2018 NOTES

- Made 17 starts between Double-A Jacksonville, Triple-A New Orleans, and GCL Marlins; combined to go 10-3 with 2.36 ERA (95.1 ip /25 er).
- Opened season with Jacksonville, making three starts from April 7-20. Went 3-0 and tossed 5.0 innings in each start, posting a 0.60 ERA (15.0/1) and 20 strikeouts.
- Performance earned Southern League Player of the Week honors for April 5-15.
- In second start, on April 13, tied career high with 10 strikeouts, allowing four hits over 5.0 scoreless innings.
- Placed on 7-day DL on April 27 with right oblique strain.
- Made rehab start at GCL on June 18 (5.0 ip, 0 r, 2h, 5 so).
- Activated on June 23, making four starts for Jacksonville before his promotion to New Orleans.
- Made nine starts for Baby Cakes prior to having contract selected, posting a 5-2 record and 3.44 ERA, limiting opponents to two-or-fewer runs seven times.
- On July 25, held Reno scoreless over 6.2 innings on six hits, while striking out six.
- Six of 17 starts this season have been scoreless outings, each going 5.0 innings or longer.

2017 SUMMARY

- Spent season with Single-A Jupiter; was limited to 11 starts due to two trips to DL, including season-ending stint on July 29 with right oblique strain.
- Ten of 11 starts were 5.0 innings or more; lasted just 2.0 innings in final start of season.
- Did not debut until June 1 at Dunedin.
- Earned win in two of first three starts, posting 1.53 ERA (17.2/3) and striking out 12.
- Pitched season-high 6.2 innings in second start of season, June 6 at Tampa, and recorded season-high nine strikeouts on June 30 vs. Lakeland.
- Third start, on June 12 at St. Lucie, allowed one hit over 6.0 shutout innings, with two walks and four strikeouts, earning Florida State League Pitcher of the Week award for June 12-18 (first career weekly award).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Spent 2016 with Jupiter and struck out 112 in 122.2 innings across 27 appearances (23 starts).
- Had only career save opportunity on July 10 vs. Tampa, picking up a 4.0 inning save (0 h, 0 r, 3 bb, 7 so).
- From June 30 to July 27, appeared in six games (five starts) and posted a 3-0 record with one save and a 0.52 ERA (34.2 ip/2 er), striking out 38.

- Started 2015 in Dodgers' system with Single-A Great Lakes and Single-A Rancho Cucamonga, combining to go 6-5 with 5.52 ERA (75.0/46) in 19 games (14 starts), with 75 strikeouts.
- Picked up first career win on April 13, for Great Lakes at West Michigan, a relief outing (3.0 ip, h, bb, 6 so).
- Finished season with Jupiter after being acquired by Marlins in trade on July 30.
- Went 6-5 with 1.87 ERA (33.2/7) in six games (five starts) for Hammerheads, striking out 22.
- Made Marlins' organizational debut with a start on August 5 at Bradenton, taking loss after allowing four earned runs on five hits and two walks over 4.0 innings.
- For rest of season, did not pitch less than 5.0 innings or allow more than two earned runs in any outing, going 2-1 with 0.91 ERA (29.2/3) and 20 strikeouts.
- Made professional debut in 2014 with Rookie-level Ogden in Pioneer League.
- Made debut on July 4 at Idaho Falls, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings in relief.
