2B Ozzie Albies singled and scored in the first inning last night and is now hitting .484 with a 1.097 slugging percentage in the opening frame this season.

Albies first-inning ranks are near the top of the majors in virtually every offensive category...He is first with 15 hits, a .484 average, a 1.097 slugging percentage and eight extra-base hits and tied for first with 11 runs and five home runs.

He is also tied for the N.L. lead with two leadoff home runs.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Giants continue a three-game set tonight with the second game of the Braves' third homestand of the season... This is the first meeting between the clubs this season; the Braves will travel to San Francisco for three games, September 10-12.

A The Braves took three of the four games against San Francisco at SunTrust Park last season, the club's first series win against the Giants in Atlanta since the 2013 season...The Giants can clinch this series with a win tonight after they took the opener, 9-4.

A Tonight marks LHP Ty Blach's second career start against the Braves and his first in Atlanta...Beat the Braves, 6-3, with 7.2 innings of two-run ball last May 27 at AT&T Park.

A RHP Brandon McCarthy is set to make his eighth career appearance and sixth start against the Giants tonight...Has not beaten San Francisco since 2013 and over his last five appearances, three starts, against the Giants, is 0-3 with a 10.18 ERA (23 ER/20.1 IP).

ROSTER MOVE: The Braves today recalled RHP Lucas Sims from Triple-A Gwinnett and optioned LHP Max Fried to the Stripers...This will mark Sims' second stint with the club this season...He was also up from April 15-April 19.

A Sims, 23, allowed three runs, earned, while getting one out in his only appearance with the Braves this season.

A The right-hander went 1-1 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) in three games, three starts, with the Stripers...He tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in his last start on April 30 at Charlotte.

A Fried went 0-2 with a 6.00 ERA (4 ER/6.0 IP) in four games out of the bullpen with Atlanta.

FIRST INNING: The Braves led 2-0 after the first inning yesterday and have now scored a MLB-high 34 runs in the first inning this season.

A They also have the most hits (49) and doubles (14) and are tied for the most home runs with 10.

A The club also has a .355 batting average and a .703 slugging percentage in the first inning, both tops in the majors.

A The Braves lost last night despite taking a lead into the second inning and are now 10-3 when ahead after the first.

DEBUT: 3B José Bautista made his Braves debut last night, doubling in his first at-bat and cleanly fielding all four of his chances.

A In 12 career at-bats at SunTrust Park, Bautista is hitting .500 with three doubles and a home run, while slugging 1.000

NICK MARKAKIS: OF Nick Markakis extended his hitting streak to a Braves season-high 11 games last night, finishing 2-for-4 with his sixth home run of the season.

A Markakis was credited with a second hit, an eighth-inning single, after the official scorer changed his call from E-5 to a base hit following the game.

A The outfielder is hitting .455 (20-for-44) with four home runs, eight walks and just one strikeout during his run, which dates to April 23.

A Markakis' .341 average and 42 hits are both tops in the N.L.

A Markakis homered for the second consecutive game last night, marking the first time he went deep in back-to-back games since July 7 and July 8, 2016... He reached six home runs this season in his 31st game; he hit No. 6 in his 108th game last season on August 4.

THE OFFENSE: The Braves offense leads all of baseball in batting average (.275) and on-base percentage (.344), while its 308 hits are tied for the most...The club leads the N.L. in runs (176), doubles (74), slugging percentage (.455) and extra-base hits (118).

A The Braves have struck out 250 times, two more times than Cubs, who have fanned the fewest times in the N.L.

VS. LEFTY STARTERS: The Braves are set to face just their fifth left-handed starter tonight...They are 3-1 in games started by lefties, with their only loss coming after blowing a 10-2 lead they built against José Quintana and the Cubs on April 14 at Wrigley Field.

A The Braves are hitting .301 against all lefties, the only team in the majors with a mark above .300... They also have the best on-base percentage (.369) and slugging percentage (.521)...The next closest slugging percentage is Tampa Bay at .459.

A The Braves have scored 30 runs against left-handed starters in just four games (7.5 runs per game)...That is the best runs per game average against left-handed starters in baseball.

A 2B Ozzie Albies is hitting .481 (13-for-27) against all left-handers, the best mark in baseball among qualifiers...His 1.111 slugging percentage is second to San Diego's Christian Villanueva (1.147)...Albies has fanned just twice against lefties this season.

VS. LEFTY HITTERS: The Braves are holding left-handed batters to a .214 batting average, the best mark in the N.L.

A Tonight's starter, RHP Brandon McCarthy has held left-handed batters to a .185 batting average, the fifth-best mark in the N.L.

A LHP Sam Freeman has yet to allow a hit to a left-handed batter in 14 at-bats.

Tonight's Game

- A* Makes his seventh start of the season and the 189th (247th appearance) of his career.
- A* Started the season 4-0 for the first time in his career...Previously opened the season 3-0 in 2009, 2015 and 2017 before dropping his next decision.
 - A* Is the first Braves starter to open a season 4-0 since Williams Perez, who did so to start his 2015 campaign...The last Braves starter to begin a season 5-0 was Jair Jurrjens, who won five of his first six starts in 2011...Kris Medlen won his first nine decisions as a starter in 2012, but took a loss in relief earlier in the season.
 - A* Atlanta is 5-1 as a team in McCarthy's starts, outscoring the opposition 52-21... The only loss was a 9-7, extra-inning loss to the Reds on 4/24.
- A* Has received 27 runs of support in 32.0 innings on the mound...His 7.59 runs of support per 9.0 innings is most in the National League and second most in the majors (LAA's Garrett Richards, 8.13).
- A* Is 1-3 with a 7.34 ERA (28 ER/34.1 IP) in seven career games (five starts) against San Francisco...Giants batters have hit .313 (45-for-144) against him in his career.
 - A* Faced them twice last year while with the Dodgers, going 0-1 with a 7.27 ERA...Allowed eight hits and six runs over 5.2 innings in a start on 5/15, before allowing one run over 3.0 innings in relief, 9/23.
 - A* Has compiled a career ERA above 7.00 against just four teams - Cincinnati (7.85), Atlanta (7.84), San Francisco (7.34) and Oakland (7.27).

2018 Recap

- A* Went 5.1 innings and allowed five hits and one run over 5.1 innings in his last turn, 4/29 at PHI, to earn the win...Three of his four wins this season have come against Philadelphia.
 - A* Is the only pitcher in the majors this season to defeat a single opponent three times.
- A* Allowed a season-high five runs (three earned) over 5.0 innings, 4/24 at CIN... Surrendered a pair of solo home runs.
 - A* Moved to 1-2 with a 7.85 ERA (16 ER/18.1 IP) in his career against the Reds, his highest ERA against any one team.
- A* Earned his second win over Philadelphia after holding the Phillies to five hits and one run over 5.1 innings, 4/18...Fanned a season best six batters.
 - A* Atlanta won the game 7-3, and moved to 4-0 in McCarthy's starts this season... That is the longest run of wins for the Braves to open the season in starts by one pitcher since the club also won each of Shelby Miller's first four starts in 2015.
- A* Limited Washington to four hits and one run, 4/11 at Nationals Park, but did not earn the win...Is winless in four career starts against the Nationals.
- A* Went 6.0 innings and allowed five hits and three runs, 4/6 at COL...Walked two and fanned four to earn his second win of the season.
 - A* Tossed the first "quality start" by a Braves pitcher and was the first Braves starter to complete 6.0 innings with the outing, Atlanta's seventh game of the season.
- A* Earned the win in his Braves debut, 3/31 vs. PHI...Allowed six hits and two runs over 5.1 innings in a 15-2 Atlanta win...Only one Braves starter last season earned the win his team debut; Max Fried on 9/3 at CHI.
 - A* The win was the first of his career against the Phillies, and he is now winless against just four major league franchises...Has never defeated Milwaukee (0-0), St. Louis (0-1) or Washington (0-2), and is also winless in two career starts against Atlanta.
- A* Made four official starts during the Grapefruit League season, going 1-1 with a 3.45 ERA (6 ER/15.2 IP) and a .193 (11-for-57) batting average against him.
- A* Acquired by Atlanta along with LHP Scott Kazmir, INF Charlie Culberson, INF Adrián González and cash considerations from the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for OF Matt Kemp on 12/16/17.

2017 Recap

- A* Appeared in 19 games, 16 starts, in his third season with the Dodgers, while also missing 73 games over three different disabled list stints...Missed time from 5/5-6/26 (dislocated left shoulder), 6/26-7/8 (right knee tendonitis) and 7/21-9/22 (blister on right third finger).

Career Recap

- A* Is in his 13th major league season with his seventh organization...Started with the Chicago White Sox (2005-06), before joining the Texas Rangers (2007-09), the Oakland Athletics (2011-12), the Arizona Diamondbacks (2013-14), the New York Yankees (2014) and the Los Angeles Dodgers (2015-16).
- A* Made four regular season starts (3-0, 5.87 ERA) in 2015 before being placed on the DL with a torn UCL in his right elbow.... Underwent "Tommy John" surgery performed by Dr. Neal ElAttrache on 4/30.
- A* Struck on the right side of his head by an Erick Aybar line drive in the fourth inning on 9/5/12 vs. LAA, suffering an epidural hemorrhage, brain contusion and a skull fracture...Did not pitch again for the remainder of the season.

Jesse Biddle • LHP • 6-5 • 220 • 26 yrs • #63

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 6/4 Inherited Runners/Scored: 3/3

- Right-handed batters have just two hits in 20 at-bats (.100) against him...Lefties are hitting .400/.500/.800 with four hits, two walks, one double, a home run and five RBI.
- Allowed the first two runs of his major league career in his last outing, 5/4 vs. SF...Surrendered a two-run home run to Brandon Crawford in the top of the seventh.
- Went 2.0 innings and fanned a career-most five batters, 4/29 at PHI...Became the first Atlanta reliever to strike out at least five batters in 2.0 or fewer innings since Dario Álvarez did so on 6/15/16...Just four Atlanta relievers have had an outing of five strikeouts in 2.0 or fewer innings since 2000.
- Made his major league debut, 4/21 vs. NYM, and tossed 1.0 scoreless inning...Earned the win when Atlanta walked off in the bottom of the ninth...Became the first Atlanta reliever to earn the win in his debut since Jed Bradley on 9/3/16 at PHI.
- Recalled from Triple-A Gwinnett, 4/17, for his first appearance on an active roster.

Shane Carle • RHP • 6-4 • 210 • 26 yrs • #51

Saves/Opp: 0/1 Holds: 5 1st Batter/Retired: 14/11 Inherited Runners/Scored: 10/3

- Threw two pitches and left with numbness in his right index finger and thumb in his last outing, 5/1 at NYM.
- Holding right-handed batters to a .158 (6-for-38) average...Lefties are hitting .281 (9-for-32).
- Converted his fifth hold of the season, 4/28 at PHI...Five holds pace the club and are tied for second most in the majors among rookie pitchers...No rookie has paced the Atlanta staff in holds since Jonny Venters in 2010 (24).
- Holding batters to a .171 (6-for-35) average with men on base and has allowed just three hits (3-for-25, .120) with runners in scoring position...Batters are hitting .257 (9-for-35) with no one on base.
- Tallied his first career win, 4/3 vs. WSH...Tossed 3.1 scoreless innings, while also stranding the bases loaded after entering the game in the third.
- Took the loss in his Braves debut, 3/30 vs. PHI...Allowed one run over 2.0 innings...The loss was his first major league decision.

Sam Freeman • LHP • 5-11 • 180 • 30 yrs • #39

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 2 1st Batter/Retired: 17/12 Inherited Runners/Scored: 18/3

- Has not allowed a hit to a left-handed batter this season (0-for-14).
- Ranks tied for second in the majors with 17 appearances this season...Has pitched in 55% of Atlanta's games...Made a career-most 58 appearances last year.
- Tossed 1.1 scoreless innings to earn his first win of the season, 4/26 at CIN...Retired all four batters he faced and did not issue a base-on-balls...Had walked eight of the last 17 batters he had faced entering the appearance.
- Inherited the bases loaded, 4/19 vs. NYM, and allowed a sacrifice fly before stranding the remaining two runners...Has inherited a majors-most (tied) 18 runners, and has stranded 15 (83%)...Inherited just 19 runners last season.
- Took the loss, 4/23 at CIN...The loss snapped a streak of 190 consecutive games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors at the time...Freeman's run, which was the second-longest in MLB history, dated to 10/3/12...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) had a longer streak in MLB history.

A.J. Minter • LHP • 6-0 • 215 • 24 yrs • #33

Saves/Opp: 1/1 Holds: 4 1st Batter/Retired: 14/8 Inherited Runners/Scored: 3/0

- Has issued seven base-on-balls over his last 6.2 innings (seven games)...Walked just two batters in 15.0 innings last season...Over 57 career games in the minors, walked 3.5 batters per 9.0 innings.
- Earned the first save of his major league career with a scoreless ninth inning, 4/25 at CIN...Became the first left-handed pitcher to record a save for Atlanta since Jonny Venters logged five in 2011.
- Allowed a career high-tying three hits and two runs, 4/24 at CIN...Had surrendered just four hits total entering play...Had not allowed three hits or two runs since 8/27/17 vs. COL, his second career appearance.
- Stranded the only runner he inherited, 4/16 vs. PHI...Inherited two runners vs. PHI on 3/30 and stranded them both in his season debut...Has stranded all seven runners he has inherited in his career.
- Fanned the side, 4/11 at WSH...Needed just 13 pitches to do so.
- Appeared in back-to-back games three times this season...His back-to-back outings on 4/3 and 4/4 vs. WSH marked the first time doing so in his career...Did so just once in the minors (7/23 and 7/24/17 with GWN)...Underwent "Tommy John" surgery in 2015.

Peter Moylan • RHP • 6-3 • 220 • 39 yrs • #30

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 15/6 Inherited Runners/Scored: 9/5

- Allowed the first batter he has faced to reach base 60% percent of the time...Nine of 15 first batters have reached.
- Allowed at least one baserunner in 14 of his 15 outings this season...Opponents have 17 hits and eight walks over 11.1 innings of work (2.21 WHIP).
- Worked a season-most 1.1 inning, 4/29 at CIN, and has just seven outings of at least 1.0 full inning this season...Made 79 appearances with Kansas City last season, but just 34 of those games went 1.0 full frame...His 79 total appearances led the majors, but his 34 relief outings of at least 1.0 inning ranked tied for 142nd.
- Has limited right-handed batters to a .215 average (220-for-1022) for his career...Lefties are hitting .299 (134-for-448) against him.
- Has appeared in 190 games without a loss, the longest such active streak in the majors...Moylan's run, which is tied for the second longest in MLB history, dates to 9/9/11...Only Trevor Miller (240 games, 2006-09) and teammate Sam Freeman (190 games, 2012-2018) have had streaks as long.

Lucas Sims • RHP • 6-2 • 230 • 23 yrs • #50

Saves/Opp: 0/0 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 1/0 Inherited Runners/Scored: 0/0

- Was recalled to Atlanta from Triple-A Gwinnett today for his second stint on the roster...Also up from 4/15-4/19.
- Made one appearance with Atlanta, 4/19 vs. NYM...Retired one batter while allowing two hits, three walks and three runs.
- In three starts with the Stripers this season, is 1-1 with a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts...Tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in his last appearance, 4/30 at Charlotte.
- Made his major league debut last season, 8/1 vs. LAD, after beginning the season in Triple-A Gwinnett's rotation...Finished the season in the Braves rotation after also working in relief for Atlanta.
- Worked out of the bullpen for four appearances, 9/7-16...Did not receive a decision out of the bullpen while compiling a 4.26 ERA (3 ER/6.1 IP)...Went 3-6 with a 5.79 ERA (33 ER/51.1 IP) in 10 starts.

Arodys Vizcaíno • RHP • 6-0 • 245 • 27 yrs • #38

Saves/Opp: 4/5 Holds: 0 1st Batter/Retired: 14/11 Inherited Runners/Scored: 0/0

- Converted his fourth save, 4/1 at NYM, and each of his last three appearances have resulted in saves...Since assuming the primary closer role for Atlanta on 7/30/17, has converted 16-of-18 (89%) of save opportunities.
