## HERE'S THE STORY

- ♦ The D-backs are 7-6 vs. Rockies this season, including 4-3 @ Coors Field.
- ♦ Arizona is 12-6 in its last 18 games at Coors Field, including 9 straight wins from June 21, 2017-July 10, 2018.
- ♦ 16 of the D-backs' last 21 games have been decided by 3 runs or fewer: 1 run - 10 times; 2 runs - 4 times; 3 runs - twice.
- ♦ The D-backs' 3.62 ERA ranks third in the Majors behind the Astros (3.09) and Dodgers (3.47).
- ♦ **Zack Greinke**, who will reach the 30-start mark for the ninth time, is 6-2 with a 2.99 ERA (23 ER in 69.1 IP) and .210 opponent average in 11 starts vs. NL West opponents in 2018...has gone 8-2 in 14 starts following a D-backs loss this season.
- ♦ **Paul Goldschmidt** has reached base safely in a club-record 46 straight road games since May 27, hitting .395 (70-for-177) with 14 doubles, 1 triple, 15 homers, 38 RBI and 28 walks.

## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

- ♦ The D-backs lost the series opener @ Rockies, 13-2.
- ♦ **Eduardo Escobar** went 3-for-3 with 1 RBI...**Paul Goldschmidt** was 1-for-3 with 1 RBI...**A.J. Pollock** tripled.
- ♦ **Zack Godley** (14-9) suffered the loss after allowing 5 runs in 4.0 innings.

## ROCKY MOUNTAIN HIGH? THAT JOHN DENVER WAS FULL OF IT

- ♦ In 110 all-time, regular-season meetings between the D-backs and Rockies in September or later, Arizona is 63-47 (.573), including 15-5 (.750) in 20 meetings since 2015.

## DOWN THE STRETCH WE GO

- ♦ The D-backs have 18 games remaining (9 home/9 away) and their opponents' combined .541 winning pct. is higher than the Rockies (.514) and Dodgers (.488) [source: ESPN.com].
  - 12 games vs. NL West foes: 6 vs. Rockies (3 on road/3 @ home), 3 vs. Padres (on road), 3 vs. Dodgers (@ home).
  - 7 games vs. first place teams from other divisions: 3 vs. Astros (on road), 3 vs. Cubs (@ home).
- ♦ Entering last Thursday's game, the D-backs next 17 games were against teams currently in first place: ATL, COL, HOU, CHC and COL...per Elias Sports Bureau, if each team leads their respective divisions at the time of those games, the 17-game streak vs. first-place teams would be a Major League record...the current record is 14 by the 1993 Orioles and 1996 Tigers.

- ♦ **Zack Greinke's** 2,416 career strikeouts are tied with Luis Tiant for 44th on the all-time list:

- ♦ His 2,416 career strikeouts are sixth among active pitchers behind CC Sabathia (2,974), Justin Verlander (2,674), Bartolo Colón (2,535), Felix Hernandez (2,463) and Max Scherzer (2,420).

## LIFE ON THE ROAD

- ♦ The D-backs' .542 road winning pct. (39-33) is fifth in the NL behind the Braves (.589, 43-30), Dodgers (.565, 39-30), Cardinals (.560, 42-33) and Rockies (.556, 40-32).
- ♦ Among NL teams on the road, D-backs pitchers have allowed the third-fewest runs (270), the second-lowest ERA (3.65), rank third in strikeouts (631) and fifth in opponent average (.237).

## GREINKE AT A GLANCE

- ◆ Third season with the D-backs.
- ◆ Is a 5-time All-Star (2009, '14-15, '17-18), won 3 NL Rawlings® Gold Gloves (2014-16) and earned a Louisville Slugger® Silver Slugger™ in 2013.
- ◆ Won the 2009 AL Cy Young Award and finished runner-up in 2015 race to the Cubs' Jake Arrieta.
- ◆ 1 of 3 pitchers all-time with a Cy Young, Silver Slugger and Gold Glove (also: Fernando Valenzuela and Orel Hershiser).
- ◆ Won 2 ERA titles: 2009 (2.16) & 2015 (1.66)...1.66 ERA was the lowest in the Majors since Atlanta's Greg Maddux (1.63) in 1995...6 career 200+ strikeout seasons (2009, '11-12, '14-15, '17).

## WHAT TO KNOW...

- ◆ With tonight's start, will reach the 30-start milestone for the ninth time.
- ◆ Needs 1 strikeout to pass Luis Tiant (T-44th, 2,416) on the all-time list.
- ◆ Has not won on the road since July 27 @ Padres.

## LAST START

- ◆ Suffered the loss on Sept. 6 vs. Braves, allowing 5 runs (4 ER) on 6 hits in 5.1 innings.

## VS. ROCKIES

- ◆ Is 11-5 with a 3.78 ERA (70 ER in 166.2 IP) over 27 career starts.
- ◆ Owns a 4-1 record in 10 starts @ Coors Field.
- ◆ In 3 starts this season, is 2-0 with a 2.33 ERA (5 ER in 19.1 IP).

- ◆ Is 47-18 (.723) all-time vs. NL West, the highest winning pct. all-time within the division:
  - ❑ **BEST WIN PCT. VS. NL WEST: .723— Zack Greinke (47-17);** .706 — Clayton Kershaw (77-32); .706 — Tommy John (48-20); .694 — Kevin Millwood (34-15) ...min. 50 GS.

## ON THE LEADERBOARD

- ◆ Ranks among NL leaders in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 1.84), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4th, 4.86), innings (4th, 181.1), WHIP (5th, 1.06), strikeouts (6th, 180), ERA (8th, 3.08), and wins (8th, 13).

- ◆ His 2,416 career strikeouts are tied for 44th with Luis Tiant on the all-time strikeout list.

## PLAYER PROFILE

- ◆ Is an avid fantasy football player.
- ◆ Was a tennis prodigy at 8 years old.
- ◆ 2002 Gatorade National Baseball Player of the Year at Apopka (Fla.) High School...played shortstop...transitioned to pitcher as a senior.
- ◆ Began his career at Rookie level as a shortstop and pitcher...after just 1 workout, he gave his infielder glove to Andres Blanco because he decided to become a pitcher.
- ◆ During his 2004 rookie season with the Royals, lived with Hall of Famer George Brett.
- ◆ Gave his 2009 AL Cy Young Award to his parents but kept the samurai sword Mizuno presented him in recognition of his season.
- ◆ Committed to Clemson University.

## AFTER A D-BACKS LOSS

- ◆ Is 8-2 with a 2.50 ERA (25 ER in 90.0 IP) in 14 starts following an Arizona loss this season.

## THE CHASE IS ON

- ◆ Ranks sixth among NL starters with a 34.8 chase pct. (swings at pitches outside the zone).
- ◆ Jacob deGrom/NYM (38.7) is first, followed by Patrick Corbin/ARI (36.9), Alex Wood/LAD (35.9), Miles Mikolas/STL (35.9) and Max Scherzer/WSH (35.8).

## RIGHT ON

- ◆ Has held righties to a .185 average (12-for-65) over his last 6 starts.

## 30/200/200.0

- ◆ Is looking to become the first D-back pitcher (fourth overall) since Dan Haren (2008-09) with at least 30 starts, 200 strikeouts and 200.0 innings in back-to-back seasons.

## PITCHER OF THE MONTH

- ◆ Named NL Pitcher of the Month for July after going 4-0 with a 1.60 ERA (6 ER in 33.2 IP), .208 opponent average, 35 strikeouts and 5 walks in 5 starts.

## AT THE DISH

- ◆ Among NL pitchers, is first with with 4 extra-base hits and 3 stolen bases, second with a .304 slugging pct., third with a .232 average and fourth with a .271 on-base percentage.
