Jed Lowrie** snapped an 0-for-17 hitless streak.
- **Paul Blackburn** went 1.1 innings, his shortest career outing and gave up a career high eight runs.
- **Emilio Pagan** recorded 2.2 innings in relief, his longest outing of the season.
- After going 0 for his last 14, **Khris Davis** snapped this streak by going 3-for-4 with a single and two solo home runs... Davis now has 18 career multi home run games... his third of the season (last: 6/8/18 vs. Kansas City)
- **Stephen Piscotty** knocked in three RBI for the second time this season...his sixth multi RBI game this season.
- **Jake Smolinski** made his professional debut as a pitcher when he pitched the ninth inning (1.0 ip, 2 h, 2 r, 2 er, 1 hr)...it was the 12th time in Oakland history a position player pitched, the first time since Tyler Ladendorf on June 3, 2016 at Houston...it was the first time at the Coliseum...it was just the second time in those 12 appearances a position player allowed a run or a home run...the other was Frank Menechino on July 18, 2000 at Colorado (1.0 ip, 6 h, 4 r, 4 er, 1 hr).
- Oakland has now lost nine of their last 11 games facing AL West competition.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **George Springer** has now hit safely in all eight games against the A's this season, and is .432 (16-for 37) hitter facing Oakland in 2018.
- Springer also has the most hits vs. the Athletics than any other player in the Major Leagues.
- **Evan Gattis** has hit nine home runs with 25 RBI in his last 15 games... he is 17-for-59 in this span...recorded back to back 4+ RBI games for the first time in his career...is the 11th player in Astros history to record 4+ RBI in back-to-back games.
- With two home runs Gattis now has two multi home run games this season...his 10th of his career.
- **Gerrit Cole** has won 3 consecutive starts for the first time this season.
- Cole gave up a season high four runs.
- The Astros hit back-to-back home runs for the third time this season...Gattis/Gonzalez in the second inning
- Yuli Gurriel collected three hits for the first time this season...his 13th three hit game of his career.
- The Astros have now won seven straight...their longest winning streak of the season.
