THE TWINS: Came out of the Thursday off-day with a win over the Rays in Port Charlotte yesterday afternoon by a score of 4-3... José Berríos (1-0) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched... Tyler Kinley made his fifth appearance of the spring with 1.0 scoreless ninth inning, earning the save... the offense recorded eight hits, two from both Miguel Sanó and Byron Buxton... Sanó homered twice, once off right-hander Andrew Kittredge (2nd inning) and once off lefty Vidal Nuño (3rd inning)... postgame, the Twins and Rays wives played a softball game as the Twins team won 9-4 as the event raised \$19,500 for the Stoneman Douglas Victims Fund.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Kyle Gibson will be making his third start of the spring today... in his last start he pitched 3.0 innings, allowing one run on two hits and was dealt the loss March 5 vs. Philadelphia in Clearwater... last spring, he made seven starts, going 1-1, 1.59 ERA (28.1 IP, 5 ER) with five walks and 19 strikeouts... last regular season, Gibson started 29 games, combining to go 12-10, 5.07 ERA (158.0 IP, 89 ER) with 60 walks and 121 strikeouts... the veteran has started 127 games over five seasons in Minnesota, going 44-48, 4.70 ERA (730.1 IP, 381 ER) with 257 walks and 506 strikeouts... Gibson was drafted by the Twins in the first round (22nd overall) in the 2009 MLB draft out of the University of Missouri... he is in his fifth major league spring training.

CROSS TOWN RIVALS: Today marks the fourth of seven matchups between the Twins and Red Sox... the Twins won the last game by a score of 8-1 at jetBlue Park on Wednesday... the Twins went 3-3 against the Sox last spring, splitting the spring series... since the "Mayor's Cup" series began in 1993, the Twins have won The Cup 12 of the 25 years... the Twins and Sox will play during the regular season for three games at Target Field June 19-21 and four games at Fenway Park July 26-29.

SPRING TRAINING SERVICE: Of the nine players in the starting lineup, here is the number of spring training appearances: Brian Dozier - 8 (all with Twins), Joe Mauer - 17 (all with Twins), Jorge Polanco - 5 (all with Twins), Eduardo Escobar - 8 (6 with Twins, 2 with White Sox), Byron Buxton - 5 (all with Twins), Max Kepler - 5 (all with Twins), Robbie Grossman - 10 (2 with Twins, 1 with Indians, 3 with Astros & 4 with Pittsburgh), Mitch Garver - 4 (all with Twins), and Jason Castro - 10 (2 with Twins, 8 with Astros).

THE ARCHER: Fernando Rodney enters his 17th career spring training and first with the Twins after signing as a free agent on December 15, 2017 (one year contract with club option for 2019)... the Twins mark his ninth organization: Detroit (1999-2009), Los Angeles-AL (2010-11), Tampa Bay (2012-13), Seattle (2015), Chicago-NL (2015), Miami (2016), San Diego (2016) and Arizona (2017)... he ranks third among active saves leaders with 300, trailing only Francisco Rodriguez (437) and Huston Street (324).

THE NEWEST REED: Addison Reed is in his first spring training with the Twins and his seventh overall... split 2017 between New York-NL and Boston... began season with New York-NL and worked primarily in the closer role after the injury to Jeury Familia and converted 19 of 21 save opportunities for the Mets... acquired by Boston via trade July 31... allowed 10 runs total with Boston in 29 games, seven of which came over two appearances at New York-AL... in his other 27 appearances for Red Sox, posted a 1.01 ERA (26.2 IP, 3 ER).

RG36: Robbie Grossman is in his second spring training with the Twins and 10th of his career: Pittsburgh (2009-12), Houston (2013-15) and Cleveland (2016)... he appeared in a career-high 119 games last season, posting a .361 on-base percentage, which ranked second on the club, trailing Joe Mauer (.384)... since the start of 2016, he ranks second in all of baseball in on-base percentage (.372), trailing only Dexter Fowler (.378).

FIRST TIME CAMPERS: The following players are appearing in major league camp with the Twins for the first time: pitchers - Alan Busenitz, John Curtiss, Zach Duke, Dietrich Enns, Trevor Hildenberger, Myles Jaye, Tyler Kinley, Michael Kohn, Zack Littell, Gabriel Moya, Jake Odorizzi, Michael Pineda, Addison Reed, Fernando Rodney, Anibal Sánchez and Lewis Thorpe... catchers: Williams Astudillo, Brian Navareto, Jordan Pacheco and Bobby Wilson... infielders: Erick Aybar, Taylor Featherston, Logan Morrison, Gregorio Petit and Brock Stassi... outfielders: Nick Buss, Chris Heisey, Ryan LaMarre and LaMonte Wade.

ROLL CALL: The Twins have 53 players in camp (15 non-roster)... 26 pitchers (3 non-roster), five catchers (5 non-roster), 13 infielders (5 non-roster) and nine outfielders (4 non-roster)... the oldest player in camp is Fernando Rodney (born 3/18/77) at 40-years-old.
