CARDINALS NOTES

- **Carlos Martínez** made his ninth start of the season, first against the Marlins in 2018 and his fifth career against the Marlins (2-1)... is making his first start since May 8 vs. MIN after missing 23 games on the 10-day D.L. with a lat strain...induced three double plays for the 6th time in his career matching his career-high; now tied for 4th-most among N.L. pitchers this season...passed **Chris Carpenter** (356) into 4th place for all-time strikeouts at Busch Stadium (359)...snapped his streak of 65 straight games pitching into the 5th inning (13 outs or more) dating back to 2016.
- **Matt Carpenter** snapped an 0-for-14 with a multi-hit game, his 13th of the season...tallied his 4th three-hit game of the season and first since 5/21 vs. KC (2nd career three-hit game vs. MIA 8/13/14 at Marlins Park).
- **Marcell Ozuna** has an RBI in three straight games (season-high is 4)...has multi-hit games in 3 of his last four games hitting safely in all four (8-14, .571)...is batting .750 against his former club (3-4, RBI) with hits in his first three at-bats...collected his 6th three-hit game of the season (T5th N.L.).
- **Dexter Fowler** recorded his 3rd hit off a left-handed pitcher (2-for-last-2) after starting the season 1-for-31.
- **Kolten Wong** hit safely in three straight games, tying his longest streak of the season...hit his first double since April 29 at PIT.
- **Luke Voit** has reached base safely in both of his plate appearances this season, both pinch-hit appearances (1B, BB).
- **Preston Guilmet** made his first appearance with the Cardinals and his first in MLB since 8/3/15 w/MIL vs. SD...suffered his 2nd career MLB loss (last: 5/29/14 at HOU w/BAL).
- **The Cardinals** committed two or more errors for the 11th game this season...suffered their first loss when recording 12 or more hits (previously 8-0)...are 5-7 following off days this season.

MARLINS NOTES

- **José Ureña** made his team-leading 13th start of the season, first against the Cardinals in 2018 and fourth career start vs. the Cardinals (2-1)...snapped a 7-game losing streak (last win: 9/20/17 vs. NYM)...Marlins had been 0-12 in his starts this season and 0-14 dating back to last season, the longest streak in club history without a win...had the lowest run support average in MLB (2.86) entering tonight...surrendered a season-high 10 hits, 2nd highest total in his career.
- **Brian Anderson** tied his season-high with three hits...has three or more RBI in a game for the 3rd time this season and first since April 30...has a hit in 9 of his last 10 games vs. N.L. Central opponents (14-37, .378)...has reached base safely in 50-of-60 games this season...collected his 20th multi-hit game of the season...has three straight multi-hit games for the first time in his career...hit his first home run on the road this season.

- **Derek Dietrich** recorded his first career outfield assist when he threw out Matt Carpenter at first base in the 1st inning on a double play...collected his 400th career hit with a single to right field in the 3rd inning...tied his season-high with two runs scored (4th game)...recored his first sac fly of the season.
- **Justin Bour** tallied his first sac fly of the season (had four last season)...3rd time he's had RBI in consecutive games this season.
- **Starlin Castro** extended his hitting streak to seven games (9-30, .300) with a single in the 3rd inning.
- **JT Riddle** connected for his 2nd home run, both solo shots accounting for all his RBI this season (5/29 at SD), this one was not an inside-the-park...has hit safely in his last five games vs. STL, all coming at Busch Stadium (8-18, .444).
- **JB Shuck** walked a career-high three times tonight, his highest total in 408 career games since 2011...scored his first run since May 13 vs. ATL (16 games).
- **Adam Conley** has struck out a batter in all six appearances this season and two or more in each of his last three.
- **Drew Steckenrider** pitched his 7th straight scoreless appearance (6.0 IP)...has not allowed a run to the Cardinals in three career appearances (2.1 IP).
- **Brad Ziegler** threw his first scoreless inning since May 23 at NYM...had allowed six runs on seven hits in his last three appearances (2.0 IP) entering tonight.
- **Kyle Barraclough** extended his scoreless streak to 11 straight appearances (10.2 IP) allowing one hit (5/22 at NYM) over that span... his 10.2 scoreless inning streak is currently the longest active among Marlins pitchers, 4th-longest of the season by Marlins pitchers and 4th-longest active among National League pitchers...8 of his 9 career appearances against his original drafting team (STL) have been scoreless.
- The **Marlins** have won 3 of their last four games at Busch Stadium...snapped a six-game losing streak and tied their highest run output of their current road trip on their first game at SD (5/28) with seven runs (has scored seven runs total in their last four games)... won their first game this season when surrendering 11 or more hits (0-15 previously)...are 2-20 when allowing 10 or more hits (defeated LAD on 5/16, 10 hits)...relief pitchers retired the last 12 straight batters in the game.
