## NATIONALS NEWS

### ONE FOR THE ROAD

The Washington Nationals cap this 10-game homestand with an afternoon tilt against the Atlanta Braves... Following the game, the Nationals will head to Chicago where they will start a seven-game road trip that will feature three games against the Cubs and four games against the St. Louis Cardinals.

- The Nationals enter Thursday's action having won nine of their last 14 games...Over the 14-game stretch dating to July 25, Washington has outscored its opponents 88-49.
- Nationals starting pitchers have worked to a National-League best 2.90 ERA (28 ER/87.0 IP) over this stretch of games.
- At the same time, Washington's offense has put together a National-League best .285/.379/.494 slash line since July 25.

### SECOND HALF STATUS CHECK

Since returning from the All-Star break, Washington leads National League clubs in on-base percentage (.362), slugging percentage (.477), OPS (.840), runs scored (104) and stolen bases (15)...They rank among National League clubs in batting average (2nd, .277), doubles (3rd, 38), home runs (4th, 25) and batting average with runners in scoring position (3rd, .279).

- Washington hitters have recorded 130 strikeouts since the All-Star break, the fewest in the National League.

### THE OPPOSITE OF A DERBY SLUMP

**Bryce Harper** clubbed his 28th home run of the season on Wednesday night against Atlanta...He is now hitting .339 (21-for-62) with six doubles, five home runs, 17 RBI, 10 walks, three stolen bases and 15 runs scored in 18 games since returning from the All-Star break...He entered the break hitting .214/.365/.468 and is now at .234/.378/.501 on the season.

- He ranks in the National League in runs (T4th, 15), home runs (T8th, 5) and doubles (T9th, 6) since the All-Star break.
- He has hit safely in seven of his last nine games, posting multi-hit efforts in six of the nine, while eight (5 2B, 3 HR) of his 13 hits have gone for extra bases.
- On the season, Harper ranks in the National League in walks (1st, 88), home runs (T3rd, 28) and RBI (8th, 71).

### STATS ON SOTO

**Juan Soto** leads all MLB rookies (min. 289 PA), in batting average (.308), on-base percentage (.426), slugging percentage (.558), and OPS (.984).

- Even though he was called up on May 20, he ranks among National League rookies this season in walks (T1st, 49), home runs (2nd, 14), runs (2nd, 50), doubles (T3rd, 16), RBI (5th, 39) and hits (6th, 74).
- Since May 15 (the first game in his game log, due to the suspended game vs. NYY), Soto ranks among all National League hitters in on-base percentage (3rd, .426), OPS (3rd, .984), walks (T4th, 49), runs scored (5th, 50), home runs (T9th, 15), percentage (10th, .558) and batting average (12th, .308).
- Among all National League hitters (min. 289 PA) in 2018, he ranks in OPS (2nd, .984), on-base percentage (2nd, .426), slugging percentage (6th, .558) and batting average (7th, .308).

### ZIM HEATING UP

**Ryan Zimmerman** has hit safely in six of his last nine games...He is 13-for-31 (.419) with six doubles, two homers, nine RBI, four walks and three runs scored...He has recorded four multi-hit games along the way, including two three-hit games in Tuesday's doubleheader.

### BULL-PENNINGS

Since July 9, Washington's bullpen ranks second in the National League and fourth in Major League Baseball with a 2.84 ERA (23 ER/73.0 IP).

- On the season, Nationals relievers rank in the National League in walks per 9.0 IP (2nd, 2.91), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2nd, 2.99), WHIP (3rd, 1.20), and hits per 9.0 IP (5th, 7.85).
- Nationals relievers have allowed just 23.5 percent of inherited runners to score (31-for-132), the second-best mark in the National League and third-best mark in Major League Baseball.

## NATIONALS HISTORY

### August 9 (8-3 on this date)

2005 - **Brandon Watson** makes spectacular big league debut, going 2-for-5 with a double, homer, one RBI and two runs scored in Washington's 6-5 win at HOU. Watson is the first franchise player to homer in a big league debut since Brad Fullmer did so on Sept. 2, 1997 vs. BOS.

2011 - **Chien-Ming Wang** spun 6.0 masterful innings of one-hit scoreless ball to pitch the Nationals past CHI, 3-1, at Wrigley Field. Wang held the Cubs hitless into the sixth and eventually earned his first MLB win since June 28, 2009. **Michael Morse** hit a titanic blast in the sixth inning, his 20th of the season, that landed above the restaurant in Wrigley's batters eye. **Drew Storen** earned his 30th save with a scoreless ninth inning.

**Dave Martinez** capped his 16-year Major League career with Atlanta in 2001, hitting .287 in 12 games... **Matt Adams** clubbed 19 home runs in 100 games for the Braves in 2017...The Braves made Nationals pitching coach **Derek Lilliquist** their first-round selection (6th overall) in the 1987 Amateur Draft.

## DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

## #47 - GIO GONZALEZ - LHP

Electric left-hander is in his seventh season with Washington...In seven years with the Nationals, is 85-62 with a 3.55 ERA in 208 starts...Ranks second on Washington's all-time (2005-pres.) wins list with 85...Is Washington's most prolific left-handed pitcher, leading Nationals southpaws in nearly every pitching category...Leads Nationals (2005-pres.) lefties in wins (85), innings pitched (1,225.0), and strikeouts (1,197), among other categories...Has made 30-or-more starts seven of the last eight seasons.

**AGAINST THE BRAVES:** Faces the Atlanta Braves for the second time this season...Tossed 7.0 innings giving up three runs on five hits on June 2 at ATL...He struck out a season-high nine batters and walked none in Washington's 5-3 win.

**LAST START:** Suffered the loss in Washington's 7-1 defeat against Cincinnati on August 4...Allowed five earned runs and gave up a season-high 10 hits while walking two in 3.2 innings pitched.

### 2018 NOTES

- Ranks seventh among National League left-handed pitchers with a 4.04 ERA.
- Ranks fourth among National League lefties, having allowed 0.92 home runs per 9.0 IP (12 home runs in 118.0 IP).
- Also ranks among National League lefties in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (5th, 8.24), opp. SLG (5th, .405), opp. OPS (9th, .749), opp. AVG (10th, .263) and opp. OBP (10th, .334).
- Has held opposing batters to a .182 average with RISP (18-for-99), tied for eighth-best in MLB and fourth-best mark in the National League.
- Opposing left-handed batters are hitting .202 against him, tied for third-best among National League left-handers.
- Has allowed two earned runs or fewer in 14 of his 22 starts...His 14 such starts are tied for sixth among National League starting pitchers.
- Has not yet hit a batter in 2018...ATL **Sean Newcomb** is the only other qualified starter not to have hit a batter in 2018.
- He pitched to a 1.81 ERA (9 ER/44.2 IP) in seven starts from April 29 through June 2, going 4-0 along the way...He recorded 43 strikeouts and a .200 opp. AVG.
- Was strong in 6.0 innings of work on July 11 at Pittsburgh...Allowed two earned runs on six hits with four strikeouts and one walk...Both runs came via third inning home run by **Starling Marte**...Was saddled with the loss as the Nationals were blanked by the Pirates, 2-0.
- Struck out a season-high nine batters in 7.0 innings pitched in Washington's 5-3 win over Atlanta on June 2.
- Tossed a season-high 7.2 innings on May 28 at Baltimore...Did not allow a run while allowing six hits and striking out three.
- Allowed two earned runs on six hits in 5.0 innings of work on May 15 vs. New York...Struck out five batters...Allowed his first home run since April 12 vs. Colorado...The game was eventually suspended due to rain.
- Earned his 11th career win at Citi Field vs. NYM on April 17...Allowed two earned runs on eight hits with two walks and five strikeouts in 5.1 IP.
- Allowed two earned runs on five hits with three walks and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings on April 12 vs. COL.
- Opened the season with 6.0 strong innings as Washington completed the sweep of Cincinnati, 6-5...Allowed one earned run on five hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

### CAREER NOTES

- His 85 wins are sixth among left-handed pitchers since 2012...Ranks fifth among MLB left-handers in that span with a .238 opp. AVG.
- His 21 wins in 2012 are tied with **Clayton Kershaw** (21 in 2014) for the most in a single season by a lefty since 2012.
- Since 2012, is 75-6 with a 2.96 ERA in 103 starts when receiving more than two runs of offensive support...Is 86-1 with a 2.81 ERA in 109 starts when getting four or more runs of offensive support in his career.
- Since 2014, has allowed just six home runs in 697 AB vs. LHB, the fewest among left-handed starting pitchers (min. 600 AB vs. LHB).
