TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants look to secure their third series win this month after evening the series last night with a 5-4, 12-inning victory...SF has not won the final game of a series since they defeated the Rangers by a score of 3-1 on Aug. 26.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Last night was the Giants' 21st extra-inning contest this season, which leads the Majors...the last time the Giants played in 21-or-more extra-inning games in a season was in 2011 (also 21 games)...SF has posted an 11-10 record in extra innings this year.

PITCHERS WHO RAKE: LHP Madison Bumgarner pinch hit in the 12th inning last night and drove in the winning run with a single...he became the first pitcher to record a walk-off hit since MIL's Yovani Gallardo doubled in the winning run on May 27, 2014 vs. BAL...he also became the first Giants pitcher to have a game-ending RBI since RHP Don Robinson hit a walk-off single against Houston on July 31, 1990 (Stats, LLC).

INSIDE THE SERIES: The Giants have posted an 11-7 record against the Padres this season despite being outscored by a 71-69 margin.

ON THE MOUND: RHP Casey Kelly is slated to make his third start this year...he's 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3er, 10.1ip) over two starts with SF this season...he'll be facing RHP Luis Perdomo, who is making his first start since July 27...he is 1-6 with a 7.94 ERA (35er, 39.2ip) in nine starts this season.

RISP MANAGEMENT: San Francisco has just nine hits in their last 52 at-bats (.173) with runners in scoring position...dating back to Sept. 1, the Giants' .172 average with RISP ranks as the lowest figure in the Majors...the Padres have the second-lowest average with RISP during that stretch at .200.

IN THE DIVISION: The Giants are 38-34 against the National League West this season and will play their final four games within the division (San Diego: tonight and Los Angeles-NL: Friday-Sunday)...last season, SF posted a 29-47 record against the West.

SECOND HALF STRUGGLES: San Francisco's .221 batting average since the break is on pace to be the lowest second-half mark in franchise history, and would be the lowest post-All Star average by any team since the 1974 Padres (.212) (Stats, LLC).

HUNTER PENCE: OF Hunter Pence is batting .370 (10-for-27) with five runs scored, a double, two homers and five RBI in his past eight games...Pence is expected to leadoff and play in left or right field in the Giants' final four games.

GIANTS PITCHERS: Beginning June 1, the Giants have posted a 3.45 ERA, which ranks as the third-best figure in the Majors behind Los Angeles-NL (3.28) and Houston (3.40).

CLOSE CALLS: The Giants have played 108 games this season that have been decided by just three runs or fewer, the most such games of any MLB team this year...SF is 52-56 (.481) in such contests.

SCORE AT LEAST FOUR: San Francisco is 21-66 (.241) when scoring three runs or fewer compared to 52-19 (.732) when plating four-or-more runs.

Livan Hernandez tossed a two-hit shutout and Reggie Sanders connected twice for homers as the Giants defeated the Padres by a score of 6-0...Barry Bonds walked in his 16th-straight game to tie Jack Clark's National League record set in 1987.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#68 RHP Casey Kelly
6-3, 215, 28 years old (October 4, 1989)
0-2 Record, 2.04 ERA

- 28-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his third Major League start for the Giants tonight and the 12th of his big league career.
- Has made two starts for SF this season, going 0-1 with a 2.61 ERA (3er, 10.1ip) and a .340 opponents average against...his last start came on Aug. 22 at New York-NL...threw 6.0 innings, allowing four runs (two earned runs) on seven hits with four strikeouts.
- Has made three outings as a reliever this year for the Giants, posting a 0-1 record with a 1.23 ERA (1er, 7.1ip) and a .200 opponents average.
- Is 2-7 with a 5.87 ERA (35er, 53.2ip) in 11 career big league starts (eight starts with San Diego, one with Atlanta and two with San Francisco).
- Is seeking his first MLB win since Sept. 15, 2012 vs. Colorado, as a member of the Padres...since then, he's lost his last nine decisions.
- Was signed by the Giants to a minor league contract July 29, 2017...he then elected free agency on Nov. 6, 2017 and resigned a minor league deal with the Giants this past Feb. 25.
- He pitched all of this season with triple-A Sacramento before having his contract purchased by the Giants on Aug. 10...was optioned back to triple-A on Aug. 23 and made one more start with the River Cats before being recalled by the Giants again on Sept. 3.
- Went 10-9 with a 4.76 ERA (72er, 136.0ip), 111 strikeouts and 19 home runs allowed in 24 starts with the River Cats this season...led Sacramento in innings pitched (136.0), strikeouts (111) and games started (24).
- Pitched 5.0-shutout innings in his Giants debut on Aug. 11 vs. Pittsburgh...only two other pitchers made relief appearances that long in their first game with the club: **Don Larsen** (6.1 innings in 1962) and **John Montefusco** (9.0 innings in 1974).
- Has made two career relief appearances against San Diego, tossing 3.1-scoreless innings.
- Drafted by the Boston Red Sox in the first round (30th overall) of the 2008 MLB draft, the Sarasota, FL native was traded from the Red Sox to the Padres in 2010 in exchange for Adrian Gonzalez in what was a five-player deal.
- Kelly made his big league debut with San Diego in 2012, but underwent Tommy John surgery the following year...he was traded to the Braves after the 2015 season.
- Kelly was also offered a scholarship to play football for the University of Tennessee, as he was a two-time regional player of the year as a quarterback at Sarasota High School.
- His dad, Pat Kelly, is the interim bench coach for the Reds.

NOTES: The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the mound Friday for his 21st and final start of the season...the Giants are 9-11 in his outings this year, going 6-3 at home and 3-8 on the road...last pitched Friday at St. Louis, taking a no-decision in the Giants' 5-3 loss at Busch Stadium...worked 6.0 innings and allowed three runs on eight hits for his 13th quality start of the season...returns home to the confines of AT&T Park where he has not allowed a run in his last 20.0 innings spanning three starts that date to August 7...the last time Bumgarner allowed a run at home was July 27 vs. Milwaukee...the left-hander owns a 1.34 home ERA (9er, 60.1ip), which ranks as the best home ERA in the NL (min. 60.0 home innings pitched) and second-best in the Majors to TB's Blake Snell, who owns a 1.24 home ERA.
