The spring roster is currently at 63 players (40 roster, 23 non-roster)...the camp breakdown by position is the following: 32 pitchers (9 non-roster), 6 catchers (3 non-roster), 13 infielders (5 non-roster) and 12 outfielders (6 non-roster).

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their 42nd spring training with a Cactus League match-up tonight against the Colorado Rockies at Peoria Stadium...tonight's game is the 12th of a 32-game Cactus League schedule for the Mariners that concludes March 27 vs. the Colorado Rockies at Salt River Fields...the Mariners will open the 2018 season March 29 vs. Cleveland at Safeco Field.

BULLPEN BULLIES...the Mariners relievers have not allowed a run in the last 11.0 innings in relief, dating back to the 4th inning on March 3 vs. the Angels...over the last 3 games (3/2-current), the bullpen has allowed only 3 earned runs over 18.0 innings (1.50 ERA)...during this 3-game stretch, the Mariners relievers have limited opponents to a .149 (10x67) average while walking 6 and striking out 22...RH **Dan Altavilla** (SV, 3 G, 3.0 IP, 1 H, 6 K), LH **Sam Moll** (SV, 3 G, 3.0 IP, 1 H) and RH **Ljay Newsome** (SV, 2 G, 3.0 IP, 1 BB, 2 K) have recorded 3 saves and combined to allow only 2 hits while walking 1 and striking out 8 over 9.0 scoreless inning.

VS. THE ROCKIES...the Mariners and Rockies meet tonight in the first of three Cactus League match-ups this spring (also: March 13 at COL and March 27 at COL)...the Mariners went 1-0-2 vs. the Rockies in 3 spring games in 2017...the clubs will face each other in the regular season July 13-15 in Denver...Seattle leads the all-time regular season series, 22-16, including winning 9 of the last 13 regular season meetings between the two teams (3-1 in 2017).

INJURY REPORT...two Mariners who have been sidelined by injury received positive news today: **Mitch Haniger** and **Ryon Healy** have both been cleared to start swinging a bat again...Healy is rehabbing from surgery to remove a bone spur in his right hand...Haniger had inflammation in his right hand.

SPEAKING OF GETTING HOT...**Kyle Seager** has hit safely in 4 of the first 5 games he has appeared this spring, batting .500 (7x14) with 2 runs, 1 double and 1 RBI...**Gordon Beckham** (.588/10x17, 6 R, 3 2B, HR, RBI, BB, SB, 2 HBP), **Braden Bishop** (.471/7x15, 3 R, 2B, 3B, 2 RBI, BB, SF, SH), **Dee Gordon** (.429/6x14, 4 R, 2B, 3B, HR, 3 RBI), **Daniel Vogelbach** (.417/5x12, 3 R, 2B, HR, 3 RBI, 4 BB), **Jean Segura** (.400/4x10, 3 R, 2 HR, 6 RBI, 3 BB, SB, SF) and **Andrew Romine** (.389/7x18, 2 R, 2B, HR, 4 RBI, BB, SB, SH) are all hitting over .380 this spring (min 10 AB).

SWING IT LIKE BECKHAM...**Gordon Beckham** has hit safely in all 7 games he has appeared this spring, batting .588 (10x17) with 6 runs, 3 doubles, 1 home run, 1 RBI, 1 walk, 1 stolen base and 2 HBP...Beckham's .588 average leads all of Spring Training...his 10 hits are tied with Atlanta's Ronald Acuna Jr., Colorado's Ryan McMahon and Atlanta's Danny Santana for 2nd-most among all players (Chicago-NL's Mike Freeman, 11).

ON THE AIR...tonight's telecast on **ROOT SPORTS NW** will feature in-game interviews with Mariners infielder **Andrew Romine** and right-hander **Dan Altavilla**...**Dave Sims** and **Mike Blowers** will call the action on TV tonight...16 of the Mariners 32 Cactus League games will be televised by **ROOT SPORTS NW** this spring, equaling the most Spring Training telecasts in club history.

PLAY-BY-PLAY...all radio broadcasts, including tonight's game vs. the Rockies, can be heard live on Mariners.com...tonight's broadcast will also be aired live on **710 ESPN Seattle** beginning at 5:30 p.m. PT...**Rick Rizzs** and **Aaron Goldsmith** will call the action today...**710 ESPN Seattle** is broadcasting 30 of the club's 32 Cactus League games this spring.

UNDER THE LIGHTS...the Mariners 2018 Cactus League schedule features 32 games: 16 home games at the Peoria Sports Complex, 14 road games and two "road" games in Peoria vs. complex neighbors San Diego...of the club's 16 home games, nine will start at 6:40 p.m., the most night games in Mariners Spring Training history...Seattle will also play three night games on the road for a total of 12 night games this spring...the additional night games are designed to prepare players for the routine of regular season start times.

HEY MIKE, DID YOU KNOW?...that **Jean Segura** has the 3rd-best batting average against the Colorado Rockies among active players?...in his career, he's hit .374 (58x155) with 31 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs and 20 RBI in 40 games against Colorado...he trails only Miguel Cabrera (.406/65x160) and Matt Holliday (.378/56x148) in batting vs. the Rockies.

2018 Spring Training - 0-0, 0.00 ERA in 2 GS...allowed 1 H in 2.0 ShO IP in Cactus League debut on 3/24 vs. CWS...allowed only 4 hits and struck out 4 over 3.0 scoreless innings on 3/1 vs. KC.

- **Last Season** - Went 10-13 with a 3.92 ERA (81 ER, 186.0 IP) with 130 K's in 31 combined starts with St. Louis (26 GS) & Seattle (5 GS).
- **Seattle Finish** - In 5 starts with the Mariners, posted a record of 3-1 with a 2.53 ERA (9 ER, 32.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts.
- **The Trade** - Acquired with cash and international slot money from St. Louis in exchange for Rayder Ascanio (inf) on Aug. 30, 2017.
- **30** - Recorded 6th consecutive season with 30+ starts...1 of 4 pitchers with 30+ starts since 2012 (also: Max Scherzer, Jon Lester and Ian Kennedy).
- **Taking His Turn** - Since making his Major League debut in 2010, has made 233 starts, 16th-most among all pitchers...among all pitchers since 2010, ranks 16th in innings pitched (1446.1).
- **Quick Rise** - Became the 21st player since the MLB Draft began in 1965 to appear in the Major Leagues before playing in a minor league game (last: Xavier Nady, SD, 2000)...is just the 13th pitcher to reach the Majors before appearing in the minor leagues (last: Ariel Prieto, Oakland, 1995)...made his MLB debut on April 11, 2010 vs. Chicago-NL with Cincinnati after being selected by the Reds with the 8th overall pick in the 2009 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- **Career** - Has appeared in parts of 8 Major League seasons with the Reds (2010-15), Giants (2015), Cardinals (2016-17) and Mariners (2017-c)...selected and signed by the Reds in the 1st round (8th overall) of the 2008 MLB Draft out of Arizona State University.

2018 Spring Training: 0-0-1, 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 3.0 IP) in 3 G...has struck out 6 of 10 BF in 3 G...struck out the side in the 9th inning to earn SV#1 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...struck out 2 in 1.0 IP on 2/26 at CHI...tossed scoreless 5th inning on 3/2 at MIL (1.0,1,0,0,0,1).

- **Totals** - Went 1-1, 4.24 ERA (22 ER, 46.2 IP) & 52 K's in 41 G with Seattle.
- **Tacoma Time** - Was 2-0 with 6 saves and a 1.54 ERA (4 ER, 23.1 IP) with 36 strikeouts and 15 walks in 20 relief appearances with AAA Tacoma.
- **Career** - Is 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA (23 ER, 59.0 IP) with 62 strikeouts and 21 walks in 56 career appearances over 2 seasons with Seattle (2016-17).
- **Drafted** - Selected by Seattle in the 5th round of the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Mercyhurst College.

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 1.93 ERA (1 ER, 4.2 IP) in 3 G...allowed 1 R on 2 H and K'd 3 in Cactus League debut on 2/23 at SD...allowed 1 H and 1 K in 1.2 ShO IP on 2/26 at CHI...tossed 2.0 ShO IP on 3/2 at MIL (2.01,0,0,2,2).

- **Welcome to Seattle** - Acquired by Seattle from Cleveland in exchange for international slot money on Dec. 13, 2017.
- **The Totals** - Went 1-0, 4.38 ERA (12 ER, 24.2 IP) in 21 G with Cleveland.
- **Career** - In parts of 3 seasons with Cleveland (2015-17), is 1-0 with a 3.53 ERA (17 ER, 43.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts and 17 walks in 39 games.
- **Drafted** - Selected by Cleveland in the 18th round of the 2011 MLB Draft.

#61 — Casey Lawrence (RHP):

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 1.80 (1 ER, 5.0 IP) in 2 G...allowed 1 unearned run in 2.0 IP in Cactus League debut on 3/24 vs. CWS...allowed 1 R on 4 H over 3.0 innings in relief on 3/1 vs. KC (3.0,4,1,1,0,2).

- **Last Season** - Was 2-3 with a 6.34 ERA (39 ER, 55.1 IP) with 52 strikeouts in 27 appearances, including 2 starts, with Toronto (4 G) and Seattle (23 G).
- **Join the Club** - Claimed off waivers from Toronto on May 11 after being designated for assignment on May 8...re-signed with the Mariners as a minor league free agent on Nov. 28, 2017.
- **Rainiers** - In 11 G (7 GS) w/Tacoma, went 2-4, 4.08 (26 ER, 57.1 IP) with 41 strikeouts.
- **Career** - Originally signed with the Blue Jays as a non-drafted free agent on June 15, 2010...played 4 seasons at Albright (PA) College.

2018 Spring Training: 0-0, 10.13 ERA (3 ER, 2.2 IP) in 3 G...tossed a scoreless 5th inning (1 BB, 1 K) on 2/23 at SD...allowed 3 R on 3 H (1 BB, 1 HR) in 0.2 IP on 2/27 vs. SD...tossed 1-2-3 6th inning on 3/2 at MIL.

- **Last Season** - Went 4-5 with a 3.86 ERA (23 ER, 53.2 IP) with 65 strikeouts and 24 walks in 59 relief appearances.
- **Bullpen Marks** - Among Seattle relievers was 2nd in strikeouts (65), T2nd in wins (4), 3rd in innings (53.2), 4th in games (59) and ERA (3.86) and 5th in opponent batting average (.248).
- **Limiting Lefties** - Held lefties to a .218 (17x78) batting average.
- **Length** - Made 13 appearances of 1.1+ inning, including three outings of 2.0+ frames...when pitching 1.1+ innings, posted 0.43 ERA (1 ER, 21.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts.
- **Career** - Has appeared in 77 games, all in relief, over parts of three seasons with the Yankees (2015-16) and Mariners (2017)...selected and signed by New York-AL out of the 13th round of the 2012 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of San Diego.

- **Save It** - Went 1-0 with 8 saves and a 2.30 ERA (4 ER, 15.2 IP) in 10 save opportunities.
- **Mariners Farmhands** - Among all Mariners minor leaguers, ranked 3rd with 8 saves.
- **Leaderboard** - Among Cal League leaders, ranked T12th in games with 43.
- **Strong Finish** - Tossed 14.2 scoreless innings over his last 10 games, going 1-0 with 4 saves and a 0.00 ERA (0 ER, 14.2 IP), Aug. 6-Sept. 3.
- **Career** - Selected by the Mariners in the 23rd round of the 2015 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Ashland University...has spent his entire 3-year pro career in the Mariners organization, compiling a record of 15-3 with 8 saves and a 3.16 ERA (64 ER, 182.1 IP) with 170 strikeouts and 74 walks in 76 games, including 20 starts.
