RECENT REDBIRDS: The Cardinals lost their third-straight game last night, matching their season-high losing skid, as they dropped a 4-1 decision to the Twins while falling to 2-3 on their 6-game, 7-day road trip (2-2 at SD, 0-1 at MIN)...the Cardinals have managed just 5 runs during the losing streak and have lost 5 of their last 7 games after having won 5-straight to begin the month of May...the Cardinals began the day tied with Chicago for 3rd place in the N.L. Central, 1.0 game back of Milwaukee & Pittsburgh.

DESIGNATED TO HIT: Playing their first road interleague games of the season this week, the Cardinals have featured the N.L.'s top all-time team in designated hitting with their DH's leading all NL clubs in batting (.298), on-base pct. (.372), slugging (.508) and RBI (127) since the beginning of interleague play.

GREGERSON ON D.L./BREBBIA RECALLED: The Cardinals announced prior to today's game that they have placed right-handed pitcher **Luke Gregerson** (right shoulder impingement) on the 10-day disabled list and recalled right-handed pitcher **John Brebbia** from Memphis (AAA). Gregerson, 34, worked 1/3 of an inning in relief last night, allowing a pair of runs. He's appeared in a total of 12 games this season, allowing eight runs on eight hits in 8.1 innings pitched. Brebbia is 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA in six relief appearances. He's struck out 14 in his 10.0 innings pitched. The Cardinals have had four pitchers go on the disabled list in the past week: **Carlos Martínez** (right lat strain), **Tyler Lyons** (mid back strain), **Adam Wainwright** (right elbow inflammation) and now Gregerson.

THUNDER & LIGHTNING: **Harrison Bader** had an RBI-triple and solo HR in Sunday's loss to the Padres, the first Cardinal to collect a triple and homer in the same game since **Stephen Piscotty** did so 9/1/17 at San Francisco...**Stan Musial** is the Cardinal with the most such games, doing so 17 times in his career.

MAN IN THE MIDDLE: Since his ML debut on May 28, 2017, **Paul DeJong** has hit 33 home runs, 2nd in the majors to the Twins **Brian Dozier** (34) and the Indians **Francisco Lindor** (34) among all Major League middle infielders (SS/2B).

HIGHS & LOWS: The Cardinals, who are hitting .226 as a team, are batting .265 with an .815 OPS and 5.59 runs/game in their wins, as opposed to .175 with a .518 OPS and 2.41 runs/game in their losses.

EXTRA, EXTRA: The Cardinals have played a Major League-high eight extra inning games this season, going 4-4 in those contests...they've played extras in three of their 12 games this month...the Cardinals eight extra inning games in their first 39 games of the season are their most since playing nine such games in the early stages of the 1979 season, going 6-3 in those.

SEASON'S FIRST: Saturday night's 2-1 loss in 13 innings was the team's first this season when allowing two or fewer runs...the Cardinals are 11-1 when allowing two or fewer runs this season.

CLOSE COMFORT: Thursday night's 2-1 win in San Diego was the Cardinals 8th win by a margin of just one run and their 5th one-run win in the month of May...the Cardinals rank 4th in the majors in one-run wins (BOS-11, MIL-10 & ARI-9)...the Cardinals have won six games by a margin of two runs, giving them 14 wins by two runs or less, 2nd only to Milwaukee (16).

MINNESOTA CONNECTIONS

The Twins defeated the Cardinals, four games to three, in the 1987 World Series...marked the first World Series in history in which the home team won every game...notable Cardinals to appear in the series included coaches **Willie McGee** and **José Oquendo**, Cardinals Hall of Famers **Ozzie Smith** and **Vince Coleman**, broadcaster **Ricky Horton**, and **Tony Peña**.

The Cardinals and Twins played a two-game Exhibition series (April 2-3) at Target Field prior to the 2010 season.

Cardinals second baseman **Kolten Wong** was selected by the Twins in the 16th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals outfielder **Dexter Fowler** was Astros teammates with Twins catcher **Jason Castro** and outfielder **Robbie Grossman** (2014).

Cardinals catcher **Francisco Peña** recorded his first MLB hit at Minnesota (October 4, 2015) with a pinch-hit single off **Ryan O'Rourke**...his father, **Tony**, was the Cardinals starting catcher against the Twins in the 1987 World Series.

Cardinals Scouting Director **Randy Flores** pitched in 11 games for the Twins in 2010.

Twins pitcher **Lance Lynn** pitched parts of six seasons in a Cardinals uniform (2011-15, '17)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Series team...selected by St. Louis in the first round (39th overall) in the 2008 MLB Draft.

Twins first baseman **Joe Mauer** and Special Assistant **Justin Morneau** represented the Twins in the 2009 All-Star Game at Busch Stadium...Twins pitcher **Zach Duke** represented the Pirates.

Twins pitcher **Kyle Gibson** pitched three seasons at the University of Missouri (2007-09).

Twins Manager **Paul Molitor** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 28th round of the 1974 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

Cardinals Sr. Special Assistant to the General Manager **Bob Gebhart** was born in Lambert, Minn. and graduated from Lambert High School...received physical education teaching certificate from Minnesota State Mankato in 1969...selected by the Twins in the 44th round of the 1965 MLB Draft...pitched parts of two seasons in a Twins uniform (1971-72)...served as Twins Director of Major League Personnel (1987) and Vice President of Player Personnel (1988-91), where he won two World Series rings (1987 & 1991).

Twins pitcher **Zach Duke** pitched parts of two seasons in St. Louis... July 31, 2016...originally traded by the White Sox to the Cardinals for outfielder **Charlie Tilson**.

Twins pitcher **Jake Odorizzi** was born in nearby Highland, Ill and graduated from Highland High School in 2008...led the Bulldogs to the Class 3A state title...named 2008 Illinois Gatorade Player of the Year...named a Louisville Slugger Pre-season All-American, a Rawlings/Perfect Game All American and a member of USA Today's All USA Team...had seats in right field to witness the Cardinals win Game 7 of the 2011 World Series.

Twins first baseman **Logan Morrison** played college baseball at Maple Woods Community College in Kansas City, Mo...was teammates with Cardinals outfielder **Marcell Ozuna** (2013) and pitcher **Dominic Leone** in Seattle (2014-15).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Lou Brock** was a baserunning consultant for the Twins in 1987.

Cardinals manager **Mike Matheny** managed the National League in the 2014 All-Star Game at Target Field...Cardinals pitcher **Adam Wainwright** was selected as the starting pitcher, while catcher **Yadier Molina** and infielder **Matt Carpenter** were selected as reserves.

Twins Special Assistant **Jim Kaat** was purchased by the Cardinals from the Yankees (April 30, 1980)...pitched parts of four seasons with St. Louis (1980-83)...was a member of the 1982 World Series Champions.

Twins Minor League Hitting Coordinator **Rick Eckstein** previously served as Hitting Coach for the 2007 Memphis Redbirds (AAA)...his brother, **David**, was an All-Star shortstop for St. Louis for three seasons (2005-07) and won the 2006 World Series.

Current Fox Sports Director of Cardinals telecasts for over 30 years, **Tom Mee's** father, **Tom**, was the first employee hired by the Twins in the fall of 1960...later served as the Twins director of media relations until 1991, then he became the team's official scorer.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** was the voice of the Minnesota Twins in 1987 and has been the play-by-play voice for three World Series championship teams: 1987 Twins, 2005 White Sox and 2006 Cardinals.

Twins Communications Assistant and Translator **Elvis Martínez** spent 2017 in the Cardinals organization as a Baseball Operations Fellowship and GCL Cardinals Coordinator in Jupiter, Fla.

- Makes his 8th start of the season and the 18th of his career (45th appearance).
- Today is his first career appearance vs. Minnesota and his 10th career start (12th app.) vs. an American League opponent.
- Opened the season with sixth straight starts against the N.L. Central: Reds (2x), Brewers (2x), Pirates (1x) and Cubs (1x) before facing San Diego in his last start.

- Leads all of Major League Baseball in strikeout/walk ratio (11.67) and is 5th in the N.L. in baserunners/9 IP (8.87).
- Ranks in the Top 10 among National League pitchers in wins (5, T2nd), ERA (2.51, 8th), innings pitched (46.2, T9th) and WHIP (0.96, 4th).
- Tied for the MLB lead in win streak (5) with Corey Kluber, Rick Porcello and Max Scherzer. Only Mikolas' streak is still active.
- Issued only three walks in 46.2 innings this season, best walks/9 IP ratio (0.58) in MLB.
- Leads Major League Baseball with five starts without issuing a walk.
