### MARINERS NOTES:

- This marks the first time in club history that the Mariners have opened the season with three consecutive one-run games.
- **Dee Gordon** recorded his 2<sup>nd</sup> career go-ahead home run in the 7<sup>th</sup> inning and later (also: 9/10/17 at ATL w/MIA – 8<sup>th</sup> inning)...it was his first home run of the season and first home run as a Mariner.
  - Has gone 4x12 to open the season and now holds a career .304 (144x474) batting average in March/April.
- **Mitch Haniger** hit his second home run of the season.
  - Has gone 5x8 to start the season and now holds a career .368 (32x87) batting average in March/April.
- 8 of the 12 runs scored by the Mariners this season have come via home run.
  - In the series, 17 of 23 runs scored by both teams have come via a combined 9 home runs.
- **Mike Leake** earned his 4<sup>th</sup> win in his first 6 starts as a Mariner...ranks T2<sup>nd</sup> for most wins in first 6 starts as a Mariner (James Paxton, 5 wins).
  - Marks his 11<sup>th</sup> start of at least 7.0 innings pitched since the beginning of 2017, tied for 17<sup>th</sup>-most in the Majors during that span.
- **Robinson Canó** recorded his 514<sup>th</sup> career double in the 1<sup>st</sup> inning, tying **Edgar Martinez** for 53<sup>rd</sup>-most all-time in Major League history...of the 52 players who rank ahead of them, 32 are in the Hall of Fame.
  - Holds a career .333 (113x339) batting average against the Indians.
  - Recorded his second multi-hit game of the season...ranked 1<sup>st</sup> on the team with 47 multi-hit games in 2017.
- **Kyle Seager** recorded his first hit of the season, an RBI double in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning...he is now just 4 hits shy of 1,000 career hits.
- **David Freitas** recorded his first hit as a Mariner with a double in the 5<sup>th</sup> inning.

### INDIANS NOTES:

- Marks the first time the Indians have lost a series since Aug. 3, 2017...were 15-0-3 in their last 18 series.
- **Edwin Encarnacion** hit two home runs, bringing his career total to 350...marks his 29<sup>th</sup> career multi-home run game (last: Aug. 14, 2017 at BOS).
- **Yonder Alonso** went 2x4 with a double in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning...he is now hitting .300 (3x10) on the season.

## **CLEVELAND MANAGER TERRY FRANCONA:**

### **On Trevor Bauer:**

"I was really impressed with him, a lot of traffic a lot of deep counts but the ball's coming out really well so that's a good first outing. You know, you're at 100 after 5, that's...and you know it's not just that. It's that you're showing good hitters a lot of pitches."

### **On the 5<sup>th</sup>-inning ground ball that bounced over 1B Yonder Alonso's head:**

"Yeah, that's a shame because I thought Trev did a really good job. Like I said, there was a ton of traffic but he got the ground ball he was desperately needing and it just hit something and went right over his head."

### **On the bullpen and Dee Gordon's home run:**

"You know, we're trying to figure out the innings to get to Andrew and Cody and, you know, [Otero] came in, first thing, really well and wanted to get to Canó. And then Gordon, you know, he's not known for that, but he got every bit of it and that hurt us."

### **On Encarnacion's two home runs:**

"Yeah, that bodes well for us, because last year it was really tough sledding for him for a while. To see him be that aggressive early on is really good."
