BLUE JAYS NOTES:

- Defeated the Red Sox for the 2nd time in their last 12 meetings...Have gone 4-12 vs. Boston this season and 18-27 vs. AL East opponents...Snapped their 5G home losing streak and are now 28-30 here...Improved to 38-34 in games vs. RH starters (14-28 vs. LH starters)...Have now doubled in 23 straight games (49-2B), their longest such stretch since a 25G streak from 8/25-9/20/17.
- RYAN BORUCKI** gave up 4 runs while allowing a career-high 9 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 3 batters and struck out a pair...Had his homerless streak come to an end at 47.1 innings, tied for the 3rd longest all-time by a Blue Jay to start their career...Evened his record at 2-2...Now has a 9.00 ERA (8 ER/8.0 IP) vs. BOS, and a 1.58 ERA (7 ER/40.0 IP) vs. all others.
- TEOSCAR HERNANDEZ** tied Justin Smoak for the team lead with his 18th home run of the season, a solo shot in the 3rd inning...Has homered in consecutive games for the 4th time in his career...Was his 8th career HR vs. BOS, his most vs. any team (6 vs. NYY)...Now has 20 RBI in 20 career games against the Red Sox
- JUSTIN SMOAK** extended his hitting streak to 13 games with an RBI single in the 1st inning...The streak is the 2nd longest streak of his career (14G: 9/23/10-4/4/11) and the longest by a Blue Jay this season...Became the 10th AL player with a 13+G streak in 2018...Went 3-for-4 with 2 RBI and has back-to-back three-hit games for the 2nd time in his career (also 3/31-4/1/18)...Marks his team-leading 10th 3+ hit effort this year...Has gone 21-for-55 (.382) with 5-2B, 2-HR, 6-RBI and 4BB over this current 13G run (1.006 OPS).
- RANDAL GRICHUK** hit a two-run homer in the 5th for his 16th HR of the season...Has homered in back-to-back games for the 2nd time this year (also 6/8-9)...Was his 14th HR since 6/3...Has gone 26-for-83 (.313) with 9-2B, 5-HR and 14-RBI over his last 20 games...Coming into tonight, his 12 XBH since the All-Star Break were tied for 5th most in the AL...Recorded 3 RBI for the 2nd straight game (5th 3+ RBI game of 2018), doing so in consecutive games for the 1st time in his career.
- DEVON TRAVIS** walked, singled twice and drove in a run...Finished 2-for-3 for his 15th multi-hit game, the 4th of his last 6 games...Has gone 26-for-84 (.310) with 2-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR and 18-RBI over his last 26 games.

RED SOX NOTES:

- Lost for the 2nd time in their last 12 games...Are now 12-4 vs. Toronto and 39-15 in divisional contests...Gave up 8 runs in a game for the first time since allowing 13 on 7/13 vs. TOR.
- RICK PORCELLO** allowed 7 runs on 6 hits over 4.0+ innings (5K, 3BB)...Gave up 2 HR and has now allowed 26 in his career vs. Toronto, his most vs. any team (21 vs. MIN)...The 7ER were his 2nd most in a game this year (8ER on 7/13 vs. TOR)...Is now 1-2 with a 9.15 ERA (20 ER/19.2 IP) in 4 starts against the Jays this year.
- MOOKIE BETTS** hit his 1st career cycle...Became the 21st player in Red Sox history to hit the cycle (22nd time) and the first to do so since Brock Holt on 6/16/15 vs. ATL...The HR was his 27th this year...Was his 5th four-hit game this season, one back of MLB leaders David Peralta and Giancarlo Stanton...His 13 3+ hit games are tied for 2nd most in the Majors...His 59 XBH entering tonight ranked T-4th in the AL...Has reached base in 25 of his last 42 PA vs. Toronto (.595 OBP)...Upped his MLB-leading average to .347.
- J.D. MARTINEZ** extended his MLB lead in home runs (35) and RBI (99) with a solo homer in the 5th inning...Extended his hitting streak to 8 games, batting .438 (14-for-32) with 6-2B, 3-HR and 10-RBI in that stretch.
- EDUARDO NUNEZ** plated the first 2 runs of the game with a single in the 1st inning...Added another 2 singles in a 3-for-4 evening...The 3 hits tied a season high (3rd time)...Has multiple hits in 7 of his last 12 games while going 18-for-50 (.360) with 3-2B, 2-3B and 7-RBI (.885 OPS).
