NEW YORK YANKEES NOTES

- The Yankees had their four-game winning streak snapped...are still 8-2 in their last 10G...fell to 60-11 when scoring first...dropped to 19-6 vs. the AL Central in 2018...are 45-21 at Yankee Stadium.
 - Had their deficit in the AL East increase to 6.5G behind idle Boston.
- RHP Masahiro Tanaka** (7.0IP, 10H, 4ER, 1BB, 7K) started and took the loss...took a shutout into the sixth inning...was his second start this season with at least 7.0IP (had a nine-inning CG SHO on 7/24 at Tampa Bay)...has lost at least three consecutive decisions for the second time in his career (lost six straight from 5/14-G2-6/17/17)...is winless in his last five starts...tied a career high with 10H (fifth time, first since 5/8/17 at Cincinnati)...permitted four infield hits.
 - White Sox batters went 4-for-12 with RISP...Tanaka had held opponents to a .119 BA (5-for-42) with RISP in his previous 11 starts.
 - Escaped a bases-loaded, no-out jam in the fourth inning by striking out Davidson and Narváez and getting Moncada to ground out.
- SS Gleyber Torres** (1-for-2, 2BB) hit a two-run HR in the fourth, his 20th HR of the season...nine of his 20HR have come with runners on base.
 - Joins Miguel Andújar (21HR) as the first pair of Yankees rookies to hit 20HR in the same season...per Elias, are the eighth set of rookie teammates to both hit 20HR, the first since Cincinnati's Joey Votto and Jay Bruce in 2008...is the ninth Yankees rookie to hit 20HR in a season.
 - His HR traveled a projected 444 feet (per Statcast), the longest of his career.
- 3B Miguel Andújar** (0-for-3, 1R, 1BB) had his four-game multi-hit streak snapped.
- Yankees batters** were held to 3H-or-fewer for the fifth time this season, first time since 8/3 at Boston (1H)...went 0-for-7 with RISP...struck out just three times, tied for their second-fewest in a game this season.
 - With Torres hitting his 20th HR, the Yankees have six players with at least 20HR: Stanton (32), Judge (26), Gregorius (22), Andújar (21), Hicks (21), Torres (20)...are the most on one team in the Majors this season...is the fourth Yankees team with at least six 20HR hitters (seven in 2009, six in 2004, six in 1961).
- In his first rehab game at Triple-A Scranton/WB at Lehigh Valley, **C Gary Sánchez** (right groin strain) went 2-for-4 with a solo HR.

CHICAGO WHITE SOX NOTES

- The White Sox have won four straight games...are 10-3 in their last 13 games (since 8/14) and 10-2 in their last 12 road games (since 8/3)...improved to 1-3 vs. the Yankees this season and are now 4-15 in their last 19 games at Yankee Stadium (since 6/30/12)...earned their 29th come-from-behind win this season, eclipsing their total from last season (28 comeback wins)...are now 11-31 when hitting 0HR this season.
 - After scoring just 6R combined in the first 3G vs. the Yankees this season, the White Sox plated 6R tonight...is their most runs scored vs. the Yankees since 8R on 7/4/16.
- LHP Carlos Rodón** (7.0IP, 2H, 2ER, 4BB, 2K, 1HR, 1WP) is undefeated in his last nine starts (since 7/5), going 5-0 with a 1.84 ERA (63.2IP, 13ER) over the stretch...his 1.84 ERA since the start of July is fourth-lowest in the Majors (second-lowest in the AL)...is tied for his longest career undefeated streak (also nine straight from 4/21-6/9/15)...had 4BB tonight and has 15BB in his last 5GS (35.0IP since 8/4)...his 2K were his fewest this season and least in a start since 6/28/17 vs. the Yankees (also 2K).
 - Has recorded nine straight quality starts, which is tied for the sixth-longest streak in Baseball this season...is the longest streak by a White Sox pitcher he recorded 10QS in a row from 8/11/15-4/13/16.
 - Additionally, was his ninth straight start of at least 6.0IP, 3R-or-fewer and 5H-or-fewer, the longest such streak by a White Sox pitcher since at least 1908...Houston's Justin Verlander is the only other pitcher with a longer streak this season (13 straight starts from 4/9-6/14/18).
 - Was his longest career start vs. the Yankees (prev.: 6.0IP on 9/25/15)...improved to 2-3 with a 5.88 ERA (26.0IP, 17ER) in five career starts vs. the Yankees...is 2-0 with a 2.77 ERA (13.0IP, 4ER) in two starts at Yankee Stadium.
- 2B Yoán Moncada** (1-for-4, 1 double, 2RBI, 2K) drove in two runs with his sixth-inning double...has at least 1RBI in four straight games, the longest streak of his career.
- SS Tim Anderson** (2-for-5, 1R, 2 doubles, 2RBI, 1K, 1SB) registered multiple extra-base hits for the seventh time this season...is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with 11R, 6 doubles, 1 triple, 2HR, 10RBI, 3BB and 3SB in his last 12 games (since 8/14)...has hit safely in his last six games.
 - Stole his team-leading 25th base of the season tonight in the ninth inning.
- CF Adam Engel** (3-for-4, 1R) is hitting .429/.444/.600 (15-for-35) over his last 10 games (since 8/18)...has multi-hit efforts in six-of-10 games.
- C Omar Narváez** (2-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1K) has recorded three straight multi-hit games.
- RHP Juan Minaya** (1.2IP, 1H, 1K) has not allowed a run in his last six games (6.1IP).
