Rockies Notes

🔒 **LHP Tyler Anderson** made his second career postseason appearance.....allowed 2 runs in an inning of work in last season's Wild Card game at Arizona.....has allowed 2 or fewer runs in each of his last 4 starts, during which he has gone 1-2 with a 1.75 ERA (25.2ip, 5er).....was his fourth career start against the Brewers (all coming at Miller Park) moving to 1-3 with a 6.53 ERA (20.2ip, 15er) against them.....fell to the Crew earlier this season, allowing 7 runs over 4 innings, including a career high-tying 3 home runs allowed, in an 8-4 loss.

🔒 **LF Gerardo Parra** singled in the fourth inning to extend his postseason hitting streak to 5 games.....since beginning his postseason career 0-for-17 in the 2011 NLDS against the Brewers (collected his first hit in his 18th and final at-bat in that series), he has gone 7-for-13 (.538) since.

🔒 **3B Nolan Arenado** recorded his first career multi-hit game in the postseason.....was 2-for-13 (.154) in his first 3 postseason games.

🔒 **The Rockies** were shut out for the first time in the postseason, coming in their 23rd all-time postseason game.....marked the first time they have been shut out in 60 combined regular and postseason games at Miller Park.....were shut out 9 times during the regular season.....have dropped 7 of their 9 matchups against the Brewers this season (regular or postseason) and 9 of their last 11 overall (regular or postseason) against Milwaukee dating back to 8/19/17.

🔒 **Colorado** has dropped consecutive games for the first time since being swept by the Dodgers from 9/17-9/19.....had won 10 of 12 games since then leading up to Thursday.....only lost back-to-back games twice in the month of September.

Brewers Notes

🔒 **RHP Jhoulys Chacin** made his first career postseason appearance against the team that signed him as a non-drafted free agent out of Venezuela in 2004 and that he spent the first 6 years of his Major League career with.....started on 3 or fewer days rest for the third time in his career, first since 9/14/16 vs. Seattle (3 days rest); however, this was his fewest days rest between starts in his career, as the other 2 starts were preceded by relief appearances.....made his fifth career start against the Rockies, moving to 3-1 with a 2.70 ERA (26.2ip, 8er) against them.....defeated Colorado earlier this season on 5/10 at Coors Field, allowing 2 runs over 5.1 innings in a 5-2 win for the Brewers.

🔒 **Chacin's** 5 scoreless innings marked the second-longest scoreless appearance by a Brewer in the postseason.....the only longer scoreless outing was by Mike Caldwell, who threw a complete-game shutout in Game 1 of the 1982 World Series at St. Louis.....led the Brewers with a career high 6 scoreless starts during the regular season.

🔒 **C Erik Kratz** recorded his first career postseason hit in the third inning, a single.....made his postseason debut at 38 years, 112 days old, becoming the oldest player to make his postseason debut since R.A. Dickey (40 years, 348 days) of the Blue Jays started on the mound in Game 4 of the 2015 ALDS at Texas.....he is the seventh-oldest player to make his postseason debut and not pitch in that game, the oldest since Jose Morales (38 years, 278 days) of the Dodgers pinch-hit in Game 1 of the 1983 NLCS vs. Philadelphia.....Kratz is the second-oldest position player to start in his postseason debut, ahead of only Lave Cross (39 years, 150 days) of the Philadelphia Athletics, who started at third base in Game 1 of the 1905 World Series vs. the New York Giants.

🔒 **SS Hernán Pérez** drove in the Brewers' first run with a double in the fourth inning, his first career postseason hit.....prior to the double, was hitless in his first 5 career postseason at-bats, 2 of which came in 4 games with Detroit in 2013-14..... is the third Brewers player with multiple doubles in a postseason game, joining Jerry Hairston Jr. in Game 4 of the 2011 NLCS at St. Louis and Sal Bando in Game 2 of the 1981 ALDS vs. New York-AL.....was his first RBI since 8/28 at Cincinnati, spanning 24 games.....was 2-for-17 (.118) with runners on base and 1-for-8 (.125) with runners in scoring position dating back to his last RBI.

🔒 **RF Christian Yelich** has reached base in 14 straight contests dating back to 9/17, batting .479 (23-for-48) with 18 runs, 5 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 18 walks and 23 RBI during this span.

🔒 **3B Mike Moustakas** has hit safely in each of his last 8 postseason games dating back to Game 6 of the 2015 ALCS vs. Toronto, batting .343 (12-for-35) with 4 multi-hit games during this span.....has driven in at least one run in 9 of his last 12 postseason games.

🔒 **CF Lorenzo Cain** has gone hitless in consecutive games for just the second time in 33 career postseason appearances, first since Game 4 of the 2014 ALCS vs. Baltimore and Game 1 of the 2014 World Series at San Francisco.....finished the regular season on an 8-game hitting streak, during which he hit .314 (11-for-35).

🔒 **RHP Corey Knebel** has not allowed a run in his 18 appearances (regular or postseason) since being recalled from Triple-A on 9/2, spanning 19 innings.....has allowed 5 hits, 4 walks and struck out 36 during this span, holding opposing hitters to a .085 batting average (5-for-59).....since Knebel's recall, Brewers relievers have gone 14-0 with a 1.72 ERA (125.1ip, 24er) in 28 games.....opponents have batted just .188 (84-for-446, 171k).

🔒 **Milwaukee** recorded their second-ever shutout in the postseason, also Game 1 of the 1982 World Series at St. Louis, a 10-0 victory.....had 14 shutouts during the regular season, the Club's most since 2013 (15).....marked the team's fourth shutout of Colorado, first since 8/1/06 at Coors Field, a 1-0 victory.....was the first time the Crew had held the Rockies scoreless at Miller Park in 60 combined regular and postseason games.

🔒 **The Brewers** have won 10 straight games dating back to 9/23, the team's longest streak since also winning 10 straight during the 2003 regular season, from 8/19-8/28.....this is tied for the second-longest winning streak in franchise history, which has now been accomplished 6 times.....the single-season Club record is 13 games, set from 4/6-4/20, 1987.....have won 7 of their 9 matchups against the Rockies this season (regular or postseason) and 9 of their last 11 overall (regular or postseason) against Colorado dating back to 8/19/17.

🔒 **The Crew** is up 2-games-to-none in this best-of-five series and is one win away from clinching their second trip to the NLCS, also 2011.....according to Elias, teams that have gone up 2-games-to-none in the Division Series during the Wild Card era (since 1995) have gone on to win the series 48 out of 55 times, or 87.3 percent of the time.
