#### WHITE SOX AT A GLANCE

- The Chicago White Sox have lost four of the last six games and 13 of the last 19 as they continue a season-long, 10-game trip tonight with the series finale at Cincinnati.
- RHP Dylan Covey is scheduled to start for the White Sox, who are 6-5 over their last 11 contests.
- The Sox have split the first two games of this series at the Reds after opening the trip by losing two of three at Texas.
- Following tonight's series finale at Great American Ball Park, the White Sox will conclude the trip with four games at Houston before ending the first half with a five-game, six-day homestand vs. St. Louis (7/10-11) and Kansas City (7/13-15).
- The Sox went 4-3 on their last homestand vs. Oakland (2-2) and Minnesota (2-1) and 0-3 on their last trip to Cleveland.

#### TONIGHT'S STORYLINES

- Chicago is looking to win its first road series since 6/8-10 at Boston, and win consecutive road games for the first time since 6/5-2-6 at Minnesota ... the club is 2-6 in its last eight road games.
- The White Sox have hit 15 home runs in the last 11 games after hitting just six in the previous 16 contests.
- The Sox are 15-64 (.234) with RISP and have left 51 runners on base over the last six games.
- Dylan Covey is 0-2 with a 12.71 ERA (16 ER/11.1 IP), 2.47 WHIP and .333 opp. average over his last three starts after going 3-0 with a 1.53 mark (5 ER/29.1 IP) in his previous five outings.
- Avisail García owns a career-high, 13-game hitting streak (since 4/22), hitting .379 (22-58) with two doubles, two triples, six home runs, 10 RBI, a 1.183 OPS and six multihit efforts ... he has hit five home runs over his last eight games.
- José Abreu is batting .380/.398/.734 (30-79) with eight doubles, one triple, six home runs, 15 RBI and nine multihit efforts over his last 21 interleague games since 2017.

#### LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

- Yoán Moncada hit a game-winning, bases-clearing triple in the 12th inning to cap Chicago's comeback in its 12-8 victory.
- The White Sox overcame deficits of 4-0 after the first, 7-2 after the fifth and 8-7 after the eighth, marking their first win of the season when trailing after eight (1-52 record).
- Avisail García forced extras with a game-tying, solo homer in the ninth, his second of the game (seventh career multihomer effort) ... Daniel Palka recorded his first career multihomer game.
- Lucas Giolito received a ND despite allowing seven runs on eight hits, including three homers, in 5.0 IP ... Sox relievers combined to allowed just one run on two hits over 7.0 IP.
- Moncada and García both recorded three-hit efforts ... seven of the Sox eight position starters registered a hit, including five-multihit efforts, in the club's 15-hit, four-homer performance.

#### HOME RUN DERBY

- Avisail García and Daniel Palka both recorded multihomer efforts last night, the first time in club history the White Sox 3-4 hitters both hit multiple home runs in a game (STATS LLC).
- García (414 and 431 feet) and Palka's (428 and 448 feet) four homers traveled an estimated 1,721 combined feet according to MLB Statcast ... Palka is tied for eighth in MLB with an average distance of 419 feet per home run this season.

#### INDEPENDENCE DAY INFO

- The White Sox have won seven of their last eight games on the Fourth July, including seven straight from 2010-16 ... their winning streak was snapped last year in a 7-6 loss at Oakland.
- The Sox are playing consecutive road games on the holiday for the first time since 2009 (Kansas City) and 2010 (Texas).
- The White Sox are playing an interleague game on Independence Day for the first time since 2004, a 2-1 loss at the Cubs.
- Chicago is 100-78 (.562) all-time on July 4, the sixth-best mark in MLB ... Washington ranks first at 35-20 (.636).

#### HE'S ON FIRE ... AVI-OUSLY

- Avisail García is currently on a 13-game hitting streak, the longest of his career, longest active and tied for the seventh-longest in MLB this season ... it is the longest streak by a White Sox in a season since Tim Anderson from 9/9-24/17 (15 games).
- He is 14-30 (.467) with two doubles, two triples, four homers and six RBI in his last six games, and 19-52 (.348) with six home runs and nine RBI in 12 games since returning from the DL.

#### TRIPLE THE FUN

- The White Sox rank second in the major leagues this season with 25 triples (Arizona is first with 31) ... the Sox led the AL with 37 triples last season, their most since 1999 (also 37).
- Yolmer Sánchez leads MLB with nine triples in 2018 after ranking sixth last season with eight.

#### WHITE SOX VS. CINCINNATI REDS

- The White Sox and Reds are meeting for the first time since 2015, and first at Great American Ball Park since 2009.
- Chicago has won five of the last seven games and 14 of the last 17 ... it won nine straight from 6/5/00-6/18/06.
- The Sox won two of three in 2015 in Chicago, and earned a series victory in the last matchup in Cincinnati in 2009.
- Chicago leads the all-time series, 17-5, going 6-2 at Guaranteed Rate Field and 11-3 in Cincinnati (6-2 at GABP).

#### WINDY AND QUEEN CITY CONNECTIONS

- White Sox OF Adam Engel (1991) and first-base coach Daryl Boston (1963) were both born in Cincinnati.
- Buddy Bell, the Reds' Vice President/Senior Advisor to the GM, previously served as the White Sox Vice President/Assistant GM.
- Reds pitching coach Danny Darwin pitched for the Sox in 1997.
- Chicago and Cincinnati played in the first ever Civil Rights Game during the regular season on 6/20/09 at Great American Ball Park ... the White Sox earned a 10-8 win.

#### INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT

- The White Sox are 4-10 during interleague play, winning four of the last eight games after losing each of the first six contests ... they have been held to two runs or less six times this season.
- Chicago has lost 10 of the last 12 games and 18 of 22 IL games on the road ... the club has not won consecutive road IL games since 8/12-13/16 at Miami (also last road IL series victory).
- The Sox went 6-14 during IL play last season and have not recorded a winning record since 2014 (11-9).
- The Sox are 210-187 all-time during IL play (since 1997).

#### BARRELING BACKSTOPS

- Omar Narváez and Kevan Smith are hitting a combined .358 (43-120) with six doubles, one home run, 14 RBI and 13 multihit efforts in 32 games since 6/1 ... they have hit safely in 28 contests.
- Narváez (1st, .392) and Smith (2nd, .333) lead all American League catchers in average since 6/1 (minimum 55 PAs) ... they also rank first and third in MLB (Kurt Suzuki is second at .350).
- Narváez owns seven multihit efforts and has hit safely in 13 games since 6/1 ... Smith has hit safely in 16 of his 17 games in 2018 since being recalled from Class AAA Charlotte on 6/5.

#### BULLPEN BREAKDOWN

- The Sox bullpen has allowed a run in seven straight games, recording a 5.79 ERA (18 ER/28.0 IP) and .224 opp. average.
- Joakim Soria has made 15 straight scoreless appearances (15.1 IP), converting all eight save chances with just seven hits allowed, two walks and 18 strikeouts.
- Rookie Jace Fry owns a 2.63 ERA (8 ER/27.1 IP) with 33 strikeouts and a .146 (14-96) opp. average in 27 games in 2018.
- Xavier Cedeño has allowed just one earned run over 13 relief appearances (15 SO/10.2 IP) since joining the White Sox on 6/7.

#### 30/30 THREAT

- Tim Anderson (13 HR/18 SB) is one of six players in MLB this season with at least 13 homers and 13 steals, joining Javier Báez, Andrew Benintendi, Mookie Betts, José Ramírez and Mike Trout.
- Anderson is on pace for career highs with 25 homers and 34 steals ... the 25 homers would tie José Valentín (2002) for the fourth-highest total by a Sox shortstop, and the 34 steals would be the most since Ozzie Guillén in 1989 (36).

#### STOP! THIEF!

- The Sox lead MLB with 67 stolen bases in 2018 ... the Sox are on pace to steal 128 bases, which would be their most since 2010 (160) ... they have not led MLB in steals since 1966 (153).
- Tim Anderson ranks second in the AL with 18 steals in 2018.

#### PITO STILL FIRST AT FIRST

- José Abreu continues to lead American League first basemen in fan balloting for the MLB All-Star Game ... All-Star starters and reserves will be announced on Sunday, 7/8 on the ASG Selection Show presented by Camping World starting at 6:00 p.m. CT.
- Abreu is the first White Sox to lead at any point in the balloting process since Frank Thomas won the fan election at 1B in 1996.
- He would be the sixth Sox player (11th time) to be fan-elected as a starter, joining Thomas (1994-96), Carlton Fisk (1981-82), Richie Zisk (1977), Dick Allen (1972-74) and Luis Aparicio (1970).

#### ON DECK: AT HOUSTON ASTROS

- Houston leads the season series, 3-0, after recording a sweep from 4/20-22 in Chicago (outscored the Sox, 27-2).
- The Sox have lost five of the last six games but are 6-5 in the last 11 and 12-9 in the last 21 ... Chicago is 6-5 in the last 11 games at Minute Maid Park ... the White Sox went 4-2 in 2017.

### COVEY AT A GLANCE

- The 26-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season, sixth on the road and first career appearance against Cincinnati.
- Is 0-2 with a 12.71 ERA (16 ER/ 11.1 IP), three strikeouts, 12 walks and a .333 (16-48) opponents average over his last three starts ... went 3-0 with a 1.53 ERA (5 ER/29.1 IP), 30 strikeouts, eight walks and a .246 (28-114) opponents average in his previous five starts.
- Was selected by the White Sox from the Athletics in the major-league portion of the Rule 5 Draft on 12/8/16 ... entered the 2017 season with zero major-league experience.
- Has gone 20-26 with a 4.06 ERA (181 ER/401.1 IP) and 288 strikeouts over 81 appearances (78 starts) over five minor-league seasons in the Athletics (2013-16) and White Sox (2017-18) organizations.
- Attended the University of San Diego from 2010-13 ... was teammates with Chicago Cubs third baseman and 2016 National League Most Valuable Player Kris Bryant.
- Was originally selected by Oakland in the fourth round of the June 2013 First-Year Player Draft.
- Bio is on page 63 of the 2018 Chicago White Sox media guide.

### LAST START

- Suffered his second straight loss and third of the season on 6/29 at Texas after allowing a career-high nine runs (eight earned) on eight hits and three walks over 2.1 IP ... the 2.1 IP tied a career low as a starter (also on 5/23/17 at Arizona).
- Allowed a career-high four home runs to Rougned Odor (solo in the second), Robinson Chirinos (three-run in the second), Nomar Mazara (three-run in the second) and Joey Gallo (solo in the third).
- Departed with the White Sox trailing, 8-0, in the third inning ... tossed 74 pitches (43 strikes) ... Chicago went on to lose, 11-3.

### LIFE ON THE ROAD

- Is 1-2 with an 8.10 ERA (12 ER/13.1 IP), five home runs allowed, nine walks, nine strikeouts and a .309 (17-55) opponents average over his last three road starts.
- Has gone 1-9 with an 8.58 ERA (62 ER/65.0 IP) and .332 (89-306) opponents average over 15 career road appearances (13 starts), compared to 2-1 with a 4.01 ERA (23 ER/51.2 IP) and .237 (45-214) opponents average in 12 outings (eight starts) at home.

### WHERE'S THE RUN SUPPORT?

- Received one run or less of support in four of his last six starts, after receiving 17 runs of support in his first three starts of the season.
- Has received one or no runs of support in 10 of his 21 career starts ... his career run support breakdown: zero (three), one (seven), two (five), three (two) and four-plus (four).

### 2018 MINOR LEAGUE STARTS

- Went 3-1 with a 2.33 ERA (10 ER/38.2 IP), 36 strikeouts and a .226 (32-141) opponents average over seven starts with Class AAA Charlotte this season.
- Did not receive a decision in his last start with Charlotte on 5/15, allowing one unearned run on four hits with one walk and six strikeouts over 6.0 IP.

### LOOKING BACK AT 2017

- Made his major-league debut on 4/14/17 at Minnesota ... did not receive the decision after allowing one run on five hits with three walks and one strikeout over 5.1 IP.
- Went 0-7 with a 7.71 ERA (60 ER/70.0 IP) in 12 starts with the Sox ... the last Sox pitcher to begin his MLB career winless over seven or more starts was Ramon García from 5/31/91-7/6/91 (eight straight starts) ... source: STATS LLC.
- Was on the 10-day disabled list from 5/26-8/15/17 (retroactive to 5/24) with a strained left oblique.
- Made two appearances with Class AAA Charlotte, going 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA (2 ER/6.0 IP), one walk and three strikeouts ... opponents batted .227 (5-22) with one home run.

### COVEY'S COVER STORY

- Originally was selected by Milwaukee in the first round (14th overall) of the June 2010 First-Year Player Draft ... following his post-draft physical and before signing a contract, was diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes.
- Following the diagnosis, elected not to sign with the Brewers and committed to play at the University of San Diego ... was teammates with Chicago Cubs third baseman and 2016 National League Most Valuable Player Kris Bryant.
- Pitched for the Toreros from 2010-13 before being drafted by Oakland in the fourth round in 2013.
- Former White Sox and current Boston Red Sox left-hander Chris Sale was selected one spot ahead of Covey with the 13th overall pick in the 2010 draft.

### VS. INTERLEAGUE OPPONENTS

- Is scheduled to make his fifth career appearance (fourth start) against during interleague play.
- Has gone 0-1 with a 4.97 ERA (7 ER/12.2 IP), four home runs allowed, six walks, 17 strikeouts and a .288 (15-52) opponents average lifetime ... is 0-1 with a strikeout as a hitter in his career.

### VS. CINCINNATI REDS

- Is scheduled to make his first career appearance against Cincinnati.

### TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER

- LHP Carlos Rodón (1-3, 4.55) is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season, fourth on the road and fifth career against Houston.
- Suffered the loss in his last start on 6/30 at Texas ... allowed five runs on six hits and two walks with three strikeouts over 5.1 IP.
- Is 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA (5 ER/26.1 IP) and .262 (27-103) opponents average over four career starts against the Astros.
- Will make his 20th career start against an American League West opponent ... is 7-4 with a 3.32 ERA (43 ER/116.2 IP) and .242 (107-443) opponents average lifetime.
