WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have won eight of their last 11 games, 14 of 20 and 19 of 31 as they continue a 10-game, 11-day homestand tonight vs. Detroit.
- RHP Lucas Giolito, who is 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (8 ER/25.1 IP) and 27 strikeouts over his last three starts, is scheduled to start for the White Sox.
- The Sox are 3-2 on the homestand, rallying yesterday for a 4-2 victory over the Tigers after splitting a four-game series with Boston over the weekend.
- Following this three-game series and a day off on Thursday, the Sox conclude the homestand with three games vs. the Angels (9/7-9) before taking a nine-game, 11-day trip to Kansas City (8/10-12), Baltimore (8/14-16) and Cleveland (8/18-20).
- The Sox went 5-2 on their last trip to Detroit (3-1) and New York-AL (2-1) from 8/23-29, including their first series win at Yankee Stadium since 2005.

TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- The White Sox are in sole possession of third place in the American League Central for the first time since 4/15.
- The Sox have won six of their last seven games vs. Detroit (37-23 margin) after losing nine of the first 10.
- The White Sox own a 2.75 ERA (30 ER/98.1 IP) over the last 11 games, the best mark in the American League ... the starters have posted a 2.01 ERA (15 ER/67.0 IP) during that span.
- The Sox are hitting .274/.332/.464 (150-524) with 31 home runs and 116 runs scored over the last 22 games (5.3 R/G).
- Yolmer Sánchez has reached base safely in a career-high 22 consecutive games (.414 on-base percentage), the longest streak by a Sox player since José Abreu (29) from 8/2-9/2/16.

ROSTER MOVES

- Prior to tonight's game, the White Sox purchased the contract of RHP José Ruiz from Class AA Birmingham and outrighted INF Matt Skole to Class AAA Charlotte.
- The White Sox active roster increases to 30, and the 40-man roster remains at 40.

YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- Daniel Palka hit a game-tying solo home run off Shane Greene with no outs in the ninth inning, and Matt Davidson hit a game-ending, two-run shot off Greene two batters later as the White Sox rallied to defeat Detroit, 4-2, in the series opener.
- After the Tigers took a 2-1 lead on Victor Martínez's solo home run off Jace Fry in the top of the ninth, Palka led off the bottom of the inning with a solo shot (No. 21), Wellington Castillo singled, and Davidson followed with his 20th homer of the season.
- Ryan Cordell scored the winning run in his major-league debut, Castillo went 1-4 in his first appearance with the Sox since 5/23, and Nicky Delmonico hit his first career leadoff home run (off Michael Fulmer).
- Reynaldo López posted a no decision despite allowing one run on four hits over 7.0 IP ... Ian Hamilton retired all four batters he faced, including the first two strikeouts of his career.
- The Sox, who ended a six-game home losing streak to the Tigers, overcame a deficit in the ninth or extra innings with two home runs, including a walkoff homer, for the sixth time since 1961 (last, 4/24/10 vs. Seattle; STATS).

WINNING WAYS

- The White Sox have gone 14-6 since 8/14, the second-best record in the major leagues behind Tampa Bay (14-5).
- The Sox are 19-12 since 8/2, moving from 9.0 games behind Detroit to 1.0 game in front of the Tigers for third in the AL Central.
- Chicago is 12-6 so far during a stretch of playing 20 straight days from 8/17-9/5, and 9-4 since José Abreu was placed on the disabled list on 8/22.

CEASE, JIMÉNEZ NAMED POM

- Class AAA Charlotte OF Eloy Jiménez and Class AA Birmingham RHP Dylan Cease have been named the White Sox Minor League Player and Pitcher of the Month for August.
- Jiménez, the No. 3 Prospect in baseball per MLB Pipeline, batted .371/.403/.629 (63-170) average with 10 homers, 29 RBI and a 1.1033 OPS over 43 games after the break.
- Cease, the No. 44 Prospect in baseball per MLB Pipeline, went 3-0 with a 0.94 ERA (5 ER/47.2 IP) and 71 strikeouts over his final nine starts.

WHITE SOX VS. DETROIT

- The Tigers lead the season series, 10-7, going 6-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 4-6 at Comerica Park.
- The Sox are batting .259/.314/.431 (152-587) with a 4.20 ERA (70 ER/150.0 IP) and have been outscored by the Tigers, 74-73.
- The White Sox are 68-98 against Detroit since 2010 (37-44 at Guaranteed Rate Field).
- The Sox trail in the all-time series, 1,056-1,097 ... they are 563-515 in Chicago (126-100 at Guaranteed Rate Field) and 493-582 in Detroit (84-91 at Comerica Park).

LOOKING FOR CENTRAL COMMAND

- The White Sox are 27-34 against the American League Central in 2018 (13-19 at home), but have won 10 of their last 13 games by a combined 71-48 margin.
- The White Sox are 318-411 vs. the AL Central since 2009, posting a losing record every season except 2012 (37-36).

RACE FOR THE PRIZE

- Class A Winston-Salem (Carolina), Class A Kannapolis (South Atlantic) and Advanced Rookie Great Falls (Pioneer) have qualified for the postseason in their respective leagues.
- Winston-Salem won both halves of the CL Southern Division with a combined 84-54 record, the fourth-best winning percentage in the minor leagues ... the Dash will play Buies Creek in a best-of-five semifinal playoff beginning tomorrow night.
- Kannapolis finished second overall in the SAL Northern Division with a 74-63 record and will host Lakewood tomorrow night in Game 1 of its best-of-three semifinal series.
- Great Falls has reached the postseason for the 11th time in the last 12 seasons ... the Voyagers won the PL North Division first-half title with a 22-16 record.

LEAD AND WALK IT OFF

- Matt Davidson yesterday hit his second career walkoff home run (also 7/30/17 vs. Cleveland) and the third this season for the White Sox, joining Daniel Palka (8/10 vs. Cleveland) and Trayce Thompson (5/3 vs. Minnesota).
- Chicago's three game-ending homers this year have surpassed their total from the last two seasons combined ... the Sox also have hit seven leadoff home runs this season, tied with the 2001 club for the second-highest total in franchise history behind the 2017 club (eight).

HISTORICALLY TOUGH STRETCH

- The White Sox just completed a stretch where they went 4-3 over consecutive series at New York-AL and vs. Boston, the best two teams in the majors.
- It marked the first time since 1939 that the Sox played back-to-back series against teams who entered the matchup having played at least 50 games with winning percentages of .630 or better (STATS).

PALKA POWER

- Daniel Palka, who was claimed off waivers from Minnesota on 11/4/17, ranks among the American League rookie leaders in home runs (3rd, 21), RBI (3rd, 55), slugging percentage (5th, .476) and total bases (5th, 165).
- Palka's 21 homers are the second-highest total in White Sox history by a left-handed hitting rookie, one behind Pete Ward's franchise-record of 22 in 1963.

YOUNG GUNS

- Lucas Giolito (24 years old), Michael Kopech (22), Reynaldo López (24) and Carlos Rodón (25) make up four-fifths of the White Sox starting rotation.
- Giolito leads the staff with 10 victories and is 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (8 ER/25.1 IP) over his last four starts.
- Kopech has allowed one run over 11.0 IP over his first three major-league starts, two of which have been rain-shortened.
- López is 1-0 with a 1.83 ERA (4 ER/19.2 IP) over his last three starts and has combined to go 2-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3 ER/20.1 IP) in three starts this season against Boston and the Yankees.
- Rodón is 5-1 with a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP) and .151 (33-218) opponents average over his last nine starts.

POWER AND SPEED ...

- Tim Anderson (18 HR/25 SB) is one of five players in the major leagues with at least 18 home runs and 25 stolen bases, joining Boston's Mookie Betts and Cleveland's José Ramírez.
- Anderson is attempting to become the first White Sox shortstop to record a 20-HR/20-SB season and could join Alex Ríos (2010) and Tommie Agee (1966) as the only players in franchise history to post 20 homers and 30 steals in one season.

GIOLITO AT A GLANCE

- The 24-year-old makes his 28th start of the season (14th at home) and fifth against Detroit ... his 27 starts have more than doubled his major-league total of 11 entering the season.
- Leads the team with 10 wins (Carlos Rodón and James Shields are second with six apiece).
- Is 3-0 with a 2.84 ERA (8 ER/25.1 IP), 27 strikeouts and a 0.95 WHIP over his last four starts and 5-2 with a 3.82 ERA (26 ER/61.2 IP), 57 strikeouts and a .203 (45-222) opponents average over his last 10.
- Owns a 4.50 SO/BB ratio (27 SO/6 BB) over his last four starts, down from 1.18 over his first 23.
- Has made six straight quality starts on the road, going 4-1 with a 2.97 ERA (13 ER/39.1 IP).
- Has gone 3-5 with an 7.52 ERA (54 ER/64.2 IP) over 13 starts at home this season and 7-4 with a 4.27 ERA (41 ER/86.1 IP) in 14 road starts.
- Made his first career Opening Day roster.
- Was acquired from Washington on 12/7/16 with RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Reynaldo López in exchange for OF Adam Eaton.

LAST START

- Posted a no decision on 8/30 vs. Boston despite allowing one run on two hits over 6.1 IP ... walked two and matched his season high with eight strikeouts (second time) ... issued a leadoff walk to Mookie Betts but then recorded his first career pickoff ... carried a two-hit shutout into the seventh inning ... left with a 4-0 lead after issuing a one-out walk in the seventh ... threw a career-high 113 pitches (74 strikes) ... Boston rallied to win, 9-4.

2018 STARTS OF INTEREST

- Earned his 10th victory on 8/25 at Detroit, allowing one run on three hits over 7.0 IP ... posted a no decision on 8/3 at Tampa Bay despite allowing one run on two hits over 7.0 IP ... carried a one-hit shutout into the eighth inning.
- Threw 6.1 scoreless IP on 7/15 vs. Kansas City ... lost on 7/8 at Houston despite allowing two runs on three hits over a career-high 7.1 IP ... carried a no-hitter through 5.1 IP on 6/28 vs. Minnesota ... pitched into the eighth inning for the first time in his career on 6/22-2 vs. Oakland.
- Allowed a career-high nine hits on 5/29 at Cleveland but did not issue a walk for the first time this season ... lasted 1.1 IP on 5/24 vs. Baltimore, the shortest start of his career ... won 5/13 at the Cubs despite walking a career-high tying seven batters ... became the third Sox pitcher since 2005 to earn the victory while issuing seven-plus walks, joining Derek Holland on 8/8/17 vs. Houston (seven over 5.2 IP) and Gavin Floyd on 4/13/09 at Detroit (seven over 5.0 IP).
- Earned his first victory of the season and first career road win on 4/26 at Kansas City ... allowed career highs of nine runs and seven walks over 2.0 IP on 4/21 vs. Houston.

BETTER WITH AGE

- Owns a combined 7.76 ERA (46 ER/53.1 IP) in the first two innings this season and 4.00 (39 ER/87.2 IP) from innings 3-6 ... opponents are hitting .246 (49-199) the first time through the lineup, but that number drops to .230 (48-209) the second time and .228 (36-158) the third time.

DAY AND NIGHT

- Has gone 7-4 with a 3.72 ERA (35 ER/84.2 IP) and .195 (59-303) opponents average over 14 starts during the day since 2017, compared to 6-8 with a 5.80 ERA (72 ER/111.2 IP) and .252 (108-429) opponents average in 20 starts at night.

2017 RECAP

- Made 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte and seven with the White Sox in his first season in the organization.
- Went 3-2 with a 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, a .177 (25-141) opponents average and 0.94 WHIP over his final six starts with the Sox ... five of the outings were quality.
- Was recalled on 8/22 and made his White Sox debut that night vs. Minnesota (4 ER/6.0 IP; 3 HR) ... earned his first win with the Sox on 8/27 vs. Detroit, allowing just three hits over 7.0 scoreless IP.
- Allowed one run and struck out a career-high 10 over 7.0 IP on 9/3 vs. Tampa Bay ... became the first Sox pitcher to strike out 10-plus batters within his first three starts with the club since Chris Sale in 2012.
- Received a ND on 9/13 at Kansas City, allowing one run on four hits in 6.1 IP ... became the 15th Sox pitcher to make four-plus straight starts of 5.0-plus IP and four hits or less allowed.
- Began the season with Charlotte ... threw his first professional no-hitter on 5/25-1 vs. Syracuse (7.0 IP), marking the first no-hitter in BB&T Ballpark history ... was named IL Pitcher of the Week for 5/22-28.

- His parents, Rick Giolito and Lindsay Frost, are Hollywood actors ... Rick has appeared in "As the World Turns," "Who's the Boss," "Hunter," "Jake and the Fatman," "Twin Peaks" and "Hit the Dutchman" ... Lindsay acted in "The Ring," "Collateral Damage," "Without a Trace," "The Unit," "Boston Legal," "Crossing Jordan," "Lost," "Frasier" and "CSI."
- His uncle, Mark Frost, is a co-creator and writer of the ABC and Showtime drama "Twin Peaks." ... grandfather, Warren Frost, was a veteran actor who played George Costanza's father-in-law, Henry Ross, on the award-winning sitcom "Seinfeld."

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was selected by Washington in the first round (16th overall) of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft ... was committed to play baseball at UCLA prior to signing with the Nationals.
- Is a 2012 graduate of Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, where he was teammates with current major-leaguers RHPs Jack Flaherty (St. Louis) and Max Fried (Atlanta).

VS. DETROIT TIGERS

- Makes his sixth career start against the Tigers and fifth of the season ... is 2-1 with a 5.25 ERA (14 ER/24.0 IP) in 2018 and 3-1 with a 4.06 ERA (14 ER/31.0 IP) lifetime ... has won his last two starts (both at Comerica Park), allowing one run on three hits over 7.0 IP on 8/25 and three runs on eight hits over 6.0 IP on 8/14 ... posted a no decision in his last start in Chicago on 6/16 (5 ER/5.1 IP) ... threw 7.0 scoreless IP on 8/27/17 at Guaranteed Rate Field, giving up three hits.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER

- RHP Michael Kopech (1-0, 0.82) makes his fourth career start and third at home ... is just the third pitcher since at least 1908 to allow one run or less and one walk or less in each of his first three major-league starts, joining St. Louis' Donovan Osborne (1992) and Cleveland's Cody Anderson (2015).
- Each of his first two career home starts have been rain-shortened: 2.0 scoreless IP in his major-league debut on 8/21 vs. Minnesota and 3.0 scoreless IP on 8/31 vs. Boston ... earned his first major-league victory on 8/26 at Detroit, allowing one run on seven hits over 6.0 IP.
- Went 7-7 with a 3.70 ERA (52 ER/126.1 IP) and 170 strikeouts in 24 starts with Class AAA Charlotte this season ... his 170 strikeouts were leading the minors ... was 4-0 with a 1.84 ERA (9 ER/44.0 IP), four walks and 59 strikeouts over his last seven starts.
- Was acquired from Boston on 12/6/16 with OF Luis Alexander Basabe, RHP Víctor Díaz and INF Yoán Moncada in exchange for LHP Chris Sale.
