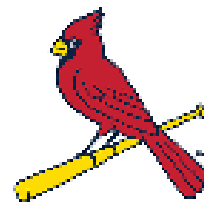

ROAD TRIPPIN' REDBIRDS: The Cardinals are coming to the end of a nine-game/10-day road trip to Arizona, San Francisco and Chicago (AL) tonight with the first of two games against the Chicago White Sox. Sunday afternoon, the Cardinals fell to the San Francisco Giants 13-8 at AT&T Park. The Cardinals and Giants combined for 21 runs and 28 hits in the game, both totals were a season-high in a Cardinals game. **José Martínez** tallied his 11th three-hit game, tied with **Albert Almora, Jr.**, for the National League lead in three-hit games. **Matt Carpenter** hit a pinch-hit home run in the 8th inning.

"SWEET HOME, CHICAGO...": The Cardinals, who play in Chicago three series each year against the rival Cubs, will be making their second of four trips this season (Apr. 16-19 at CHI). Tonight, the Cardinals head to the South Side to take on the White Sox for the first time since July 21-22, 2015. St. Louis swept that two-game set and then won two games against the 'Sox May 1-2 of this season giving them a four-game win streak in this series.

SPLISH, SPLASH!: On Sunday, **Matt Carpenter** became the 121st player to smack a home run into McCovey Cove on the fly. The shot, Carpenter's 2nd career pinch-hit blast, came off rookie **Ray Black** making his Major League debut and was estimated at 391 feet by StatCast. It was Carpenter's team-leading 17th home run of the season. The home run was also the 43rd hit by a visiting team player and the most recent by a Cardinals player in exactly 13 years as **Larry Walker** hit one into the San Francisco Bay on July 8, 2005, off **Jason Schmidt** (with **Mike Matheny** catching for the Giants).

MIKOLAS SELECTED TO ALL-STAR GAME; CARPENTER ON FINAL VOTE: The St. Louis Cardinals will be represented by right-handed pitcher **Miles Mikolas** at the Major League Baseball All-Star game as he was selected by MLB., his first All-Star selection. Infielder **Matt Carpenter** (#VoteCarp) was picked to be in MLB's Final Vote. Carpenter, a three-time All-Star, is going up against **Jesús Aguilar** (Brewers), **Brandon Belt** (Giants), **Max Muncy** (Dodgers) and **Trea Turner** (Nationals).

SEND IN THE G.O.A.T.! Last night, Major League Baseball announced that Cardinals catcher **Yadier Molina** will be an injury replacement for San Francisco's **Buster Posey** (right hip inflammation) in the All-Star Game. Molina, who will be making his ninth appearance at the All-Star Game (2009-15, 17), finished 4th among catchers in the fan voting and hit the game-tying home run for the National League in last season's All-Star Game in Miami. No other player in this year's game has more than seven All-Star selections.

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER: **Matt Carpenter** enters tonight's Interleague matchup leading all active players with a career .625 slugging percentage in those contests while ranking 3rd in batting (.331) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.415).

SMOKING HOT!: Since May 16, **Matt Carpenter** has raised his batting average from .140 to .258 smacking a Major League-leading 34 extra base hits, 20 doubles and leads the National League with 41 runs. He's ranked among MLB leaders in home runs (14, T7th) and hits (62, T4th) while batting .330 (T7th) and slugged .660 (5th) during that period.

THE DUKE PITCHES BACK-TO-BACK: Cardinals rehabbing relief pitcher, **Luke Gregerson**, pitched on consecutive days in Springfield (AA) the last two days with scoreless appearances in both. Gregerson has made five rehab appearances between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield since June 30 and has allowed one unearned run, two hits and has struck out five. His last MLB action was on May 15 at Minnesota.

DON'T WALK: **Carlos Martínez**, **Jordan Hicks** and **Bud Norris** combined to keep the Giants off the bases with no free passes on Saturday in a Cardinals 3-2 win. The Cardinals are 4-1 this season when they don't issue a walk. The four wins without a walk ranks T3rd (Cubs, Diamondbacks) in the National League behind the Dodgers (9) and Nationals (6).

CHICAGO CONNECTIONS

Coach **Willie McGee** was originally selected by the White Sox in the 7th round of the 1976 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

First baseman **José "Cafecito" or "Cafe Jr." Martínez** originally signed with the White Sox as a non-drafted free agent (February 16, 2006)...spent seven seasons in the White Sox minor league organization before electing free agency...his father, **Carlos "Café" Martínez**...played for Chicago for three seasons (1988-90)...made MLB debut with the White Sox (Sept. 2, 1988 at Cleveland).

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** managed Chicago for parts of eight seasons (1979-86)...began managerial career in 1978 in the White Sox minor league system with AA-Knoxville Sox of the Southern League...played two minor league seasons in the White Sox organization for the AAA-Denver Bears (1975) and AAA-Iowa Oaks (1976).

White Sox Pitching Consultant **Dave Duncan** served as St. Louis' pitching coach for 16 seasons (1996-2011)...under his watch, the Cardinals ranked third in the majors in overall ERA and third in starting-pitching ERA...coached **Chris Carpenter** to 2005 Cy Young Award and four Cardinals to 20 game-winning seasons (Carpenter, 2005; Adam Wainwright, 2010; Matt Morris, 2001; Darryl Kile, 2000)...awarded 2009 Meritorious Service Award by St. Louis BBWAA.

Pitcher **Luke Gregerson** was born in and resides in nearby Park Ridge, Ill...graduated from Morton High School in Berwyn, Ill...played college baseball at St. Xavier University (Ill).

Pitcher **Jack Flaherty** was high school teammates with White Sox pitcher **Lucas Giolito** and Braves pitcher **Max Fried** while at Harvard-Westlake High School in Los Angeles, Calif.

Infielder **Paul DeJong** graduated from nearby Antioch (Ill.) Community High School...played three seasons at Illinois State Univ. (2013-15) while majoring in biochemistry and pre-medicine.

Infielder **Greg Garcia's** brother, **Drew**, was selected by the White Sox in the 21st round of the 2008 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons in the White Sox minor league organization (2008-13).

Catcher **Francisco Peña** made his MLB debut against the White Sox while with the Royals (May 20, 2014), his only game played that season...his father, **Tony**, played 31 games for the White Sox in 1997...later traded by the White Sox to Houston for pitcher **Julien Tucker** (August 15, 1997).

White Sox outfielder **Charlie Tilson** was originally selected by St. Louis in the 2nd round of the 2011 MLB Draft...later traded by the Cardinals to the White Sox for pitcher **Zach Duke** (July 31, 2016).

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** pitched in 52 games for the White Sox in 1988...originally traded by the Cardinals with outfielder **Lance Johnson** and cash to Chicago for pitcher **Jose DeLeon**.

Cardinals broadcaster **John Rooney** spent 18 years (1998-2005) with the White Sox - one in TV followed by 17 seasons in the radio booth...Rooney worked with the World Champion team in back-to-back seasons, following the White Sox win in 2005.

Late Hall of Famer **Red Schoendienst** hit a game-winning solo home run off Detroit's **Ted Gray** in the top of the 14th inning to give the National League a 4-3 win in the 1950 All-Star Game at Comiskey Park at Chicago.

Hall of Famer **White Herzog** managed the National League in the 1983 All-Star Game at Comiskey Park in Chicago, a game that featured starting shortstop **Ozzie Smith** and reserve outfielders **Willie McGee** and **George Hendrick**.

White Sox Bench Coach **Joe McEwing** was selected by the Cardinals in the 28th round of the 1992 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons with St. Louis (1998-99)...made his Major League debut with the Cardinals on September 2, 1998 at Florida...later traded to the Mets for pitcher **Jesse Orosco** (March 18, 2000).

TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 55th career appearance (28th start) tonight in his 18th start of the season.
- Ranks among NL leaders in wins (9, T5th), winning pct. (.750, 6th), ERA (2.63, 6th), innings pitched (109.1, 9th), WHIP (1.03, 5th), strikeout/walk ratio (4.41, 7th), base-runners/9 IP (9.63, 5th) and HR/9 IP (0.66, 4th), and fewest walks/9 IP (1.40, 1st) and quality starts (12, T4th).
- Pitched 7.0 or more innings in six starts (T6th in NL) and at least 6.0 innings in 14 of his 17 starts this season (T4th in the NL).
- Leads the National League with a 1.65 ERA in eight home starts (10 ER/54.2 IP), the 4th-lowest home ERA in MLB. On the road, he's 5-0 with a 3.62 ERA in 9 road starts; his five wins are T3rd in the NL, while Mikolas and COL's Tyler Anderson (4-0) are the only NL pitchers with perfect 1.000 win percentage.

- Collected his team-leading 9th win (5th on the road) on Independence Day at Arizona, tossing his 12th quality start.
- Matched his career-high of 4 walks.

- Selected by Major League Baseball to represent the Cardinals on the 2018 National League All-Star team...was his first MLB All-Star nod and second recognition of his career (2010 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star with Fort Wayne).
- Leads all National League pitchers with the fewest pitches per inning (14.7).
- Sports an 9-0 record with three no-decisions (St. Louis is 10-2) when receiving two or more runs of support in a start.
- Led the National League with 6.24 runs of support in his first 10 starts to begin the season (3/29-5/31), but just 14 runs of support in his last seven starts...his 2.93 run support average since June 1 is the 5th-lowest in the NL (Jack Flaherty, 2.78, is 2nd).
- Ranks T4th in the N.L. with six starts without issuing a walk, trailing PIT's Ivan Nova (8) and LAD's Ross Stripling (8), and LAD's Alex Wood (7).
- Is one of 14 pitchers in MLB and five in the National League with a shutout this season.
- Earned his team-high 8th win of the season on 6/23, as the Cardinals snapped a 3-game losing skid with a 3-2 win at MIL. Allowed two 1st inning runs, then blanked the Crew over his final 5.2 IP, setting down 15-straight from the 2nd to the 7th.
