ABOUT YESTERDAY AFTERNOON: The Padres fell 3-1 yesterday to the Rockies, joining the Rays as the only teams so far this season to reach the six-loss mark...starter **Joey Lucchesi** made his second career start, working 5.0 innings of scoreless ball and allowing just one hit and striking out a career-high seven...he retired the last 10 batters he faced yesterday, five via the strikeout.

• SS **Freddy Galvis** had his third multi-hit game, and CF **Manuel Margot** homered for the first time this season in the ninth inning...his round-tripper snapped an 0-for-16 slump, the longest hitless streak of his career.

GALVANIZED: SS **Freddy Galvis** has reached base safely in all seven games to start the season (.429 OBP) while hitting in five of those games (.333, 8-for-24)...San Diego has produced 13 individual multi-hit performances this season, six of which have come from either Galvis or 1B **Eric Hosmer**.

HELLO HOUSTON: The last time San Diego played the Astros dates back to the three-game series at Petco from April 27-29, 2015, in which the Padres were swept...the last time SD travelled to Houston dates back to their June 25-28, 2012, in which the four-game series was split.

• The Padres 1-6 start ties their worst record through their first seven games of any season (also: 1994, 1987 and 1974)...on the flip side, the Astros 6-1 start ties their best record to begin a campaign (also: 1988 and 1987).

HOS LIKES HOUSTON: Among active players hitting against the Astros since 2012 (minimum 100 at-bats), 1B **Eric Hosmer** has the highest batting average .348 (40-for-115)...he is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak (16-for-43, .372) versus the Astros at Minute Maid Park.

THE GROUNDER GAMES: The Padres have forced 99 ground balls, the second-most in the majors behind OAK's 101...the Friars 49.5 ground ball percentage ranks third-highest.

YOU SHALL NOT SCORE: The Padres bullpen has inherited 12 runners, allowing only one of them to score...they are just one of nine teams to allow one or no inherited runs to score.

RISPECT, FIND OUT WHAT IT MEANS TO ME: Despite going 0-for-2 with RISP yesterday, the Padres' .302 average (13-for-43) is tied for the fourth-highest average in the majors.

WE'RE NO. 1! (AND HUMBLE ABOUT IT): The Padres farm system ranks first in all of Major League Baseball, according to MLB Pipeline...the Padres headline the list, having been tabbed as fourth a year ago...the club has an MLB-best six players in MLB Pipeline's Top 50 prospect list and seven in the Top 100.

• The top 10 Padres prospects are as follows: Fernando Tatis Jr.(8), MacKenzie Gore (19), Luis Urías (36), Cal Quantrill (40), Michel Baez (42), Adrian Morejon (50), Anderson Espinoza (89), Logan Allen, Joey Lucchesi and Franchy Cordero.

THIS DATE IN PADRES HISTORY: On April 6, 1996, Trevor Hoffman struck out seven in three perfect innings, and third baseman **Ken Caminiti** hit a grand slam in the top of the 13th to give the Padres an 8-4 victory over Houston in the Astrodome.

PADRES ON DECK: The minor league baseball season kicked off yesterday... No. 13 prospect LHP Eric Lauer allowed two runs on five hits and two walks with six strikeouts in 6.0 innings to pick up the win for El Paso (AAA)...CF Travis Jankowski (3-for-5) and 2B Luis Urias (1-for-3, two walks) each reach base thrice as the Chihuahuas opened the Pacific Coast League season with 4-2 win at Las Vegas.

#61 RHP LUIS PERDOMO (0-1, 11.25)

SOCK'S UP!: 24-year-old **Luis Perdomo** takes the mound tonight for the series opener in Houston, his first on the road and second of the season..in '17, he made 29 in total and 13 on the road.

- In his first start of the season on 3/31 vs. MIL, Perdomo tossed 4.0 innings and allowed five runs on seven hits and four walks while striking out seven...the seven punchouts were two shy of his career high and the most since August 8 of last season.
- Tonight marks his first career start against the Astros.

AL VS. NL: Since the beginning of 2017 Perdomo has made 30 starts, with four of those coming against American League foes...he is 2-1 with a 3.52 ERA and 0.39 HR allowed per 9 IP against AL opponents...he is 6-11 with a 5.06 ERA and 1.00 HR/9 IP against NL foes.

THE GROUNDER GAMES: Last season, he led all NL pitchers with a 62.0 ground ball percentage, behind only TOR Marcus Stroman's 62.9 mark for the Major League lead...teammate Clayton Richard (60.0) and former teammate Jhoulys Chacin (49.2) ranked third and 14th, respectively.

LET'S TURN TWO: Forced opponents to ground into 32 double plays last season, which ranked tied for first in the National League and tied for second in MLB with teammate Clayton Richard.

WORKHORSE: Worked 5.0 innings-or-more in 26 of his 29 starts last season and 6.0 innings-or-more in 20 of his starts in 2017.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: Last season, Perdomo tossed 16 quality starts this year, ahead of Jhoulys Chacin's 15 for the club lead.

SWING IT, LUIS: Became the first pitcher to hit four triples in a season since PHI's Robin Roberts in 1955...only three pitchers had on triple in 2017, resulting in Perdomo having more triples in his 46 at-bats than all other MLB pitchers in their combined 4,534 at-bats.

A WIN, AT LAST, FOR LUIS: Went 10 starts into last season without earning a win...only John D'Acquisto (12 starts without a win in 1977) has ever had a longer winless streak in Padres history...with six no decisions to open last season, Perdomo had the most consecutive starts to begin a season without a decision in club history, surpassing Bob Owchinko's five consecutive starts in 1977 (STATS).

SPRINGTIME, FOR LUIS, IN PEORIA: This past Spring, Perdomo went 1-2 with a 5.74 ERA (10 ER, 15.2 IP) in four Cactus League appearances.

SATURDAY'S STARTER

<u>SATURDAY, IN (MINUTE MAID) PARK</u>: RHP Bryan Mitchell is scheduled to make his road debut in a Padres uniform against the Houston Astros tomorrow night.

- Acquired by the Padres during the Winter Meetings from the New York Yankees along with INF Chase Headley and cash considerations in exchange for OF Jabari Blash on December 12, 2017.
- Has made 137 minor league appearances (131 starts) and posted a 30-43 record with a 4.16 ERA.
