**TODAY'S GAME:** The Giants and Nationals play the rubber game of this three-game series today...the Giants have won seven of their last nine games while the Nationals have won 10 of their last 14.

**GOING FOR THE SERIES WIN:** A win today and the Giants would secure their first series victory over Washington here at Nationals Park since taking two of three games from July 9-11, 2010...since then, the Giants have lost each of their last seven series here, going 6-18.

**TOUGH ASSIGNMENT:** The Giants face one of the best pitchers in baseball today in RHP Max Scherzer, who enters today's outing leading the Majors in wins (10) and ranking second in WHIP (0.83) and third in ERA (1.95)...he hasn't lost since April 4 and his nine-game winning streak matches the longest of his career...Scherzer is 4-4 with a 4.03 ERA in nine starts versus the Giants.

**AGAINST MAX:** Current Giants are hitting a combined .200 (26-for-130) against Max Scherzer, including **OF Andrew McCutchen's** 4-for-24 (.160) and **IF Evan Longoria's** 2-for-16 (.125)...**IF Pablo Sandoval** is 6-for-17 (.353) off the Nationals' ace, including two homers and four RBI.

**ON DECK:** Following today's game the Giants will head to Miami where they'll face the Marlins for a four-game series beginning tomorrow...the Giants went 1-5 against Miami last season and have lost 12 of their last 19 to the Fish since 2015.

**BIRTHDAY WISHES:** Happy Birthday to Giants beat writer **Kerry Crowley**.

**IN THE BULLPEN:** Giants relievers are sporting a 1.25 ERA (5er, 36.0ip) during a 7-2 run...during this stretch **RHP Sam Dyson**, **RHP Hunter Strickland**, **LHP Tony Watson** and **LHP Will Smith** have combined for zero earned runs in 17.0 innings while allowing eight hits and recording 21 strikeouts.

**SCORE AT LEAST FOUR:** The Giants are 29-7 (.806) this season when they score four-or-more runs in a game...over their last 36 games, the Giants are 18-4 when scoring four-or-more runs compared to 1-14 otherwise...SF is 22-4 (.846) when scoring at least five runs a game.

**ROAD WOES:** San Francisco is just 13-21 (.382) on the road this season, the third-lowest winning percentage in the NL...the Giants have lost each of their last five road series and will be seeking their first road series win since sweeping the Braves in Atlanta from May 4-6.

**WITH THE BATS:** San Francisco enters today leading the Majors in team batting average (.265) and ranking second in hits (589, 9.2 per game)...SF's .422 slugging percentage ranks third in the NL while their .325 on-base percentage is fourth...the Giants are averaging 4.27 runs per game, which is ninth in the NL.

**ON THE MOUND:** Giants starting pitchers have totaled just 22 quality starts this season, tied for the sixth-fewest in the Majors...SF is 14-8 (.636) when receiving a quality start and 18-24 (.429) when they don't get a quality outing.

**CRAWFORD SINCE MAY 1:** Beginning May 1, Crawford has hit safely in all but five of his last 35 games, batting a MLB-best .422 (54-for-128) with 14 doubles, five homers and 25 RBI...he's raised his batting average by 137 points from .189 to his current .326 mark, which ranks as the fifth-best in the National League.

**Bud Black** allowed two unearned runs on three hits over 8.0 innings to help the Giants defeat the Reds 6-2...**Will Clark** went 4-for-4 with a homer and two doubles and **Robby Thompson** drove in three while also going yard.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER**

**#45 LHP Derek Holland**  
**6-2, 215, 31 years old (October 9, 1986)**  
**3-6 Record, 4.91 ERA**

- The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 13th start in a Giants uniform...has posted a 3-6 record with a 4.91 ERA (34er, 62.1ip) over his first 12 starts.
- The Giants are 5-7 in his 12 starts, but have won five of his last eight.
- Did not factor into the decision in his last start on June 4 against Arizona...threw 4.0 innings, allowing two runs on four hits with five strikeouts...when his spot in the batting order came up in the bottom of the 4th inning the game was tied 2-2 and the Giants had the bases loaded, so Holland was pinch-hit for.
- Has posted a 2-2 record with a 3.95 ERA (12er, 27.1ip) over his last five outings, with the Giants going 3-2.
- Is holding opponents to a .204 (10-for-49) average with his curveball this season...allowed a .306 (37-for-121) average with 13 home runs off his curveball last season.
- Has held left-handed batters to a .136 clip (6-for-44), which ranks as the fifth-lowest average in the National League...righties are hitting .270 (51-for-189) off him with 27 extra base hits.
- Has allowed 29 extra-base hits, tied for the seventh-most in the NL (18 doubles, two triples, nine home runs)...has allowed just two home runs over his last five starts, after allowing seven homers in his first seven starts.
- Has struggled in the 1st inning, allowing a .341 (15-for-44) opponents average and 10 runs.
- Has never faced the Nationals.
- Holland relies on five pitches...sinker (54.3%), slider (20.3%), curve (13.5%), changeup (11.4%), four seamer (0.5%) (*Baseball Savant*).
- Signed by the Giants to a minor league contract in Feb. and made the team as a non-roster invitee.

<b>NOTES:</b> The four-time All-Star (2013-16) takes the hill today for his second start of the 2018 season...returned from his rehab assignment and was reinstated from the 60-day DL last Tuesday, June 5...made just two rehab starts - one with triple-A Sacramento (3.2ip, 1bb, 8so, 47 pitches) and one with Class A Advanced San Jose (4.2ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 7so). before returning to the big leagues...missed the Giants' first 60 games with a broken pinkie finger on his left hand, an injury he suffered on his final start in spring training at Scottsdale, Arizona on March 23 after Royals' hitter Whit Merrifield hit a line-drive comebacker off of his left hand...made his 2018 debut last Tuesday versus Arizona was logged 6.0 innings, allowing a pair of runs on eight hits with three strikeouts on 82 pitches. Faces the Marlins for the eighth time in his career...is 2-3 with a 4.73 ERA (three quality starts) in seven starts.
