NATIONALS NEWS

MOVING ON...

The Washington Nationals will face the Colorado Rockies in game three of this four-game weekend set this afternoon...Washington dropped game two, 5-1, on Friday night despite a strong outing from **Tanner Roark** (6.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, BB, 3 SO, HR) and 3.0 innings of scoreless relief from the bullpen...**Brandon Kintzler** (1.0 IP, 2 SO), **Sammy Solis** (1.1 IP, 2 H, 3 SO) and **Trevor Gott** (0.2 IP, SO) combined to strike out six batters without issuing a walk.

- Following Sunday's series finale against the Rockies, the Nationals will embark on a 10-day, nine-game road trip that will include games against the New York Mets (3 G), Los Angeles Dodgers (3 G) and San Francisco Giants (3 G).

SPEAKING OF THE 'PEN

Nationals relievers have allowed just two of 16 inherited runners to score this season...Their 12.5% inherited runners scored percent ranks second in the National League and fourth in Major League Baseball...They are one of two National League teams (and one of six in MLB) to allow two or fewer inherited runners to score.

- Henry Blanco's** bullpen has also been strong when it comes to striking out batters...Washington's relievers lead the National League and rank second in Major League Baseball with 11.46 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (behind NYY - 13.34)...Their 59 strikeouts rank fourth in the National League.
- Sammy Solis** ranks third among National League relievers with 13 strikeouts and **Sean Doolittle** is tied for eighth with 11.

HOWIE'S DOIN' IT

Howie Kendrick saw his hitting streak snapped at 10 games on Friday Night...He clubbed his first home run of the season on Thursday night, a solo shot in the fifth inning off Chad Bettis...The home run extended his hitting streak to 10 games.

- Kendrick has reached base safely in 10 of 12 games of the season...He was hit by a pitch on April 4 at Atlanta while serving as a pinch hitter...Kendrick has recorded five multi-hit efforts along the way, while seven of his 15 hits have been extra base hits (6 2B, HR).
- Kendrick is tied for fifth in the National League with six doubles.
- Since joining the Nationals prior to the 2017 trade deadline, Kendrick is hitting .299 with 14 doubles, two triples, eight homers, 31 RBI, four stolen bases and 24 runs scored in 64 games...He has posted a .344 on-base percentage and a .498 slugging percentage.

LEADING MAN

Bryce Harper clubbed his sixth home run of the season on Sunday, a two-run shot in the first inning off **Matt Harvey**...His six home runs lead Major League Baseball and he is tied for first with 16 walks...Harper ranks among National League hitters in runs scored (71st, 13), slugging percentage (2nd, .667), OPS (2nd, 1.104), RBI (3rd, 13), and on-base percentage (8th, .438).

- Of his 12 hits this season, six have been home runs...Moreover, Harper has 16 walks and just 10 strikeouts through the first 14 games of the season.

VOTE FOR PEDRO

Since being recalled on April 2, **Pedro Severino** has posted a .455 on-base percentage (8 H, 5 BB, 2 HBP)...He has hit safely in six of his nine games played, including five of his last six games.

- In seven starts, he is hitting .320 (8-for-25) with two doubles, three RBI, five walks, one stolen base and three runs scored...He has recorded two multi-hit efforts and driven in runs in three of the eight starts.

FUN IN THE FIRST

The Nationals have scored two runs in the first inning in three of their last five games...For the season, Washington's offense has scored at least one run in the first inning in nine of 14 games...In total, the Nationals have scored 18 runs in the first inning, ahead of the Arizona Diamondbacks (16) for the most in Major League Baseball.

NATIONALS HISTORY

April 14 (6-5 on this date)

2005 – In the first Major League game played in Washington D.C. since Sept. 30, 1971, the Nationals beat the Diamondbacks at RFK Stadium, 5-3. President **George W. Bush** threw out the ceremonial first pitch after receiving the ball from **Joe Grzenda**, the former Washington Senators reliever who threw the final pitch in Senators history. **Livan Hernandez** earned the win, allowing three earned runs on three hits in 8.1 innings of work. **Vinny Castilla** hit his first home run of the season, a two-run shot in the sixth inning.

2016 – The Nationals completed a four-game sweep of the Atlanta Braves with a 6-2 victory, improving to 7-1 on the season. The 2016 Nationals were the first team to start a season 7-1 since baseball returned to the District in 2005. In the win, **Bryce Harper** clubbed his 100th career home run, becoming the eighth-youngest player in MLB history to reach the 100-homer mark (*Elias*). The third-inning grand slam off **Julio Teheran** marked the first time a player clubbed a grand slam for his 100th career home run.

IN THE COMMUNITY

April 15: Jackie Robinson Day

On Sunday the Nationals, Major League Baseball and the entire baseball family will pay homage to the contributions of **Jackie Robinson** and his enduring impact on society and the game of baseball. The Nationals are honored to be joined by Medal of Freedom winner and civil rights icon, Congressman **John Lewis**, who will be throwing out the ceremonial first pitch.

OPPONENT

COLORADO ROCKIES

Henry Blanco spent the 1999 season with the Colorado Rockies...**Ian Desmond** spent seven Major League seasons in Washington from 2009-15...This will be his his first action against his former team, as he was on the disabled list during the 2017 matchups.

THE SERIES

The Nationals and Rockies will play four games this weekend in D.C. and will not match up again until the final series of the season, Sept. 28-30 at Colorado...The Rockies have won six of the last seven games at Nationals Park since Aug. 27, 2016.

DAVE MARTINEZ

Nationals manager **Dave Martinez** was named the seventh field manager in Nationals history on Oct. 30, 2017. He joined the Nationals for what will be his 30th season in professional baseball. A 16-year Major League outfielder, Martinez has been a Major League coach for the last 10 seasons, serving as Cubs manager **Joe Maddon's** bench coach and right-hand man in Chicago (2015-17) as well as Tampa Bay (2008-14). This is the first Major League managerial assignment of Martinez's career.

#31 - MAX SCHERZER - RHP

Polished veteran right-hander, three-time Cy Young Award Winner and five-time consecutive All-Star signed a historic seven-year contract with Washington on Jan. 21, 2015...Joined the Nationals after seven Major League seasons with the Detroit Tigers (2010-14) and Arizona Diamondbacks (2008-09)...Is one of just 10 pitchers in Major League history to take home the Cy Young Award three or more times.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: Faces the Colorado Rockies for the ninth time and fourth time since joining the Nationals in 2015...Is 1-4 with a 4.76 ERA in those eight starts...Has faced them just one time at Nationals Park, Aug. 9, 2015 (6.0 IP, 8 H, 4 ER, 3 HR, BB, 10 SO).

LAST START: Was dominant in his second consecutive start against Atlanta...Tossed a two-hit shutout, striking out 10 with out issuing a walk in the 2-0 win...It was his ninth career complete game (fifth career shutout) and 66th career 10+ strikeout game.

2018 NOTES

- Ranks among National League pitchers in strikeouts (2nd, 27), ERA (3rd, 0.90), strikeout-to-walk ratio (4th, 9.00) and SO/9.0 IP (12.15).
- Has not walked a right-handed batter through three starts (4-for-23, 2B, 2 RBI).
- Opened the season in dominating fashion striking out 10 batters in 6.0 shutout innings in Washington's 2-0 win over the Cincinnati Reds on Opening Day...It was his 65th career 10+ strikeout game...Scherzer's 10 strikeouts tied the most on Opening Day in Expos/Nationals history: **Stephen Strasburg** (3/31/14 at NYM) and **Steve Rogers** (4/9/82 at PHI).

2017 NOTES

- Was named the National League Cy Young Award winner for the second consecutive season...He joined **Roger Clemens** (7), **Randy Johnson** (5), **Steve Carlton** (4), **Greg Maddux** (4), **Sandy Koufax** (3), **Pedro Martinez** (3), **Jim Palmer** (3), **Tom Seaver** (3) and **Clayton Kershaw** (3) as the only pitchers to bring home three Cy Young Awards...Hall of Famers **Gaylord Perry**, **Martinez**, and **Johnson**, as well as **Clemens** and **Roy Halladay** join Scherzer as the only pitchers to win the award in both leagues.
- Was the first pitcher to win his league's Cy Young Award in back-to-back seasons since **Clayton Kershaw** took home the honors in 2013 and 2014.
- Led the National league in strikeouts (268), WHIP (0.90), Opp. AVG (.178), Opp. OPS (.566), Hits per 9.0 IP (5.65), FanGraphs.com WAR (6.0), Baseball-Reference.com WAR (7.2), quality starts (22), and complete games (2).
- With 12.02 SO/9.0 IP for the season, was just the fourth pitcher in MLB history to average as many as 12 SO/9.0 IP over a season of 200-plus innings: **Randy Johnson** did it six times (1995, 1997-2001), **Pedro Martinez** (1999) and **Chris Sale** (2017).

CAREER NOTES

- His 66 games of 10+ strikeouts are 11th-most in MLB history (since 1913) and most among active pitchers...**Tom Seaver** (HOF, 92) is 10th (70).
- Is one of 13 pitchers (2 active, **Kershaw**) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 36 G of at least 10 SO and one earned run or fewer allowed.
- Is one of 12 pitchers (2 active, **Kershaw**) in MLB history (since 1913) with at least 19 G of at least 10 SO and zero earned runs allowed.
- Leads all active starters and ranks second in MLB history with a career 10.2 strikeouts per 9.0 IP (**Randy Johnson** - 10.6).
- Is the only pitcher in MLB with an active streak of six-plus seasons with at least 200 SO...Is one of 25 pitchers in MLB (since 1913) to post at least six seasons of 200+ strikeouts...The only other active pitchers to do so are **Zack Greinke** (6), **Clayton Kershaw** (6), **Felix Hernandez** (6), and **Justin Verlander** (6).
- Since joining the Nationals in 2015, has taken a no-hitter into the sixth inning 11 times in 101 starts (10.8%), according to MASN in-game reporter, Dan Kolko.
