TRIBE HEADLINES

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** has been named American League Player of the Month for July...he finished the month as the MLB leader in stolen bases (11), while he ranked T2nd in RBI (25) & extra-base hits (18), T4th in walks (19) & runs scored (21), and T5th in homers (8).

» **LHP ANDREW MILLER** has been activated from the 60-day Disabled List...had been on the D.L. since May 26 with right knee inflammation...to make room on the 25-man roster, **RHP ZACH McALLISTER** has been designated for assignment.

» **MIKE CLEVINGER** owns a 3-0 lifetime record with a 2.95 ERA (7ER/21.1IP) in four career starts against the Angels, his former organization...he earned the win in his season debut on April 2 at Angel Stadium, tossing 5.1 shutout innings (4H, 2BB, 5K).

» The Indians bullpen owns a 2.78 second-half ERA (11ER/35.2IP), the 2nd-lowest in the American League and 5th-lowest in MLB... Tribe relievers have also posted a 1.08 ERA (3ER/25.0IP) across their past nine contests.

EARN YOUR WINGS

» The Indians are set to open their second and final series of the season with the Angels in this weekend's three-game set.

» The clubs previously met from April 2-4 at Angel Stadium, with Los Angeles-AL taking two of the three contests...Cleveland won 6-0 in the opener, but fell 13-2 and 3-2 (13 innings) in the other two games.

» The Indians own an all-time record of 315-327 (.491) against the Angels, including a mark of 23-12 (.657) since **Terry Francona** became Tribe manager in 2013...dating back to June 12, 2016, Cleveland has won 12 of its last 14 games vs. Los Angeles-AL, including 10 straight wins at Progressive Field (since August 28, 2015).

TODAY'S TRANSACTION

» **LHP ANDREW MILLER** has been activated from the 60-day Disabled List...to make room on the 25-man roster, **RHP ZACH McALLISTER** has been designated for assignment.

» Miller has been on the D.L. since May 26 with right knee inflammation and made seven rehab appearances between July 17-31 with Single-A Lake County, Double-A Akron and Triple-A Columbus (5.2IP, 7H, 9R/7ER, 1BB, 7K)...he owns a 1-3 record with a 4.40 ERA (7ER/14.1IP) in 17 appearances for Cleveland this season, striking out 23 batters across those outings.

» McAllister has been a member of the Indians organization since his acquisition from the New York Yankees on August 20, 2010...in 41 games this season, he has posted a 1-2 record with a 4.97 ERA (23ER/41.2IP)...he has made 277 appearances (68 starts) for Cleveland across eight seasons, the 28th-most in franchise history.

WEDNESDAY'S RECAP

» The Indians took the rubber match at Minnesota and notched their 10th shutout of the season on Wednesday afternoon, blanking the Twins 2-0.

» **JOSÉ RAMÍREZ** went 2-for-4 with a double, collecting his 33rd multi-hit game of the season...**RAJAI DAVIS** (1-5) scored the game's first run, dashing home on a double steal attempt with Ramírez...**YAN GOMES** (1-4) provided an insurance run with a 9th-inning RBI-single, and **LEONYS MARTIN** went 1-for-2 in his first game for the Indians.

» **CARLOS CARRASCO** earned his 13th win in dominant fashion, holding the Twins to just four hits over 7.1 scoreless innings...walked none and struck out 10 batters, logging his fourth start this season with double-digit punchouts...Carrasco joined **COREY KLUBER** as the only pitchers in Indians history to record multiple career starts with 10 strikeouts, no walks and no runs allowed.

» **BRAD HAND** collected his second save with the Indians, tossing 1.2 scoreless frames (2K) to preserve the Tribe's shutout.

GOOSE EGGS

» Cleveland ranks T2nd in the American League with 10 shutouts this season (T4th in MLB)...four of those shutouts have come at Progressive Field, while six have been thrown on the road, including a 6-0 win on April 2 at Los Angeles-AL.

» The Indians threw an MLB-high 19 shutouts in 2017, the club's most since recording 23 in 1968...through 107 team games last season, Cleveland had collected nine shutouts.

THIS DAY IN INDIANS HISTORY

1948: 42-year-old **Satchel Paige** makes his first career Major League start vs. Washington after beginning his MLB career with eight relief appearances...Paige earned the win, allowing three runs over 7.0 strong innings (7H, 4BB, 6K) in the Tribe's 5-3 victory over the Senators...the win moved Cleveland into a four-way tie for the American League lead, en route to the Indians' eventual run to the pennant and World Series championship.

TONIGHT'S START

» The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to start tonight's series opener vs. the Los Angeles Angels, the club that originally drafted him in 2011...will mark his 66th career appearance and 53rd start, as well as his career-best 22nd start of the season.
 » Clevinger will pitch tonight on extended five days' rest after making his last start on July 28 at Detroit...battled through an illness and took the loss despite allowing just two runs on five hits (one home run), with one walk and eight strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
 » Will face the Angels for the second time this season...**earned the win on April 2 in Anaheim in his first start of the season, shutting out Los Angeles-AL in his 5.1 innings and allowing just four hits and two walks, with five strikeouts.**
 » Clevinger has pitched well against his former organization, owning a career 3-0 record and 2.95 ERA (7ER/21.1IP) in four starts vs. the Angels.
 » Enters play tonight ranked T7th in the American League with 13 double plays induced, as well as 13th with a 3.43 ERA.

VS. LOS ANGELES-AL | A.L. WEST

» Clevinger is due to make his second start of the season vs. the Angels tonight...last faced Los Angeles-AL in Anaheim in his first start of the year on April 2, earning the win after tossing 5.1 shutout innings (4H, 2BB, 5K).
 » **Owens a career 3-0 record and 2.95 ERA (7ER/21.1IP) in four starts against the organization that originally drafted him in 2011...**his career 2.95 ERA vs. Los Angeles-AL is his 2nd-lowest mark against an opponent that he has started against at least four times.
 » Two of Clevinger's four career starts vs. the Angels twice have come at Progressive Field...has posted a 1-0 record and 5.40 ERA (6ER/10.0IP) in those outings, both Indians victories.
 » Last faced Los Angeles-AL at home on July 25, 2017...did not factor into the decision in the Tribe's 11-7 win, allowing six runs (five earned) on nine hits (two home runs), with two walks and five strikeouts over 4.1 innings.
 » Clevinger will face an opponent from the A.L. West division for the eighth time this year in tonight's game...has compiled a 2-3 record and 4.25 ERA (20ER/42.1IP) in his seven prior starts.

HOME COOKING

» Clevinger is due to make his 11th home start of the season tonight...owns a 3-3 record and 4.26 ERA (30ER/63.1IP) in his 10 prior outings...has allowed three-or-fewer runs in five of his nine home starts, tied with **CARLOS CARRASCO** for the 3rd-most such outings on the Tribe (**COREY KLUBER** - 10, **TREVOR BAUER** - 9).
 » He has put together stronger numbers on the road than at home this season...is 4-2 with a 2.69 ERA (21ER/70.1IP) and .213 opponent batting average on the road compared to 3-3 with a 4.26 ERA and .270 opponent batting average at home.
 » Owns a career 10-7 record and 3.94 ERA (66ER/150.2IP) in 33 games (25 starts) at Progressive Field.

2018 RECAP & HIGHLIGHTS

» **Recorded his 12th quality start of the season on July 22 at Texas, setting a new career high (previous, 11 quality starts in 2017).**
 » Clevinger matched his career high with 11 strikeouts on July 9 vs. Cincinnati...marked his fourth career start with 10-or-more strikeouts...the Tribe pitching staff has 20 such starts this season, which is 2nd in MLB (Houston - 21).
 » Notched his seventh win on July 1 at Oakland, holding the Athletics to three runs on eight hits (2BB, 5K) over 6.0 innings...marked his 11th quality start of the season, matching his career high (set in 2017).
 » Finished the month of June with a 2-1 record and 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in five starts...marked his 3rd-lowest ERA in a single month in his career (min. 5G), trailing Sept./Oct. 2017 (0.99 ERA) and March/April 2018 (2.56 ERA)...his 33 strikeouts in June are his 2nd-most in a single month, behind his 39 punchouts in May of this year.
 » On June 14 at Chicago-AL, set a new career-high with 11 punchouts in the Tribe's 5-2 win (7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, 1BB)...combined with his start on June 19 (10K), struck out 10-or-more batters in consecutive starts for the first time in his career.
 » Clevinger has also thrown 100-or-more pitches in 14 of his 21 starts this season, which is tied for the 4th-most such starts in the American League...teammate **TREVOR BAUER** leads the Majors with 23 such outings.
 » **Tossed his first career complete-game shutout on April 21 at Baltimore on April 21...**held the Orioles to two hits and two walks, with three strikeouts...his two hits allowed in the game marking the fewest such hits in a complete-game shutout by an Indians starting pitcher since **CARLOS CARRASCO** allowed one hit in a CGSO at Kansas City on September 25, 2015 (9.0IP, 2BB, 15K).
 » Set a new career-high in innings pitched for the second time this season in the outing, after breaking his previous career best with 7.1IP on April 8 vs. Kansas City.

CAREER SNAPSHOT & 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

» Clevinger is in his fourth season in the Indians organization...was selected in the 4th round (135th overall) by Los Angeles-AL in the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Seminole State College (FL)...**acquired by the Indians in exchange for reliever Vinnie Pestano on Aug. 7, 2014...**added to Cleveland's 40-man roster on November 20, 2015.
 » Was ranked as the 7th-best prospect in the Indians organization entering the 2015 & 2016 seasons by **Baseball America**...split 2016 between Triple-A Columbus and Cleveland, going 11-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 17 starts for the Clippers and making 17 appearances for the Tribe throughout the season...began the year 9-0 in Columbus, did not lose a game until July 18 (15th start)...tossed a scoreless inning in the Triple-A All-Star Game on July 13 (2K).
 » Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2016 against Cincinnati...did not factor into the decision, tossing 5.1 innings (5H, 4R/ER, 1HR, 1BB, 5K) in the Tribe's 8-7 win...struck out Joey Votto in the first inning for his first career MLB punchout...went 3-3 with a 5.26 ERA 31ER/53.0IP) in 17 games (10 starts) across three stints with the Indians.
 » **Named Tribe's organizational Pitcher of the Year in 2015...**went 9-8 with a 2.73 ERA in 27 games/26 starts with Akron, tallying the 3rd-most strikeouts, the second-lowest WHIP and the 4th-lowest average against in all of Double-A (.219).
 » Posted career-highs in nearly every pitching category in 2017, including wins (12), strikeouts (137), ERA (3.11), innings pitched (121.2), games (27) and games started (21)...overall, went 12-6 with a 3.11 ERA (42ER/121.2IP) in 27 games (21 starts) at the Major League level.
 » His 3.11 ERA ranked 8th among American League starting pitchers with at least 100.0 innings, and his .211 average against ranked 5th...ranked 4th on the club in wins.
 » Made four starts in the Tribe's historic 22-game win streak, allowing one earned run in those appearances and posting a 4-0 record and 0.38 ERA (1ER/23.2IP), while holding opposing hitters to a .186 (16-86) batting average...became the first CLE pitcher since John Denny in 1981 with three consecutive starts of 6.0-or-more scoreless innings.
 » **Won his final five starts of the season, marking a new career-long streak, and compiled a 5-0 record with a 0.61 ERA (2ER/29.2IP) in that span.**
 » **POSTSEASON:** Appeared in relief in Games 2 & 4 of the 2017 American League Division Series against the New York Yankees...allowed two earned runs on one hit (1HR) in 0.2 innings (2BB, 2K) in the Tribe's 9-8 victory in Game 2 at Progressive Field...tossed 0.2 innings again in Game 4 in The Bronx (1H, 1R, 2BB, 1K), as the Indians lost 7-3...has no record and a 6.43 ERA (5ER/7.0IP) in six career Postseason appearances.
