FISH BITES

The Marlins conclude a 10-game, 11-day road swing looking for just the third three-game sweep of the St. Louis Cardinals (second in St. Louis) in Franchise history today at 12:15 p.m. RHP **Trevor Richards**, recalled earlier today, is making his first career start against the Cardinals. St. Louis is countering with RHP Miles Mikolas, who in three previous appearances (one start) against the Marlins has no record and 5.68 ERA (6.1 ip/4 er). The current trip started in San Diego (1-3), and then went to Arizona (0-3). Miami will return home for a seven-game homestand with three games against San Diego and four against San Francisco beginning tomorrow. The Marlins are in a stretch that will see them play 49 games in 52 days from May 25 to the All-Star Break.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

Miami exploded for season highs in runs and hits (17) in an 11-3 win over the Cardinals. **Derek Dietrich** recorded a career-high four hits, while **Starlin Castro** tied a career best with four hits (18th time). The two became the sixth pair of Marlins to record four-plus hits in the same game since 2010. **J.T. Realmuto** and **Lewis Brinson** both tallied three-hit affairs, with Brinson recording his second career multi-home run game. Castro doubled three times, and Realmuto tripled and doubled twice, marking only the second time in Club history that two players recorded three-plus extra-base hits in the same game (Ozuna-Yelich on July 26, 2017). **Drew Rucinski** earned his first career win, allowing two hits and one run, while striking out two, in 2.1 relief innings.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Marlins today optioned RHP **Tyler Cloyd** to Triple-A New Orleans and recalled RHP **Trevor Richards** from NOLA. Richards has made five starts with Miami already this season after making his Major League debut on April 2 vs. Boston. With the Baby Cakes, Richards has gone 3-2 with a 2.06 ERA (39.1/9) over six starts. Over his Minor League career, he has compiled a 17-16 record and 2.44 ERA (239.2/65) over 44 appearances (40 starts).

2018 DRAFT OVERVIEW

The Miami Marlins completed the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft yesterday, making their final 30 selections in Rounds 11-40. The Club selected 41 players over the course of the three-day Draft, and took position players with its first five picks for just the second time in franchise history (also, 1998). It was also just the seventh time that the team used at least four of its top five picks on position players (also, 2012, '07, '06, '00, 1998, '95). In total, the Marlins drafted 25 pitchers, seven outfielders, five infielders, and four catchers. Miami opened its 2018 Draft by selecting outfielder Connor Scott out of Plant High School in Tampa, Florida, with the 13th overall pick. The Club also selected shortstop Osiris Johnson out of Encinal High School (CA) with the 53rd overall pick, and catcher Will Banfield out of Brookwood High School (GA) with the 69th overall pick on the opening night of the Draft.

COMING IN TWO'S

Lewis Brinson, who connected for two home runs last night, became the first rookie in Club history to record two-or-more multi-home run games in his first 59 games played with the team. He is the second rookie this season to record two-plus multi-HR games, joining San Diego's Christian Villanueva.

FINDING HIS RHYTHM

Derek Dietrich has been one of the Marlins hottest hitters of late, posting a .423 (22x52) average since May 20. He has recorded at least one hit in 13 of 15 games, including a career-high four hits last night and two three-hit efforts. His average since that date ranks third among NL hitters, behind Matt Kemp (.453) and Marcell Ozuna (.442), while his on-base percentage (.475) ranks fourth.

DANDY ANDY

Since May 15, **Brian Anderson** has posted a .357 average (30x84), recording at least one hit in 17 of 21 games, including 12 multi-hit efforts. He is tied with Scooter Gennett for third in the National League in hits over that span, behind Brandon Crawford (31) and Freddie Freeman (31), while his average ranks seventh.

- Ranks second in the Majors and is tied for the National League lead in hits with runners in scoring position (23) this season, behind Jean Segura (24). His .411 RISP average ranks fifth in MLB and third in the NL.
- Has eight hits in his last 10 at-bats with RISP. Had 4x4 streak snapped in second at-bat of last night's game. Was first Marlin with 4x4 stretch with RISP since Dee Gordon (June 13-18, 2017). - *Elias*

ROOKIE LEADER

Brian Anderson has appeared in all 61 games for the Marlins this season - the only rookie to appear in each of his team's games in 2018. Anderson leads all qualified Major League rookies in games, at-bats (229), runs (32), hits (68), and on-base percentage (.371); tied for the lead in multi-hit games (20); ranks second in average (.297), walks (22), doubles (15), RBI (30), and slugging percentage (.419); and is tied for third in triples (2).

- Ranks second among National League players 25-younger in hits, behind Ozzie Albies (70).
- Owns three outfield assists in 32 G in RF - his first action at the position in his professional career. Is tied with Johnny Field and Jesse Winker for most assists among MLB rookies.
- His three assists are the most by a Marlins rookie since Marcell Ozuna (8) and Jake Marisnick (5) in 2013.
- Is on pace to record 109 hits before the All-Star Break, which would be the most ever recorded by a Marlins rookie and would tie Rocco Baldelli for the third-most by any Major League rookie since 2000 (Ichiro-133 in 2001; Hideki Matsui-114 in 2003). Alex Gonzalez currently holds the Franchise record with 99 in 1999, while Gaby Sanchez ranks second with 95 in 2010. He is also on pace to record 48 first-half RBI, which would rank as the second-most by a Marlins rookie, behind Dan Uggla's 51 in 2006.

On Friday, there will be the 'LYFERS' T-shirt ticket package, which starts at \$20, alumni Autograph and Selfie Stations beginning at 6 p.m. inside Marlins Park, Charlie Hough bobblehead to all full season ticket members, and postgame fireworks, presented by T-Mobile. On Saturday, Alumni Autograph and Selfie Stations will begin at 3 p.m. inside Marlins Park, there will be a special pregame ceremony beginning at 3:15 p.m., a Teal Marlins Rally Towel giveaway for all fans upon admission to Marlins Park (while supplies last), and a postgame concert by Deep Fried Funk Band (a '90s cover band) at The 5th Base, presented by Corona Light. The weekend will conclude Sunday with an Alumni Softball Game, presented by Ciroc, begins at 11:30 a.m., a 25th Anniversary Logo Pin giveaway for all fans upon admission to Marlins Park (while supplies last), and highlight watch party postgame inside the 5th Base, presented by Corona Light.

- The Marlins set a club record by playing a 20-inning game on April 27, 2003 vs. St. Louis. The Fish also set a club record by drawing 16 walks.

- Trevor Richards was recalled from Triple-A New Orleans today and will make his sixth start of the season for Miami, as the club closes out a three-game set with the Cardinals, the end of a three-city, 11-game road trip.
- Went 2-0 with 0.75 ERA (12.0 ip/1 er) in four Spring appearances (two starts) with Miami. He had his contract selected on April 2 and made his Major League debut that night against Boston.
- He went 0-2 with a 4.94 ERA (23.2 ip/13 er) across six starts in his first stint with the Marlins. Tossed 7.0 shutout innings with just two hits allowed on April 14 vs. Pittsburgh, and tossed 4.2 shutout innings, with a career-high 10 strikeouts, on April 25 at the Dodgers, his final start before being optioned back to NOLA.
- In the Pittsburgh start, became the first Marlins rookie starter to work at least 7.0 innings and allow two or fewer hits since Justin Nicolino on September 26, 2015 vs. Atlanta (7.0 ip, 2 h). He became just the 15th pitcher in Club history to do so (22nd time).
- Allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in each of his six starts after returning to New Orleans. Tossed a career-high 7.1 innings against Round Rock in his first game back, on May 1. Struck out nine batters in that game, a Minor League season-high that he tied on May 26 at Iowa.

- Posted 37 strikeouts against just four walks with the Baby Cakes.
- Is making first career start and appearance against St. Louis.
- Road ERA stands at 5.84 (12.1/8), while home ERA is 3.97 (11.1/5). Allowed career-high six runs in road start at Milwaukee on April 20, before rebounding with the 4.2 shutout innings at the Dodgers in his next start.
- On April 8 at Philadelphia, surrendered three runs, six hits, and three walks, with two strikeouts, over 4.0 innings.
- Took loss in debut MLB debut vs. Boston, allowing five runs on eight hits and a walk, while striking out five, over 4.1 innings. Surrendered just two hits over first three innings, but was touched for three runs in fourth and two in fifth, leaving with one out and a runner on first.
- In 2017, split second affiliated and third professional season between Single-A Jupiter (13 games, 11 starts) and Double-A Jacksonville (14 starts). Combined to go 12-11 with a 2.53 ERA (146.0 ip/41 er) overall and earned Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year honors.
- Led all Marlins farmhands in strikeouts (158), ranked second in wins, ERA and WHIP (1.03), and fifth in innings pitched.
- Opened campaign at Jupiter, going 7-4, 2.17 (70.2/17) to earn Florida State League Midseason All-Star honors.
- Set career high with 11 strikeouts on June 2 at Dunedin, when he allowed just one hit and no walks over 6.0 shutout innings, earning FSL Pitcher of the Week honors for May 29-June 4.
- Did not appear in FSL All-Star Game due to starting three days prior (June 14) at St. Lucie, his final start with Jupiter before June 21 promotion to Jumbo Shrimp.
- Tossed at least 6.0 innings in seven of last nine starts for Hammerheads, including 6.1 on May 27 vs. Bradenton, his season-high with Jupiter.

- Caleb Smith is making his 13th start of the season tomorrow when the Marlins open their 25th Anniversary Weekend with the first of three games against San Diego at Marlins Park.
- Made first career Opening Day roster after going 0-2 with 5.21 ERA (19.0 ip/11 er) in six Spring outings (two starts). Acquired by Miami this offseason, along with INF Garrett Cooper on November 20, from Yankees.
- Leads all MLB rookies in strikeouts (74), ahead of Shohei Ohtani and Tyler Mahle (61 each).
- His 74 strikeouts are tied with Josh Johnson for fourth-most before the All-Star break by a rookie in Club history (third-most by a left-hander). Only José Fernández (103 in 2013), Scott Olsen (LH, 79 in 2006), and Dontrelle Willis (LH, 79 in 2003) had more.
- Among pitchers with at least 12 starts, ranks fourth in National League (11th in MLB) with a strikeout rate of 29.6% (74/250). He trails only Max Scherzer (39.3), Jacob deGrom (33.9), and Patrick Corbin (32.7) in the NL.
- Also among pitchers with at least 12 starts, ranks sixth in the NL (12th in MLB) in hits allowed per 9.0 innings (6.56). Trails only Scherzer (5.54), Corbin (6.06), Aaron Nola (6.30), Sean Newcomb (6.42), and Michael Wacha (6.46) in NL.
- Allowed five runs in his last start (June 2 at Arizona). In previous seven starts, had allowed more than two runs just once (four on May 17 vs. Dodgers). Over last eight starts, he is 4-4 with a 3.02 ERA (44.2/15) and a .181 average against (28x155).
