STREAKING

The Reds' **6-game winning streak** is the **longest active streak** in the Major Leagues and the team's longest since a **6-game streak** from **5/10-5/16, 2013**...haven't won more than **6 straight games** since a **10-game winning streak** from **7/19-7/29, 2012**...during this active streak are hitting **.272** (58-213) with **29 runs scored** (4.83 r/g) and a **1.64 ERA** (55ip, 10er), including a **2.27 ERA** by **Reds starters** (31.2ip, 8er) and a **0.77 ERA** by **relievers** (23.1ip, 2er).

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is **Game 1** of a 3-game series vs **Devon Bridges' Giants** and **Game 5** (4-0) of a 7-game West Coast road trip that included the Reds' **first series win** vs LAD since **September 2013**, their **first series win at Dodger Stadium** since **June 2011** and their **first 4-game sweep** of the Dodgers since **August 1976**...following this series and an off day, on **Friday** the Redlegs return to **Great American Ball Park** for **7 games** vs the **Cubs** (4g) and **Pirates** (3g), including a **day/night doubleheader** on **Saturday**.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK: **Scotter Gennett** has been named National League **Player of the Week** for the second time in his career...he is the second Reds player this season to receive the award (**Joey Votto**, 4/23-4/29)...in 5 apps last week **Gennett** hit **.591** (13-22, 2 2b, 4hr, 10rbi), including a streak in which he homered in 4 consecutive games for the first time in his career...he led National League batters in **hits**, **hitting and slugging percentage** (1.227), tied for the NL lead in **HR** and **total bases** (27), ranked second in **on-base percentage** (.591), T3rd in **runs scored** (7) and **extra-base hits** (6) and fourth in **RBI**...since RBI became a statistic in 1920, he became the sixth player in franchise history to produce at least 1 HR and 4 RBI in 4 consecutive games, joining **Devin Mesoraco** (6/20-6/24, 2014), **Jay Bruce** (9/2-9/5, 2012), **Eric Davis** (9/3-9/6, 1984), **Frank Robinson** (7/22-7/24, 1961) and **Ted Kluszewski** (7/4-7/7, 1956)...**Gennett** received his first **Player of the Week** award following his 4-homer game on **6/6/17 vs StL**.

TRANSACTIONS: Earlier today the Redlegs sent to Class AA Pensacola on rehabilitation assignments **RHP Michael Lorenzen** (right shoulder strain) and **RHP Anthony DeSclafani** (left oblique strain)...**DeSclafani** was scheduled to start tonight for the **Blue Wahoos** at **Biloxi** (4ip, 60-65 pitches), while **Lorenzen** was scheduled to throw 1.0 inning (20 pitches) in relief...both have been on the Reds' disabled list all season.

SERIES NOTES: The Reds won the first 4 games of the 2017 season series vs the Giants but lost the last 3 games...the **31 runs scored** in the Reds' 13-3, 14-2 and 4-0 wins from **5/5-5/7** of last season at **Great American Ball Park**

was their highest total for any **3-game series** since they scored **32 runs** from **8/19-8/21 vs Ari, 2005**...beginning with the **2008 season** the Reds are **40-27 vs SF** (.597), the best winning percentage of any Giants opponent since then (minimum 50 games) and including **29-19** (.604) over the **last 7 seasons**...**Reds vs Giants** information is on media guide **Page 330**.

WE LEAVE OUR HEARTS...: Beginning **6/29/12**, including that 2012 season's **National League Division Series**, the Redlegs have won **15** of the last **23** meetings at SF's **AT&T Park**...the Giants' 17-inning, 3-2 win here on **5/12/2016** was the Reds' longest game by inning since a **19-inning**, 5-4 loss on **5/25/2011 at Phi** and the second-longest game in the history of **AT&T Park** (**5/29/2001**, 1-0 Giants loss vs Diamondbacks in 18 innings)...from **6/26-6/29, 2014**, the Reds outscored the Giants, **20-6**, in the first **4-game series sweep** ever by an opponent at **AT&T Park**.

APRIL 19: The Reds are **11-12** since **4/19**, when they replaced manager **Bryan Price** and pitching coach **Mack Jenkins**...bench coach **Jim Riggleman** became interim manager, Class AAA Louisville manager **Pat Kelly** (#60) was promoted to serve as interim bench coach, and Class AA Pensacola pitching coach **Danny Darwin** (#52) joined the Reds' Major League staff as interim pitching coach...later in the year, the team will conduct a thorough managerial search for a permanent replacement...**Price** went **279-387** (.419) in his 5 seasons as manager, including **3-15 this year**.

7-YEAR ITCH: The **10-4 Reds victory** on **4/23 vs Atl** was the first for **Jim Riggleman** as his team's full-time manager since a **1-0 Nationals win** vs the **Mariners** on **6/23/11**...since 1900, he is **1 of 14 managers** to work for at least **5 Major League teams** (SD, Chc, Sea, Wsh, Cin)...**Jimmy Dykes**, **John McNamara** and **Dick Williams** each managed **6 teams**...the others who managed **5 teams** are **Chuck Dressen**, **Bucky Harris**, **Rogers Hornsby**, **Davey Johnson**, **Billy Martin**, **Bill McKechnie**, **Jack McKeon**, **Lou Piniella**, **Jeff Torborg** and **Joe Torre**.

FRONT OFFICE NEWS: Reds President of Baseball Operations **Dick Williams** on last week announced the promotion of **Nick Krall** to General Manager...**Krall** had been the club's Vice President, Assistant General Manager since November 2015...**Williams** will remain the club's President of Baseball Operations and will continue to oversee the organization's entire baseball operations department.

RISPY BUSINESS: With a minimum of 45 plate apps with runners in scoring position, **Joey Votto** ranks third in the **Major Leagues** and second in the **National League** in **hitting with RISP** at **.405** (15-37)...he leads all **Major League** batters in **on-base percentage with RISP** (.540).

IN A PINCH: In his **last 5 pinch-hit apps**, **Jesse Winker** walked, singled (RBI), doubled, singled and singled...he is the first Reds batter to **reach base safely** in **5 consecutive pinch-hit apps** since **Todd Frazier** did it from **4/20-5/2, 2012** and the first Reds batter to **produce a hit** in **4 straight pinch-hit apps** since **Brayan Pena** from **7/8-8/9, 2014**...**Fred Lewis** was the last Reds batter to **reach base safely** in **6 consecutive pinch-hit apps** (**6/13-7/2, 2011**)...**Rick Auerbach** was the last Reds batter with **hits** in **5 straight pinch-hit apps** (**8/14-9/13, 1978**)...courtesy Elias Sports Bureau.

HOME COOKIN': In the 9-game homestand completed Wednesday, **Eugenio Suárez** became the first Reds batter to produce **15 RBI** in a homestand since **Jay Bruce** had **15 RBI** in 7 games from **8/8-8/14, 2011**...in his 9 apps vs the **Brewers**, **Marlins** and **Mets** at **Great American Ball Park**, **Suarez** hit **.313** (10-32, 3 2b, 3hr, .688slg, .395obp)...courtesy Elias.

25 IN 20: With a team-high **25 RBI** in his **first 20 apps**, **Eugenio Suárez** tied the franchise record for **most RBI** by a player in his **first 20 games** of a season...he played in his **20th game** on **Tue vs NYM** and produced **4 RBI** to give him **25** on the season...**George Crowe** (1958), **Vada Pinson** (1962) and **Ken Griffey Jr.** (2006) each produced **25 RBI** in his **first 20 games** of those respective seasons...courtesy Elias.

RED HOTS

Sal Romano at just **24 years old** is in his **second Major League season**...tonight is making his ninth start of the season and his **25th Major League** appearance and start...will be his **first career appearance** vs the **Giants**...lowered his season ERA following each of his last 5 apps...in 2017, in his Major League debut made 16 starts during 3 stints with the Reds...made spot starts in April and in early July before joining the rotation for good after the All-Star break...during the second half led Reds pitchers in innings (79.0) while tying Homer Bailey for the staff lead in starts (14)...in his last 8 starts of the season for the Reds went 3-3, 3.17 with 4 quality starts...overall after the All-Star break went 4-7, 4.44 in his 14 starts...the Reds went 7-9 in his 16 starts.

Tomorrow's Pitcher - #30 Tyler Mahle, RHP

RED HOTS

Tyler Mahle's last name rhymes with **RALLY**...at just **23 years old** is in his **second Major League season**...tomorrow night will make his ninth start of the season, the 13th appearance and start of his **career**...will be his first career appearance vs the **Giants**...leads the Major Leagues in strikeouts among all pitchers **age 23 and younger**...his career-high **11 strikeouts** on **4/24 vs Atl** are the most by a Reds pitcher this season...leads the staff with **4 quality starts**...in the 12-inning, 9-7 win on **4/24 vs Atl**, took a 5-0 lead and a no-hitter into the seventh before **Freddie Freeman** led off the inning with a solo HR...was the victim of a **blown save** when the Braves tied it at 7-7 with 4 runs in the ninth inning off **Amir Garrett** and **Raisel Iglesias**, including a second HR by **Freeman**, but the Reds won it on **Scouter Gennett's** 2-run, walkoff HR off **Max Fried**...pitched into the seventh inning for the first time in his career, then recorded 1 out in the seventh of his next start (4/29 at Min)...his third-inning single in the 5-0 loss on **4/8 at Pit** was the only Reds hit in **Jameson Taillon's** first career complete game...was the first **Reds pitcher** to record the team's only hit in a game hit since **Earl Yingling** did it on **9/19/1914 at Brooklyn Robins**...was 1 of 5 rookies on the **Opening Day roster** (**RHP Jackson Stephens**, **RHP Zack Weiss**, **OF Phillip Ervin**, **OF Jesse Winker**) and the only rookie to begin this season in the Reds' starting rotation...when he earned the 1-0 win in his season debut on 4/2 vs Cubs, at **23 years**, **185 days** was the youngest pitcher in the Major Leagues with a victory.

Matt Harvey on Wed will make his second appearance for the Reds...will make his **fourth career** appearance and start vs the **Giants**, his first since **June 2015**, and his **third career** appearance at **AT&T Park**...in his Reds debut, Fri's 6-2 win at LAD, left with a 5-0 lead after allowing just 1 hit on a routine fly ball that dropped between **CF Billy Hamilton** and **RF Scott Schebler**, both of whom lost the ball in the lights...began the season with the **Mets** and went **0-2, 7.00** in **4 starts** and **4 relief apps** before he was **designated for assignment** on **5/5**...on **5/8** was acquired by the Reds in exchange for **C Devin Mesoraco** and **cash**...from **2012-2018** for the **Mets** went **34-37, 3.66** in **104 starts** and **5 relief apps**.

- Has a 6-game hitting streak, tying his season high and raising his batting average 46 points from .283 to .329 (14-26, .538, 3 2b, 4hr, 10rbi, 1.115slg, .556obp)...is the longest active hitting streak on the team and includes a 2-hit game, two 3-hit games and a 4-hit game.
- Hit safely in 12 of his last 13 starts (25-57, .439, 5 2b, 6hr, 17rbi).
- Played in 39 of the Reds' 41 games, off only on 5/9 vs NYM and Sun at LA...from 4/30-5/4 missed 4 starts with inflammation in his right shoulder but pinch hit in each game.
- In the 12-inning, 9-7 win on 4/24 vs Atl produced his third career 2-homer game (off Brandon McCarthy, Max Fried), his first career walkoff HR (2-run off Fried) and a successful suicide squeeze bunt...became the first Major League player to produce in a game a sac bunt and 2 HR, including a walkoff, since LAD's Hee-Seop Choi on 6/20/05 vs Min and the first Reds batter to do it since Reggie Sanders on 5/31/94 vs Montreal.
- Was born in Cincinnati and lived in nearby Lebanon until he was 9 years old, when his family moved to Sarasota.

6 BILLY HAMILTON, cf Road Trip: 4g, 3gs, 4-12, 1 3b, 1rbi, 3sb

- Hit safely in 9 of his last 12 apps, raising his batting average from .169 (12-38, .316, 2 2b, 1 3b, 1hr, 3rbi, 3sb, .395obp).
- Has made 9 starts batting leadoff, a team-high 23 starts batting ninth and 2 starts batting eighth...has made 13 straight starts batting ninth since he led off on 4/26 vs Atl.

- Hit safely in 6 of his last 7 apps (10-29, .345, 2 2b, 2hr, 8rbi).
- From 4/9-4/25 was disabled with a fractured right thumb...suffered the injury on 4/8 at Pit, when in the fourth inning he was hit by a Jameson Taillon pitch...missed 16 games (3-13).
- In the 14-3 loss on 4/6 vs Pit started at 3B but moved to SS in the eighth inning...was his only game at SS since 8/20/17, when he made his only appearance of last season at that position...in his career has made 181 apps and 167 starts at SS.
- On 3/16 signed a 7-year contract extension through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025...following last season was eligible for arbitration for the first time while under team control through 2020.

- Has a 5-game hitting streak, 1 shy of his season high (7-19, .368, 1hr, 4rbi, 4bb, 4r, 1sb, .526slg, .478obp).
