**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The Cardinals improved their home stand mark to a perfect 3-0 last night with their 3rd-consecutive 3-2 win and their 4th consecutive win that has been decided by a single run...the Cardinals began the day in 1st place in the N.L. Central, 1/2-game in front of 2nd place Milwaukee...the Cardinals +28 run differential is 3rd best in the Senior Circuit.

**THE HOME STRETCH:** The Cardinals are in the midst of a 16-game stretch during which they will play 13 at home, interrupted only by their three-game trip to Pittsburgh last weekend...the Cardinals are 8-1 over the first nine home games during this stretch.

**THE WINNING TRIFECTA:** The Cardinals have won three consecutive games by the same 3-2 score for the 1st time since June 13-16, 2015 when they also did so in wins vs Kansas City (1) & Minnesota (2).

**MILES MARKER:** Miles Mikolas extended his string of walk-less innings to 20.0 last night, the longest no free-pass stretch by a Cardinals pitcher since Mike Leake posted a 36.0 inning string from June 30 to Aug. 4, 2016.

**PITCHERS HOME WORK:** The Cardinals pitching staff is leading the majors with their 2.64 ERA (143.0 IP/42 ER) at home in 15 games and they are the only team in the majors to have allowed fewer than 10 HR's at home, having allowed just 7.

**FROM ONE TO 100:** The Cardinals took a 1-0 lead in the 6th inning on Wed. via the first career home run by pitcher Carlos Martínez...Dexter Fowler pushed the lead to 3-0 with his 100th career homer in the 7th inning...Matt Carpenter tied Tue. night's game at 2-2 in the 9th inning with his 100th career homer.

**BOMBIN' BIRDIES:** The Cardinals rank T4th in the N.L. (Colorado, 43; Washington 42 & Atlanta 39) with their 38 home runs...through 30 games, the Cardinals have homered in 22 games and are 16-6 in games when they do homer.

**BETTER AT BUSCH:** After going 44-37 (.543) at home last season and 38-43 (.469) in 2016, the Cardinals are off to a 10-5 (.667) start at Busch this season and have won 8 of their last 9 at home.

**AN APRIL FOR THE AGES:** Carlos Martínez finished the month of April with a 0.54 ERA (33.1 IP/2 ER) the best April ever by a Cardinals pitcher (min. 30 IP) dating to 1913...Jesse Haines had a 1.00 April mark in 1927 (36.0 IP/4 ER).

**MILESTONE MANAGER:** Cardinals Manager Mike Matheny managed his 1,000th regular season game with the Cardinals on Tue., becoming only the 4th Cardinals manager (Tony La Russa, Red Schoendienst, Whitey Herzog) to pilot the club in 1,000 or more regular season games...Matheny is 562-440 (.561 win pct.) at the helm, taking the Cardinals to the postseason in 4 of his 6 seasons.

**TRIPLES TRIVIA:** The Cardinals are the only MLB team without a triple this season...St. Louis' 30-game start to the season without a three-bagger is a franchise high, surpassing their 2015 start of 15 triple-less games...San Francisco went without a triple in a Major League-record first 41 games in 1982.

**BULLISH PEN:** Cardinals relievers have inherited 63 runners this season (1st in the N.L.) and have stranded 49, giving them the league's 2nd best inherited runners pct. (.22.2). The Cardinals 23 Holds rank T2nd in the N.L. behind only Arizona (27).

- Limited opposing right-handers to a .226 (14-for-62) average against.
- Has allowed just five extra-base hits (2 HR, 2 3B, 2B) among his 29 hits allowed.
- Ranks 15th in the NL with his 0.57 HR/9 IP ratio. (2 HR/31.1 IP)

**CAREER**

- Averaging 10.34 K/9 IP over his career 128.0 career Major League innings.
- His 147 career strikeouts are 2nd to Shelby Miller (148) for the highest total all-time among Cardinals through their first 28 career games.
- Won team-leading seven consecutive 2017 starts (8/2-9/20/17), was the 4th-longest in the National League and longest by a MLB rookie in 2017...is the first Cardinals rookie to achieve the feat since Ted Wilks (1944) & Johnny Beazley (1942) (*Elias*).
- Became the fifth rookie pitcher in the last 70 years to allow two runs or fewer over seven consecutive winning starts, joining Fernando Valenzuela (eight straight in 1981), Cal Eldred (1992), Jered Weaver (2006) and Steven Matz (2016) (*Elias*).

**2017**

- Pitched the majority of the second half of the season with St. Louis, pitching in 13 games (10 starts) over three stints. Was the 7th different Cardinals pitcher to make a start behind the original starting five and Marco Gonzales.
- Struck out 72 over 60.1 IP to average 10.74 K/9 IP, the 5th-highest mark among National League starters (min. 60.0 IP), trailing Robbie Ray (12.11), Max Scherzer (12.02), Rich Hill (11.01) and Dinelson Lamet (10.94).
- Was one of five rookie pitchers to sport a pair of double-digit strikeout games (8/23 & 8/29) in 2017: COL's German Marquez, SF's Chris Stratton, PHI's Nick Pivetta & SD's Dinelson Lamet.
