THE GIANTS: Will play the final game of this series against the Dodgers as **LHP Ty Blach** and LHP Clayton Kershaw are set to face each other for the second time this season...today marks the fourth time Blach and Kershaw have matched up in an outing...Blach has gone 2-1 with a 1.00 ERA (2er, 18.0ip) in these first three outings, while Kershaw is 1-2 with a 1.80 ERA (4er, 20.0ip).

CUTCH IS CLUTCH: OF Andrew McCutchen had one of the best games of his career in his seventh game in a Giants uniform last night as he recorded a career-best six hits, while hitting a game-ending three-run homer in the 14th inning to give San Francisco a 7-5 victory over LAD... McCutchen became just the second player in the live-ball era to tally six-plus hits including a walkoff homer in a game, joining Detroit's Jim Northrup, Aug. 28, 1969 vs. Oakland (*Elias*).

- McCutchen's homer in the 14th inning was the second-latest walkoff homer in the Giants and Dodgers series - Valmy Thomas, May 11, 1957 (15th) (*Elias*).
- He became just the fourth Giants player with a six-hit game since the franchise moved to San Francisco in 1958... McCutchen joined Jesus Alou (6-for-6, July 10, 1964), Mike Benjamin (6-for-7, June 14, 1995) and Brandon Crawford (7-for-8, Aug. 8, 2016).
- McCutchen was the first player with a walkoff homer with his team trailing in the 14th inning or later since July 11, 2015 when he also accomplished the feat against St. Louis (*ESPN Stats & Info*).

BIRTHDAY WISHES: Happy Birthday to Giants President & CEO **Larry Baer** and to Giants beat writer **Henry Schulman**.

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants and Dodgers have 10 games scheduled through April 29 (SF & LA have already played one another five times)...according to *Elias*, there has been only one instance in Major League history in which two clubs played against each other 10 times before the end of April: Baltimore/Tampa Bay in 2003...there are three sets that will do it this April: San Diego/Colorado, Tampa Bay/Boston and San Francisco/Los Angeles-NL.

HOMER HAPPY: The Giants have outhomered their opponents by a 10-2 margin through their first seven games this season.

RISPY BUSINESS: The Giants went 2-for-13 last night with runners in scoring position and are now hitting just .127 (7-for-55) with RISP this season.

IN THE 'PEN: San Francisco's bullpen has combined to go 2-0 with a 2.54 ERA (8er, 28.1ip) and 31 strikeouts in the first seven games of the season.

GETTING AHEAD: The Giants are 4-0 this season when scoring first and 0-3 in games their opponent scores first.

The new-look Giants made a rousing debut in an 8-3, Opening Night romp at the Astrodome...**Will Clark's** first Major League swing resulted in a home run off Nolan Ryan...**Robby Thompson** doubled and **Candy Maldonado** hit a game-winning, three-run triple as a pinch-hitter.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#50 LHP Ty Blach
6-2, 200, 27 years old (October 20, 1990)
1-1 Record, 5.79 ERA

- The 27-year-old left-hander enters his third season in a Giants uniform and will take the hill for his third start of the season.
- Started six spring games, going 1-1 with a 4.05 ERA (9er, 20.0ip)...struck out 16 batters compared to five walks this spring.
- Took the loss in his last start this past Tuesday in the Giants' 6-4 loss against the Mariners...he allowed six runs on 10 hits and two walks with two strikeouts.
- Earned his first win of the season on March 29 in the Giants' 1-0 victory at Los Angeles-NL...tossed 5.0-scoreless innings, allowing three hits and three walks with three strikeouts...he became the first Giants pitcher to start the season opener other than **Madison Bumgarner, Matt Cain** or **Tim Lincecum** since 2008 when **Barry Zito** was the club's Opening Day starter.
- His 26 career Major League starts entering Opening Day were the second-fewest of any Giants Opening Day starting pitcher since 1958...in 1982, **LHP Al Holland** was the Giants' Opening Day starter and he had just three previous MLB starts entering that contest (STATS, LLC).
- In five career starts against the Dodgers, he owns a 1.41 ERA (5er, 32.0ip), which is one of the lowest by any Giants pitcher since both teams moved west 60 years ago.
- This marks the fourth time in his career he has matched up against Clayton Kershaw in an outing... has gone 2-1 with a 1.00 ERA (2er, 18.0ip) in his first three starts...owns a .429 avg. (3-for-7) with a double in his career when hitting against Kershaw.
- Left-handed batters are 6-for-14 (.429) off him so far this season...in 2017, he held lefties to a .250 clip (43-for-172) with just eight extra-base hits (all doubles).
- Finished 2017 with an 8-12 record and a 4.78 ERA (87er, 163.2ip) in 34 games (24 starts)...as a starter went 8-12 with a 4.81 ERA (80er, 149.2ip) in 24 starts...the Giants went 9-15 in his starts and dropped each of his last five games, including seven of his last nine contests.

NOTES: Hit .227 (10-for-44) last season but did have a few highlight games with the bat...recorded his first career homer, drove in three runs and pitched 8.0- innings in the Giants' 11-2 win over the A's on Aug. 3, 2017...became just the third Giants rookie pitcher to drive in at least three runs in a game since the team began playing in San Francisco in 1958, joining Jim Duffalo (four in 1961) and Brad Hennessey (three in 2005) (*Elias*)...walked three times on June 2 at PHI and became the first pitcher in MLB to draw three walks in a game since COL's Aaron Cook on Oct. 1, 2009 vs. MIL...was the first Giants' pitcher to draw three walks in a game since **Ray Sadecki** on Sept. 1, 1969 vs. MON.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP DEREK HOLLAND

2018: 0-1, 5.40 ERA / Career: 69-65, 4.58

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his second start in a Giants uniform and the 186th of his career...suffered the loss on March 31 at Dodger Stadium...tossed 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (three earned runs) on three hits and three walks with four strikeouts...appeared in six games this spring, going 1-1 with a 4.05 ERA (9er, 20.0ip) and 23 strikeouts...entered camp as non-roster invitee after signing a minor league contract with SF on Feb. 9...has never faced the Diamondbacks.
