TONIGHT'S GAME: The Giants and Pirates begin a four-game series tonight...these two teams met in early May with the Pirates taking two of the three games...the Giants have won six of the last nine meetings with Pittsburgh, however have lost 11 of the last 16 against the Pirates here at AT&T Park.

AT AT&T PARK: SF is 0-2 to kick off a six-game homestand and have lost seven of their last eight games here at AT&T Park, scoring one run or fewer in four of the last five games...during this 1-7 stretch at home, the Giants have been outscored by a 37-22 margin.

TODAY'S STARTER: LHP Andrew Suárez has accumulated over three times as many strikeouts as walks so far in his first 19 big league starts... according to *Stats, LLC*, he could have the best strikeout-to-walk ratio by a Giants pitcher through 20 starts in the live-ball era.

ANDREW McCUTCHEEN: A five-time All-Star and 2013 MVP in nine seasons with the Pirates, is among the all-time leaders in Pirates history in home runs (4th, 203), doubles (9th, 292), RBI (11th, 725), games played (14th, 1,346) and hits (14th 1,463)...he went 4-for-14 with three doubles in his May homecoming in Pittsburgh.

DID YOU KNOW?: OF Andrew McCutchen and Pirates OF Gregory Polanco are two of six NL players to lead their teams in RBI, runs scored, walks and extra-base hits...McCutchen leads with the Giants with 46 RBI, 55 runs scored, 58 walks and 39 extra-base hits while Polanco has 64 RBI, 64 runs scored, 52 walks and 49 extra-base hits (*Stats, LLC*).

#25: For only the 10th time in the Giants' 136-year history, the Giants will retire a uniform number...this Saturday, August 11, the team will retire number 25 in honor of Barry Bonds' historic career with the San Francisco Giants from 1993-2007... AT&T Park gates will open at 3:45 p.m. and the pre-game ceremony will begin at 5:00 p.m.

BIRTHDAY WISHES: Happy Birthday to Giants first base coach **José Alguacil**, who turns 46 years old today.

SOLID PITCHING: Beginning June 1, Giants' pitchers have posted a 3.34 ERA (201er, 542.0ip), which ranks as the second-best figure in the Majors over that span, behind the Houston Astros (3.33 ERA).

IN THE 'PEN: The Giants' bullpen ranks fourth in the National League with an ERA of 3.54...only the Diamondbacks (3.06), Cubs (3.38) and Padres (3.49) have lower bullpen ERAs than San Francisco...in fact, beginning June 1, SF's bullpen ERA of 2.81 is the second-lowest in the Majors (Yankees, 2.80).

IN NEED OF CLUTCH HITS: The Giants are 5-for-their-last-31 (.161) with runners in scoring position.

NOTABLE BATTER-PITCHER MATCHUP: IF Evan Longoria is 13-for-44 (.295) with three homers and nine RBI in his career against tonight's starter Ivan Nova.

This Date in Giants History: August 9, 2002

Barry Bonds joined Babe Ruth, Willie Mays and Hank Aaron as the only players ever to hit 600 home runs in the Major Leagues...the 38-year-old Giant left fielder hit the milestone homer in the 6th inning by lining a 2-1 pitch thrown by Pirates starter Kip Wells over the centerfield wall at Pacific Bell Park.

#59 LHP Andrew Suárez
6-0, 187, 25 years old (September 11, 1992)
4-7 Record, 4.60 ERA

- The 25-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 20th career Major League start...has gone 4-7 with a 4.60 ERA (54er, 105.2ip) in 19 outings, with the Giants going 8-11 in those games.
- Among NL rookie leaders he ranks second in innings pitched (105.2), third in strikeouts (92) and ninth in ERA (4.60).
- Received a losing decision in the Giants' 9-3 loss at Arizona on Saturday...allowed eight runs on 10 hits with two walks, five strikeouts and two home runs allowed over 5.0 innings...the hits and runs allowed were career highs.
- Has a 7.89 ERA (19er, 21.2ip) over his last four starts.
- Has struck out 92 batters while issuing just 26 walks in his first 19 career Major League starts.
- Opponents have 27 hits in 83 at-bats (.325) off him with runners in scoring position...is holding opponents to a .182 average (6-for-33) with RISP and two outs.
- With one out in an inning opponents are hitting .307 off him with an OBP of .342 and a SLUG pct. of .526... however, with two outs in an inning opponents are hitting .248/.309/.448 (Baseball Info Solutions).
- Has received three or fewer runs of support in 13 of his 19 starts.
- Has a 3.64 ERA (22er, 54.1ip) in nine starts at home compared to a 5.61 ERA (32er, 51.1ip) in 10 starts on the road.
- Lefties are hitting .210 (21-for-100) off him and are just 12-for-their-last-59 (.203).
- Has faced the Pirates once this season and allowed five runs on seven hits over 4.0 innings and was tagged with the loss.
- Was selected in the second round of the 2015 MLB Draft by San Francisco (No. 61 overall).

NOTES: The 31-year-old left-hander is slated to make his 22nd start (26th appearance) this season...has posted a 5-8 record with a 3.88 ERA (51er, 118.1ip) over his 25 outings...did not factor into the decision in his last start on August 5 at Arizona...threw 5.1 innings, allowing two runs on three hits with six strikeouts in the Giants 3-2 victory over the Diamondbacks...has made four relief appearances and allowed two runs on five hits (one home run) with 14 strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...has struck out 14 of the 28 batters he's faced as a reliever... has made one career appearance against the Pirates...earned the win, tossing 6.1-scoreless in the Giants' 5-0 victory over Pittsburgh on May 13...the win snapped the Giants' season-high six game losing skid.
