THE LOSS: The Royals dropped to 2-7 in rubber matches and snapped their three-series unbeaten streak (2-0-1), falling to 3-13-3 in 19 series overall.

- + Have played 28 of 59 games (47.5%) during the day, one behind Detroit for most in the Majors...they're scheduled to play 28 more day games over their remaining 103, which would equal 56 day games out of 162 (34.6%), fifth most in club history and most since 2004 (61)...they're 9-19 in day games (26-27 in 2017).
- + Scored just six runs on 19 hits in the three-game series, while batting just .100 (2-for-20) with runners in scoring position, including 0-for-4 today.
- + Have lost three straight home series vs. Oakland since their last win from April 17-19, 2015, and have lost 11 of 15 overall vs. the A's since April 16, 2016.
- + Fell to 10-21 at home—including a 1-12 start—but have had a winning home record in each of the previous five seasons (2013-17), going 227-178.

JAKOB JUNIS: He's lost back-to-back starts for the first time in his career and has allowed three runs in back-to-back starts for the first time this season.

- + He's held opponents to three-or-fewer runs in 20 of 28 career starts (71.4%)—including nine of 12 this season—but has lost his last two after starting 11-0.
- + Retired the first seven batters before allowing three straight to reach in the third inning, going: double, RBI single (**Jonathan Lucroy**), to fall behind, 1-0... he stranded: a two-out single in the fourth, a two-out single and walk in the fifth, and erased a batter that reached on an E6 with two outs in the sixth with a 2-4 caught stealing...went: single, line out, go-ahead RBI single (**Jed Lowrie**) in the eighth, exiting after 7.1 innings, down 2-1, in favor of **Burch Smith**, who went: walk, three-run HR (**Matt Olson**), charging a third run to Junis...pitch count by inning: 9 (1st), 12 (2nd), 16 (3rd), 12 (4th), 17 (5th), 15 (6th), 10 (7th), 15 (8th), 106 total, matching a career high (also: April 20 at Detroit) while setting a new career high with nine strikeouts...he's pitched into the eighth inning in four of 12 starts this season.

JON JAY: Hit a solo home run in the third inning, his first since July 6, 2017 vs. Tampa Bay, snapping a streak of 442 at-bats without a HR, which was the longest active streak in the Majors by a non-pitcher, according to *Elias*...he has a hit in 29 of his last 32 games, a stretch in which he's batting .353/.385/.444 (47-for-133).

WHIT MERRIFIELD: Stole second and third base in the sixth inning—his 13th and 14th of the season—his third career multi-steal inning and second this season... he entered one behind **Mookie Betts** and **Mike Trout** (13 each) for the second most steals in the American League, trailing **Dee Gordon** (18)...the steal of third was his Major League-leading seventh (in as many attempts) in 2018 and 17th in 18 attempts in his career, trailing only **Rajai Davis** (22) and **Jose Altuve** (20) since 2016.

- + Went 0-for-2 with two walks, snapping his eight-game hitting streak, in which he hit .387/.500/.548 (12-for-31).

ATHLETICS: Improved to two games over .500 (31-29), one shy of their season high, and are 26-19 (.578) since April 15 after starting the season 5-10.

- + Earned their third straight road series win and improved to 8-9-2 in series play overall, including 8-6 in their last 15 since going winless their first five.
- + Extended their Major League lead in road HR to 53 and have homered in 17 straight road games, their longest since a club-record 21 straight in 2013.
- + Hit .300/.371/.518 (33-for-110) with six HR and 25 runs during the three-game series after batting .161/.223/.276 with 22 runs in their previous 10 games.
- + Have won three straight series at Kauffman Stadium and have won 11 of 15 games overall vs. Kansas City dating back to April 16, 2016.

DANIEL GOSSETT: Yielded a career-best two hits in 5.0 innings, but remains winless in his last nine starts since his last win on Sept. 9, 2017 vs. Houston.

- + He's 0-2 despite a 2.12 ERA (4 ER in 17.0 IP) in three starts since his May 23 recall, after going 0-1, 11.05 ERA (9 ER in 7.1 IP) in two starts prior.
- + Stranded a walk in each of the first two innings, before surrendering a solo HR to **Jon Jay** in the third...he retired seven of his last eight batters before exiting after 5.0 innings with right elbow tightness...pitch count by inning: 15 (1st), 15 (2nd), 18 (3rd), 8 (4th), 7 (5th), 63 total, the third-lowest pitch total in his career.
- + All five HR he's allowed this season have been solo and with two outs...his 26 career HR are the most by an Oakland pitcher through 23 career appearances.

LOU TRIVINO: Recorded scoreless sixth and seventh innings ahead of Oakland's four-run eighth to earn his third win and lower his ERA to 0.82 (2 ER in 22.0 IP).

MATT OLSON: Hit a three-run HR in the eighth inning, his 12th of the season (3rd with a runner on base) and fourth HR in four games.

JED LOWRIE: Had the go-ahead RBI single in the eighth inning off **Jakob Junis**, his first go-ahead RBI in the eighth or later since April 18 vs. the White Sox (2-run HR in the 8th)...it's the ninth go-ahead RBI in the eighth or later by the A's this season, fifth most in the American League behind (totals entering today): Seattle (12), Texas (10), New York (10) and Detroit (10).

DUSTIN FOWLER: Matched a career high with three hits (also: Friday) and scored the go-ahead run in the eighth inning in his second career start as the leadoff batter (also: May 20 at Toronto)...he hit .500/.538/1.000 (6-for-12) with three runs and four RBI in this three-game series, after entering 8-for-46 (.174/.250/.304) in 17 games.
