RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals wrap up their six-game, seven-day homestand (CLE: 2-1, ATL: 0-2) with Sunday's matinee against first-place Atlanta, and are looking to avoid a three-game series sweep for only the second time this season (April 27-29 at Pittsburgh)...St. Louis lost its third game in a row with last night's 11-4 defeat, scoring all four runs in the 9th inning...the Cardinals are 4-6 in their last 10 games and 8-12 over their previous 20...St. Louis began the day in 3rd place in the NL Central, 5.5 games back of the first place Brewers.

OUT OF THE NEST: After today's homestand finale, the Cardinals will play 17 of 20 games away from Busch Stadium, beginning with an 11-day, nine-game road trip through Arizona (3), San Francisco (4), and Chicago-AL (2). The Cardinals and Dodgers have played the fewest road games in the Majors this season (37).

WORKIN' FOR THE WEEKEND: The Cardinals sport a combined 23-17 (.575) mark in weekend (Friday-Sunday games), including a 10-6 record at Busch Stadium, as opposed to their 19-23 (.452) tally during the work week.

HAPPY FLIGHT?: Six of St. Louis' nine Sunday victories have come at home... Sunday (9-4) is the Cardinals most successful day of the week.

WRAPPING UP JUNE: The Cardinals finished June with a 12-15 record, marking their first losing month since June of 2017 (13-16)...offensively, their 37 home runs ranked T2nd in the NL and were 2nd-most in franchise history for June (2017, 42). Among NL June leaders, **Marcell Ozuna** ranked T3rd in hits (34), T7th in average (.333), T12th in home runs (7), T7th in RBI (21), 8th in total bases (59), and T2nd in go-ahead RBI (7); **Matt Carpenter** ranked 2nd in runs scored (24), T11th in doubles (8), T6th in home runs (8), and 8th in slugging (.636); **José Martínez** ranked T6th in home runs (8), 7th in slugging (.640), and T7th in RBI (21). Cardinals pitchers struck out 236 batters (4th in NL), establishing a franchise record for June (2017, 233). **Jack Flaherty** finished T5th in the NL in strikeouts (37) and 6th in average against (.194), while **Miles Mikolas** ranked 4th in innings (37.0) and 9th in WHIP (1.00). **Austin Gomber's** 14 games were T2nd in NL, while his 7 holds ranked 2nd among MLB rookies and 2nd in the NL. **Mike Mayers** inherited 11 runners (T4th NL) and stranded 81.8% (10th NL).

FAN-TASTIC: All 17 June home crowds were above 40,000 fans, while six of the team's 10 sellouts in 2018 came in the month of June. The team drew a total of 741,155 fans last month, for an average per home date of 43,597.

UP AND AT 'EM: Today is St. Louis' 35th day game this season (T2nd NL) and the first at home since June 7...the Cardinals' 20 wins in matinees rank 2nd in the NL behind Chicago (Atlanta is 3rd with 18)...St. Louis is 10-5 in home games at Busch Stadium this season.

BIRD BYTES: Happy 27th birthday to pitcher **Michael Wacha**...the Cardinals are 42-39 at the halfway point this season and were 39-42 last season...**Marcell Ozuna** has 14 career multiple-RBI efforts against Atlanta since 2013, 2nd-most behind **Daniel Murphy** (15)...**Yairo Munoz** is batting .274 (20-73) with two strikes, 2nd-highest in the NL and 1st among MLB rookies...St. Louis ranks 3rd in the NL in both inherited runners (140) and percentage of runners stranded (73.6)...the Cardinals are in the midst of playing 19 straight games against opponents with winning records, and are 17-19 overall this season when doing so.

ATLANTA CONNECTIONS

Pitcher **Adam Wainwright** was born in Brunswick, Ga. and resides in St. Simon's Island, Ga...attended Glynn Academy in Brunswick...selected by Atlanta in the first round (29th overall) of the 2000 MLB draft...acquired by St. Louis from Braves with pitchers **Jason Marquis** and **Ray King** for outfielder **J.D. Drew** and catcher **Eli Marrero** (Dec. 13, 2003).

Outfielder **Dexter Fowler** was born in Atlanta, Ga...graduated from Milton (Ga.) High School.

Catcher **Francisco Pena's** brother, **Tony**, appeared in 46 games with Atlanta during his MLB debut season in 2006.

First baseman **José Martínez** played parts of two minor league seasons (2013-14) in the Braves organization, sandwiched around 28 games with the independent Rockford Aviators at the beginning of the 2014 season.

First baseman **José Martínez** and outfielder **Ronald Acuña Jr.** were both born in La Guaira, Venezuela and are third cousins.

Pitcher **Bud Norris** pitched 22 games (10 starts) for Atlanta in 2016 before traded to the Dodgers along with outfielder **Dian Toscano**, pitcher **Alec Grosser** and cash for pitchers **Caleb Dirks** and **Phil Pfeifer** (June 30, 2016).

Pitcher **Jack Flaherty** was high school teammates with Braves pitcher **Max Fried** and White Sox pitcher **Lucas Giolito** while at Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, Calif.

Pitcher **John Gant** pitched in 20 games (seven starts) for Atlanta in 2016, where he made his MLB debut...became a Cardinal via trade with the Braves, packaged with pitcher **Chris Ellis** and infielder **Luke Dykstra** for pitcher **Jaime Garcia** (Dec. 1, 2016).

Mike Maddux's brother, **Greg**, was a Hall of Fame pitcher for Atlanta for 11 seasons (1993-2003), winning three Cy Young and 10 Gold Gloves Awards, named to six NL All-Star Games, and a member of the 1995 World Series team.

Ron Washington (manager) and **Mike Maddux** (pitching) were on the Texas Rangers coaching staff that faced St. Louis in the 2011 World Series.

Manager **Mike Matheny** and Hitting Coach **Kevin Seitzer** were Braves teammates for parts of three seasons (1994-96)...Seitzer grew up in Lincoln, Ill...attended Eastern Illinois Univ. in Charleston.

Manager **Brian Snitker** was born in nearby Decatur, Ill...graduated from Macon (Ill.) High School.

Pitcher **Sam Freeman** was drafted by the Cardinals in the 32nd round in 2008...made his MLB debut and pitched in 81 games over three years for St. Louis (2012-14), including the 2014 NLDS.

Pitcher **Dan Winker** is born in Effingham, Ill...graduated from St. Anthony High School in Effingham.

Former Cardinals coach **Chris Maloney** (2012-17) is currently the Mississippi Braves (AA) manager in the Braves organization.

Braves Senior Director of Media Relations **Brad Hainje** worked six seasons (1998-2003) as a member of the Cardinals Media Relations Department.

Braves Senior Coordinator, Media Relations **Jonathan Kerber** began his pro career with the Rookie Level New Jersey Cardinals (2004).

Cardinals Broadcaster **Rick Ankiel** played in 47 games for the Braves in 2007...traded by Kansas City with pitcher **Kyle Farnsworth** to the Braves for outfielder **Gregor Blanco** and pitchers **Jesse Chavez** and **Tim Collins** (July 31, 2010).

Cardinals broadcaster **Al Hrabosky** pitched his final three seasons with Atlanta (1980-82).

Braves broadcaster **Chip Caray** was born in St. Louis in 1965...graduated from Parkway West High School in 1983...briefly broadcast Cardinals games in the early 1990s...his father, **Skip Caray**, was born in St. Louis in 1939...graduated from Webster Groves High School and the University of Missouri...previously broadcast for the Tulsa Oilers (AA-Cardinals), and basketball for Saint Louis University and St. Louis Hawks...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, was born in St. Louis in 1914 and graduated from Webster Groves High School...was a Cardinals broadcaster for 25 years (1945-1969).

Braves broadcaster **Brian Jordan** was selected by the Cardinals in the first round (30th overall) of the 1988 MLB Draft...played first seven professional seasons in St. Louis.
