**TODAY'S GAME:** The Braves and Red Sox open a three-game set today with the fourth meeting between the clubs this season...The Braves dropped two of three in Boston earlier this season, May 25-27.

*A* Since the beginning of the 2006 season, the Braves have lost 12 of 15 against the Red Sox in Atlanta, including each of the last three...They club has not beaten the Red Sox in consecutive games here since June 14 and 15, 2002.

*A* RHP Touki Toussaint is set to make his second career MLB appearance today...The 22-year-old native of Pembroke Pines, Fla., beat Miami, 9-1, here on August 13 in his major league debut.

*A* RHP Nathan Eovaldi is scheduled to face the Braves for the first time since August 30, 2015, while with New York (AL)...The righty earned the win in a 20-6 victory at Turner Field...For his career, Eovaldi is 3-3 with 2.82 ERA (26 ER/83.0 IP) in 13 games, all starts, against the Braves, including going 2-3 with a 2.50 ERA (20 ER/72.0 IP) in 11 starts from 2012-2014 as a member of the Marlins.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Braves acquired OF Preston Tucker from the Cincinnati Reds yesterday in exchange for cash considerations...The club also designated OF Dustin Peterson for assignment...Tucker will wear No. 8 when he reports...With the addition of Tucker, the Braves will have 33 active players on the roster.

*A* Tucker, who appeared in 62 games with the Braves earlier this season before being included in a four-player trade with the Reds on July 30, hit .189 (7-for-37) with two home runs in 17 games for Cincinnati.

**NEVER QUIT WITH SNIT:** Each of the Braves' last three wins have come in their last at-bat after they scored four more times in the eighth inning last night to win, 5-1, over Pittsburgh...They now have 16 last at-bat wins this season, tied for the fourth-most in the National League.

*A* Since Brian Snitker was named interim manager on May 17, 2016, the Braves have 53 last at-bat wins, the most in the National League.

*A* The Braves led the N.L. in last at-bat victories the last two seasons...They had 20 in 2017 and 19 in 2016.

*A* The Braves have scored 223 times in the seventh inning or later this season, the second-most such runs in the National League this season...Only Chicago has more at 247.

**THE ROTATION:** RHP Julio Teheran tossed 7.0 innings of one-run ball last night and since adding RHP Kevin Gausman to the rotation on August 1, the Braves have the fifth-best starter's ERA in the majors at 2.84 (58 ER/184.0).

**LEADOFF HOME RUNS:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. drove Nick Kingham's second pitch of yesterday's game out to left field for his seventh leadoff home run of the season...Acuña Jr. tied Marquis Grissom for the most leadoff home runs in a single season in franchise history.

*A* Grissom set the record over 157 games in 1996; yesterday was Acuña Jr.'s 41st game hitting leadoff since moving into the spot on July 20 in the first game out of the All-Star break.

*A* Acuña Jr. is now one behind St. Louis' Matt Carpenter for the most leadoff home runs this season...Carpenter has led off 92 times this season.

**SINCE THE BREAK:** OF Ronald Acuña Jr. finished 3-for-4 with a home run and scored the go-ahead run in the eighth inning yesterday to help the Braves to their 24th win this season after the All-Star Game.

*A* Since the break, Acuña Jr. is hitting .346 (56-for-162) with 36 runs scored and 16 home runs in 42 games...He is averaging a home run every 10.13 at-bats over this stretch...For context, Hank Aaron holds the franchise record for a full season, averaging a home run every 10.53 at-bats in 1971.

*A* Among N.L. players since the break, Acuña Jr. ranks tied for first in runs (36) and home runs (16), while ranking second in hits (56), tied for second in RBI (31) and third in OPS (1.141).

**YOUNG PITCHERS:** RHP Touki Toussaint is one of four Braves starters to win his major league debut this season, joining RHP Mike Soroka, LHP Kolby Allard, and RHP Bryse Wilson.

*A* The Braves are just the second team in the last 110 seasons to have four different starters win their MLB debut in the same season...The 2009 Baltimore Orioles had five such pitchers.

**THE BULLPEN:** Three relievers combined to toss 2.0 more scoreless innings last night, and over the last 13 games, the Atlanta bullpen owns a 0.94 ERA (4 ER/38.1 IP).

*A* Prior to this stretch, Braves relievers allowed 13 runs over a four-game sweep by Colorado.

*A* Despite that rough stretch, the Braves still own the third-best bullpen ERA since the All-Star break at 3.14 (46 ER/132.0 IP).

*A* They have allowed 10 home runs since the break, second fewest in baseball...Only Pittsburgh has allowed fewer with nine.

**INTERLEAGUE:** This series marks the Braves final interleague matchup of the season...They are 8-9 against the American League so far this season.

*A* Since winning consecutive series against Los Angeles and Oakland at Turner Field in 2014, the Braves have won one interleague set in Atlanta...They beat Detroit in two of three games to close out 2016.

#### Today's Game

- A** Atlanta recalled him from Triple-A Gwinnett, 9/1, and he is set to make his second major league start.
- A** Made his major league debut in the first game of a doubleheader, 8/13 vs. MIA, and was returned to Gwinnett postgame.
  - A** Tossed 6.0 two-hit innings in his debut, allowing one run and two walks while fanning four.
  - A** Became just the third Braves pitcher over the last 110 seasons to go at least 6.0 innings and allow no more than two hits in his debut, joining James Parr (9/4/08 vs. WSH) and Armando Reynoso (8/11/91 vs. HOU).
- A** Earned the win in his major league debut and became the third Braves starter to win his MLB debut this season, joining Mike Soroka (5/1 at NYM) and Kolby Allard (7/31 vs. MIA).
  - A** Since Toussaint won his first game vs. Miami, Bryse Wilson has debuted and defeated the Pittsburgh Pirates on 8/20.
  - A** The Braves are just the second team in the last 110 seasons to have four different starters win their MLB debut in the same season...The 2009 Baltimore Orioles had five such pitchers.
- A** Starts today at 22 years, 75 days old...Is the eighth-youngest pitcher to start a game this season.
  - A** Of the eight youngest pitchers to start a game, five have done so for Atlanta... RHP Mike Soroka made five starts for Atlanta, while LHP Kolby Allard, LHP Luiz Gohara and RHP Bryse Wilson have each started once for Atlanta.
- A** Made 24 starts at the minor league level, splitting his season between Double-A Mississippi and Triple-A Gwinnett...Combined to go 9-6 with a 2.38 ERA (36 ER/136.1 IP) and 163 strikeouts.
  - A** Opened the season in Mississippi and made 16 starts with the M-Braves (4-6, 2.93)...Transferred to Gwinnett on 7/4 and went 5-0 with a 1.43 ERA in eight starts for the Stripers.
  - A** At the time of his recall, his 163 strikeouts were most among Atlanta farmhands and tied for eighth most in the minor leagues...His 10.8 SO/9.0 IP is the highest rate of his career.
- A** Entered the 2018 season tabbed by MLB.com as Atlanta's No. 11 prospect and as the Braves No. 14 farmhand by Baseball America.
- A** Name is pronounced TWO-key TWO-sahnt...His complete bio is available on page 320 of the 2018 Atlanta Braves media guide.

#### 2018 Recap

- A** Has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his last 14 starts, regardless of level, dating to 6/4 while with Double-A Mississippi...Is 8-1 with a 1.34 ERA (13 ER/87.0 IP) and a .184 opponents' batting average in that span.
  - A** His team has gone 11-3.
- A** Atlanta selected his contract today from Triple-A Gwinnett, optioned him to the Stripers and then appointed him as the 26th man for the doubleheader, 8/13... Made his major league debut.
  - A** Is one of 11 Atlanta players to debut this season, and one of four starting pitchers...RHP Mike Soroka started against the New York Mets on 5/1, LHP Kolby Allard debuted with a start vs. Miami on 7/31, and RHP Bryse Wilson started at Pittsburgh on 8/20.
  - A** LHP Jesse Biddle (4/21), OF Ronald Acuña Jr. (4/25), OF Dustin Peterson (5/28), RHP Evan Phillips (7/3), LHP Adam McCreery (8/9), RHP Wes Parsons (8/9) and RHP Chad Sobotka (8/10) have also debuted this season.
- A** Became the second Atlanta starter to debut against Miami in franchise history.
  - A** LHP Kolby Allard was the first to do so, when he started against the Marlins just 13 days ago on 7/31.
- A** Ranks in the Top 10 among Atlanta's starting farmhands in strikeouts (1st, 163), strikeouts per 9.0 innings (1st, 10.8), wins (T2nd, 9), hits per 9.0 innings (3rd, 6.7), WHIP (3rd, 1.130), starts (T3rd, 24) and innings (4th, 136.1).
- A** Entered 2018 with 201 career walks in 393.2 innings (4.97 BB/9.0 IP)...Has walked just 53 batters in 136.1 innings (3.5 BB/9.0 IP) this season.
  - A** Has three starts this season in which he has not walked a batter...Had six starts without a walk in his first four professional campaigns.
- A** Named a Southern League Mid-Season All-Star while with Mississippi.
- A** Has four double-digit strikeout performances, including a season-best 11 on 6/30 at Pensacola.

#### Career Recap

- A** Acquired by the Braves along with RHP Bronson Arroyo from the Arizona Diamondbacks in exchange for INF Phil Gosselin on 6/20/2015.
  - A** Originally drafted by Arizona in the first round (16th overall) in the 2014 First-Year Player Draft.
- A** Is 26-38 with a 4.08 ERA (240 ER/530.0 IP) over 106 career minor league games, including 101 starts.

- Recalled, 8/29, from Triple-A Gwinnett for his fourth stint on the active roster...Was also up from 8/11-18, and on 8/7 and 7/31...Was added to the roster as the 26th man for the doubleheader on 8/7...Had his contract selected, 7/31, and started versus Miami in his major league debut...Optioned to Triple-A Gwinnett postgame that night.
- Has allowed seven earned runs over 3.0 innings in two relief appearances with the Braves...Last pitched for Atlanta on 8/17 vs. COL (1.0 IP, 4 H, 3 R).
- Started vs. MIA, 7/31, in his major league debut...Allowed nine hits and five runs (four earned) over 5.0 innings to earn the win...At the age of 20 years, 352 days, became the youngest left-hander to win his debut for the Braves since Charlie Vaughan did so on September 3, 1966 at the age of 18 years, 332 days.
- Is 6-4 with a 2.72 ERA (34 ER/112.1 IP) in 19 starts for Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

- Has a 2.32 ERA in 48 relief appearances for Atlanta this season, the second lowest ERA by a left-handed rookie reliever in franchise history...Only Jonny Venters' 1.95 ERA in 2010 is lower.
- Has a seven-game scoreless streak dating to 8/19...Has fanned nine over 6.1 scoreless innings.
- Pitched more than 1.0 inning in 14 outings this season, compiling a 0.95 ERA (3 ER/28.1 IP) with 43 strikeouts...Three of his four wins this season have come in outings longer than 1.0 inning.
- Opponents are 7-for-39 (.179) with runners in scoring position, including 2-for-16 (.125) with two outs.
- Converted the first save of his career, 8/5 at NYM...Joined Arody Vizcaino, A.J. Minter, Luiz Gohara, Luke Jackson, Jonny Venters and Dan Winkler as Atlanta relievers with a save this season.
- Set career highs in IP (3.0) and strikeouts (8), 6/2 vs. WSH... Became the first Braves reliever in 110 seasons to strike out at least eight batters in that few innings...MIL's Josh Hader struck out eight in 2.2 IP, 4/30/18 at CIN.
